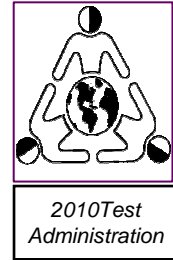

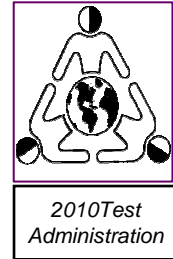

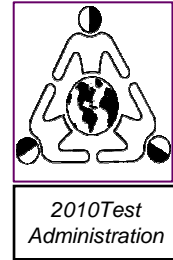

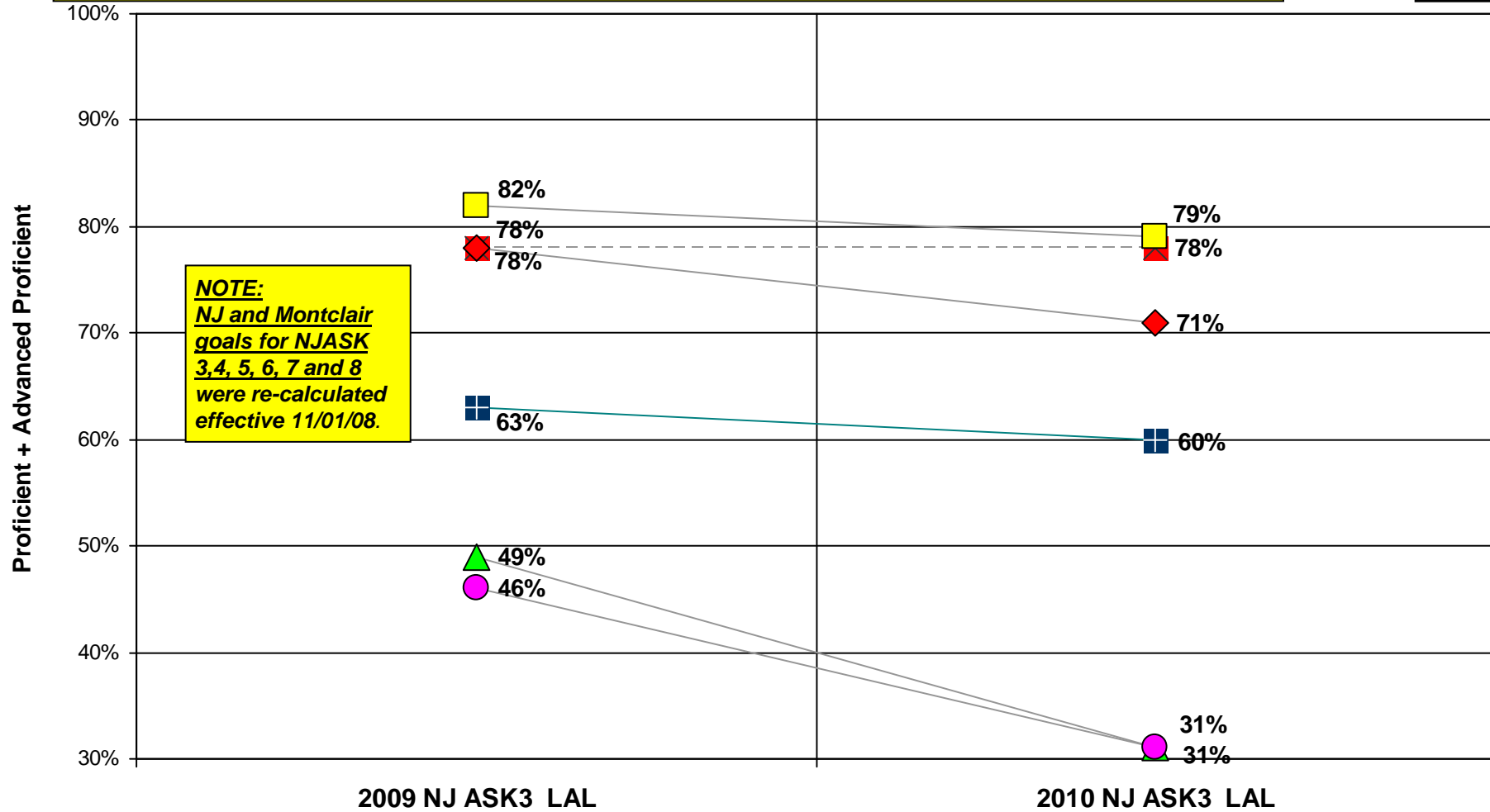

