2021-22 Security and Emergency Management Measures

ALL HAZARDS SECURITY/VULNERABILITY ASSESSMENT

STANDARD: The New Jersey Department of Education requires the following: "A vulnerability assessment is the ongoing process for identifying and prioritizing risks to the individual schools and school districts."

The report will include Findings, Recommendations and cite relevant standards or guidelines to justify the recommendations. Prioritized recommendations will also be made to assist the district in budgeting for improvements and includes meeting and planning with District architects.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN DEVELOPMENT

STANDARD: New Jersey Administrative Code 6A:16-5.1 school safety and security plans requires each school district to have a school safety and security plan that meets the minimum state requirements. The format and content of school safety and security plans are established by the domestic security preparedness task force and the commissioner of education.

SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT TRAINING

Training is required by State regulation and is critical to support the plans that have already been developed for the MPS and their schools.

SGA will provide training sessions for all Montclair schools.



2021-22 Security and Emergency Management Measures

TABLETOP EXERCISE

To assist the MPSs with exercising their existing emergency management plan, SGA will coordinate, plan and facilitate one tabletop exercise with local emergency management responders. This exercise will permit the school to measure the effectiveness of its plan response and make the necessary improvements to the Plan.

SINGLEWARE INFORMACAST SUPPORT

InformaCast is a powerful emergency mass notification system that the MPS will transitioning to enhance emergency communication amongst key stakeholders.

SGA will support the Director of Technology with completing the "InformaCast Worksheet" that will be incorporated into the system and used to enhance emergency response for specific emergencies

SAFETY COMMITTEE SUPPORT

As requested by the School Safety Specialist(s), SGA will participate on the MPS Safety Committee and provide updates on MPS security and emergency management activities as well current best practices related to safety, fire safety, security, and emergency management.