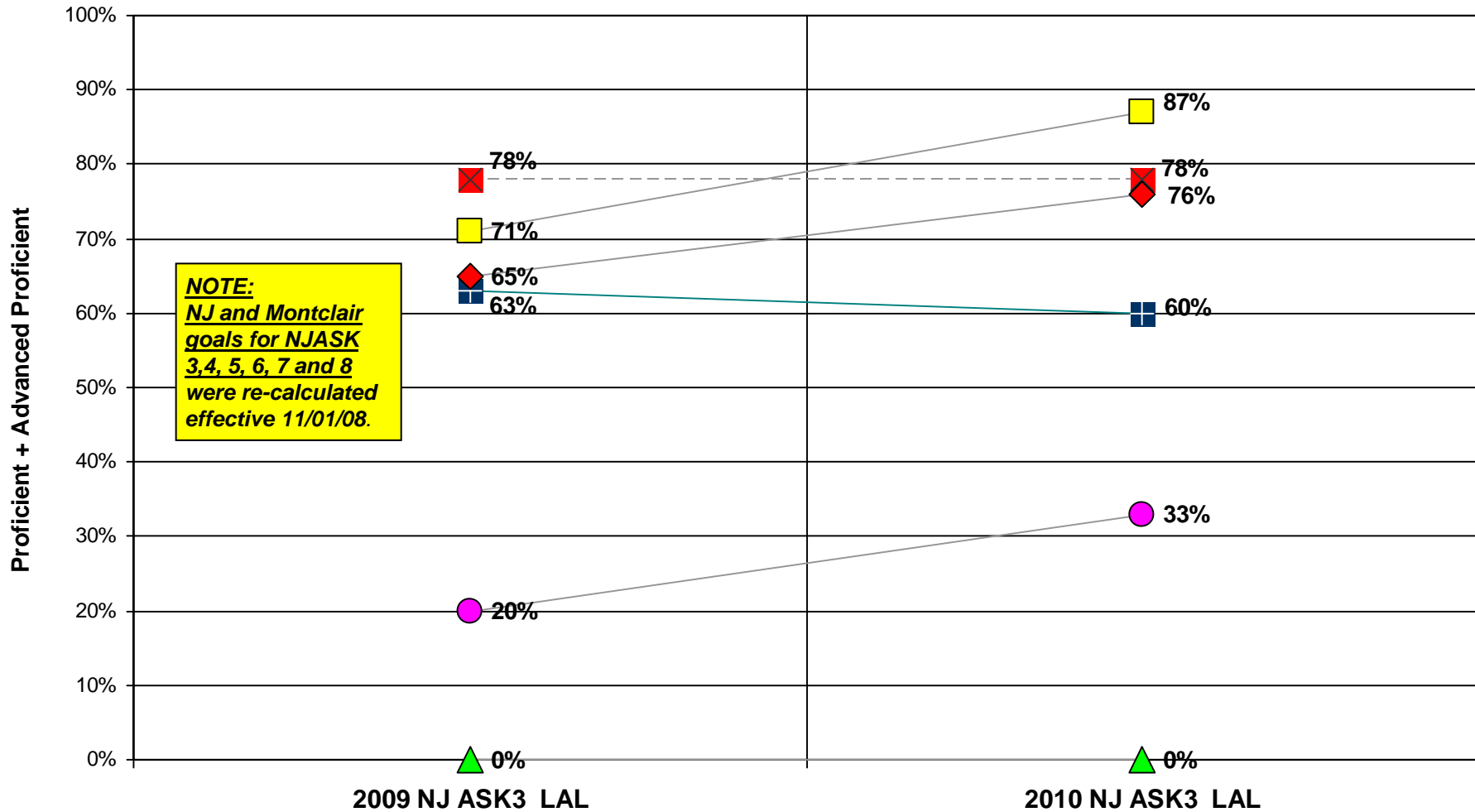


Grade 03 LAL (NJASK3) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf BRADFORD By GROUP: 2009 - 2010

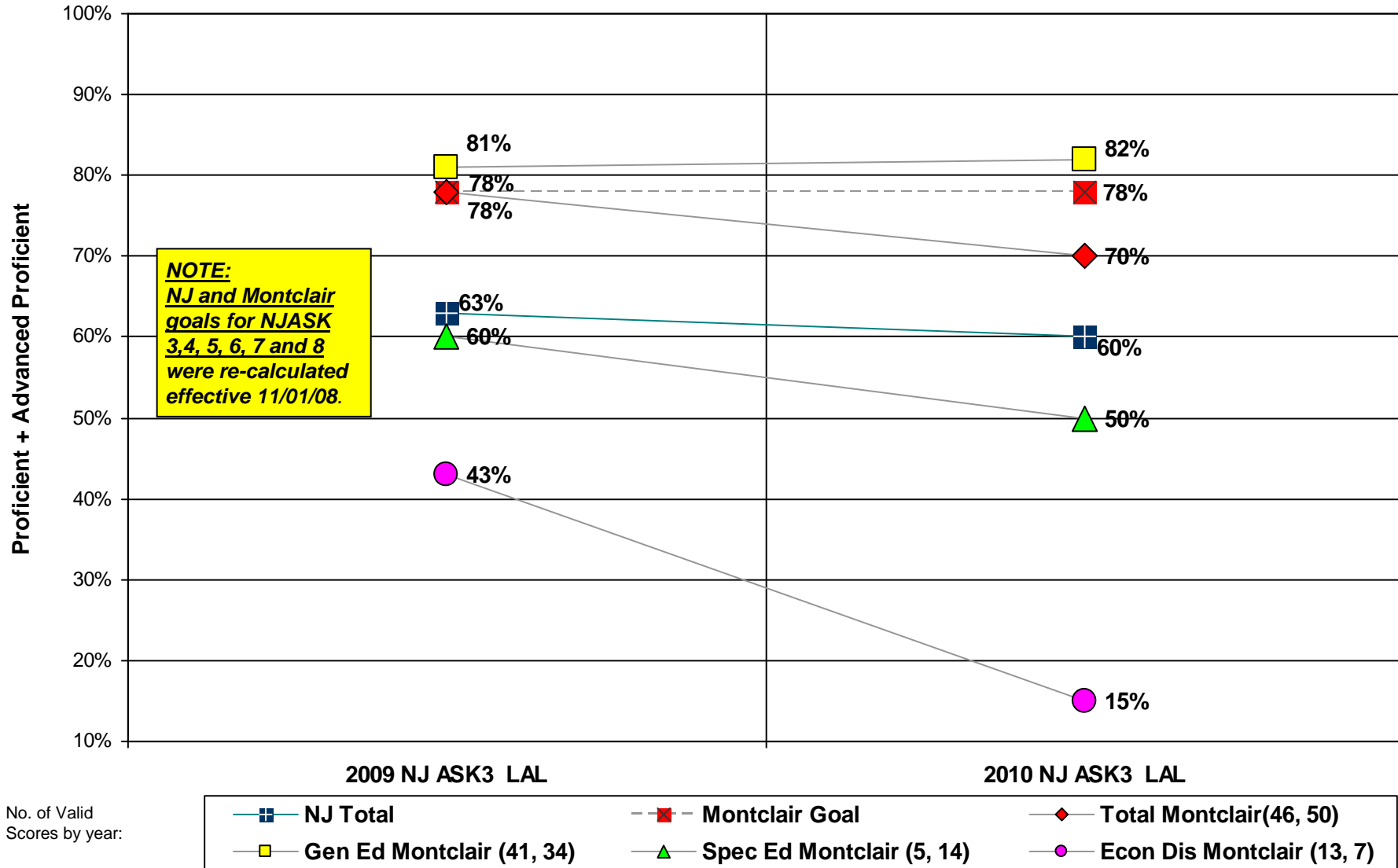


Grade 03 LAL (NJASK3) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf EDGEMONT By GROUP: 2009 - 2010

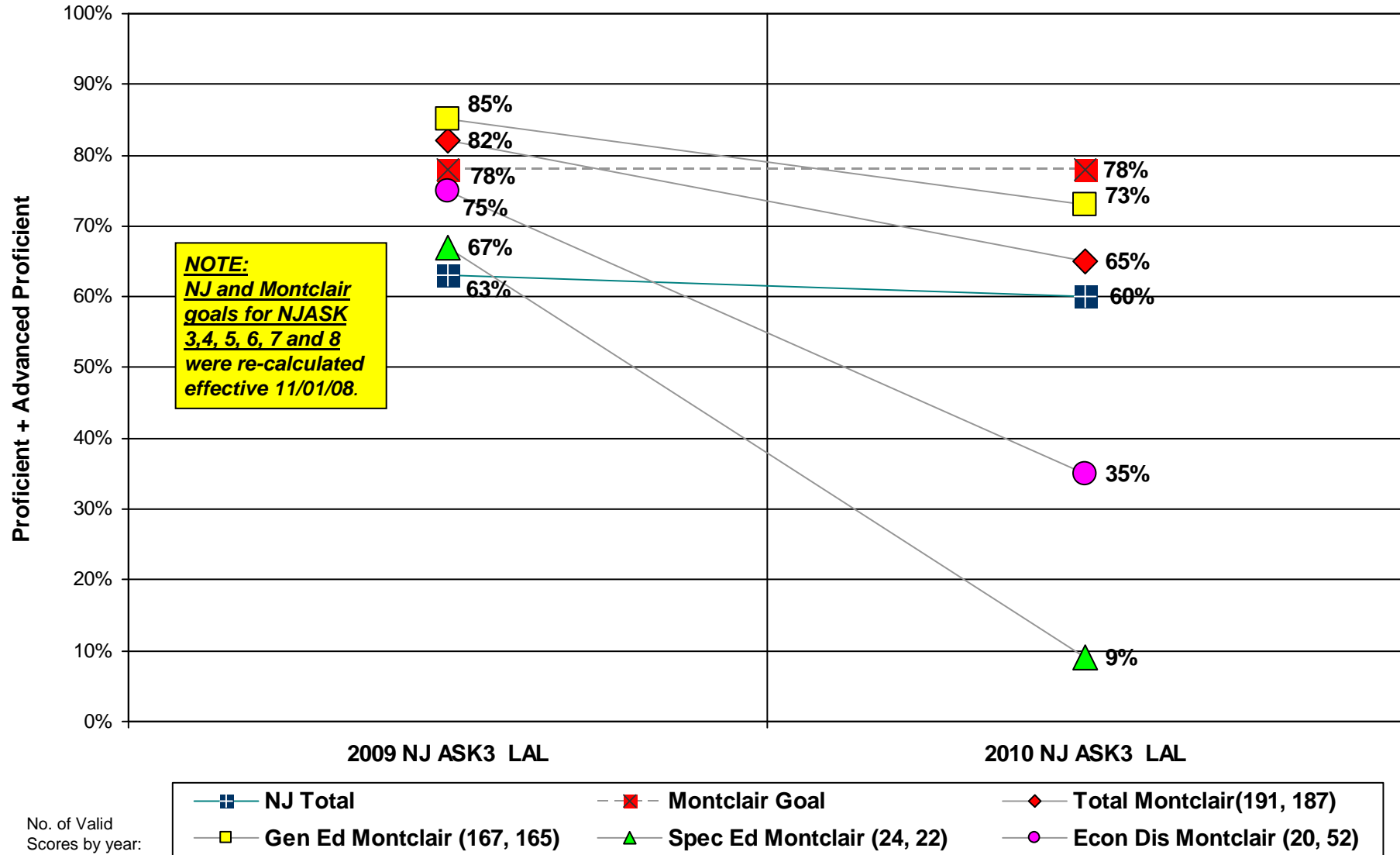


Grade 03 LAL (NJASK3) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf HILLSIDE By GROUP: 2009 - 2010

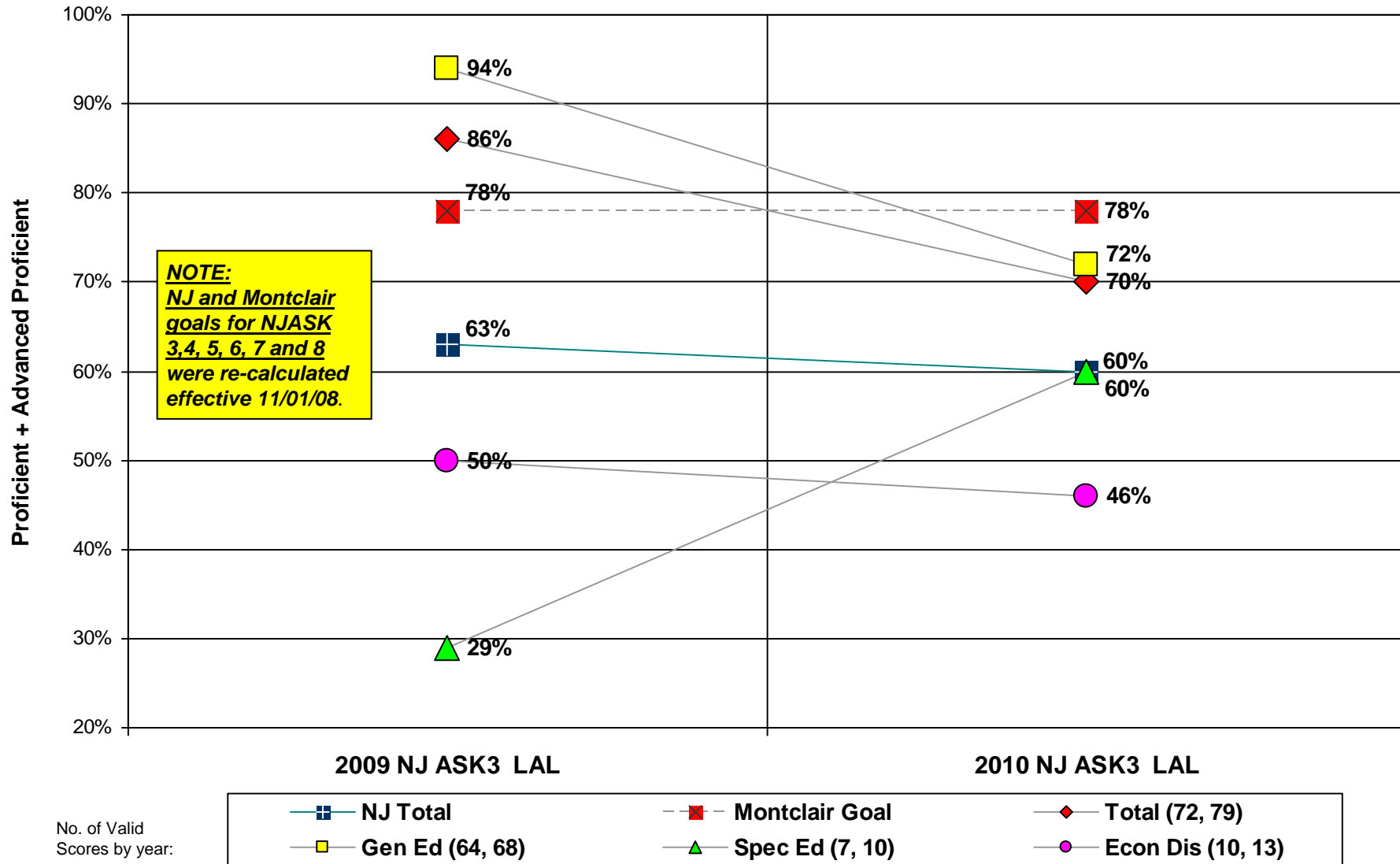


Grade 03 LAL (NJASK3) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf NORTHEAST By GROUP: 2009 - 2010

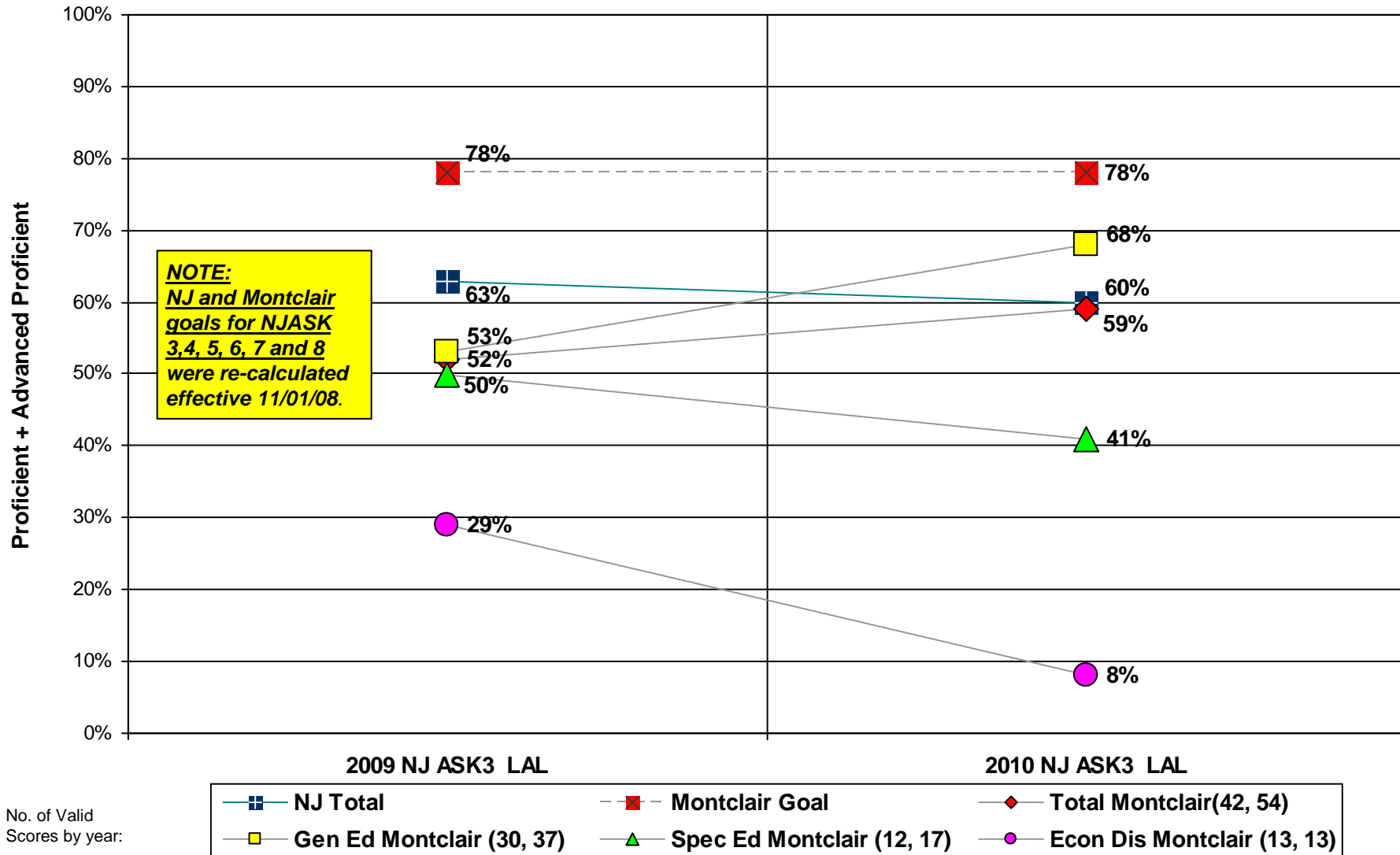


Grade 03 LAL (NJASK3) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf RAND By GROUP: 2009 - 2010

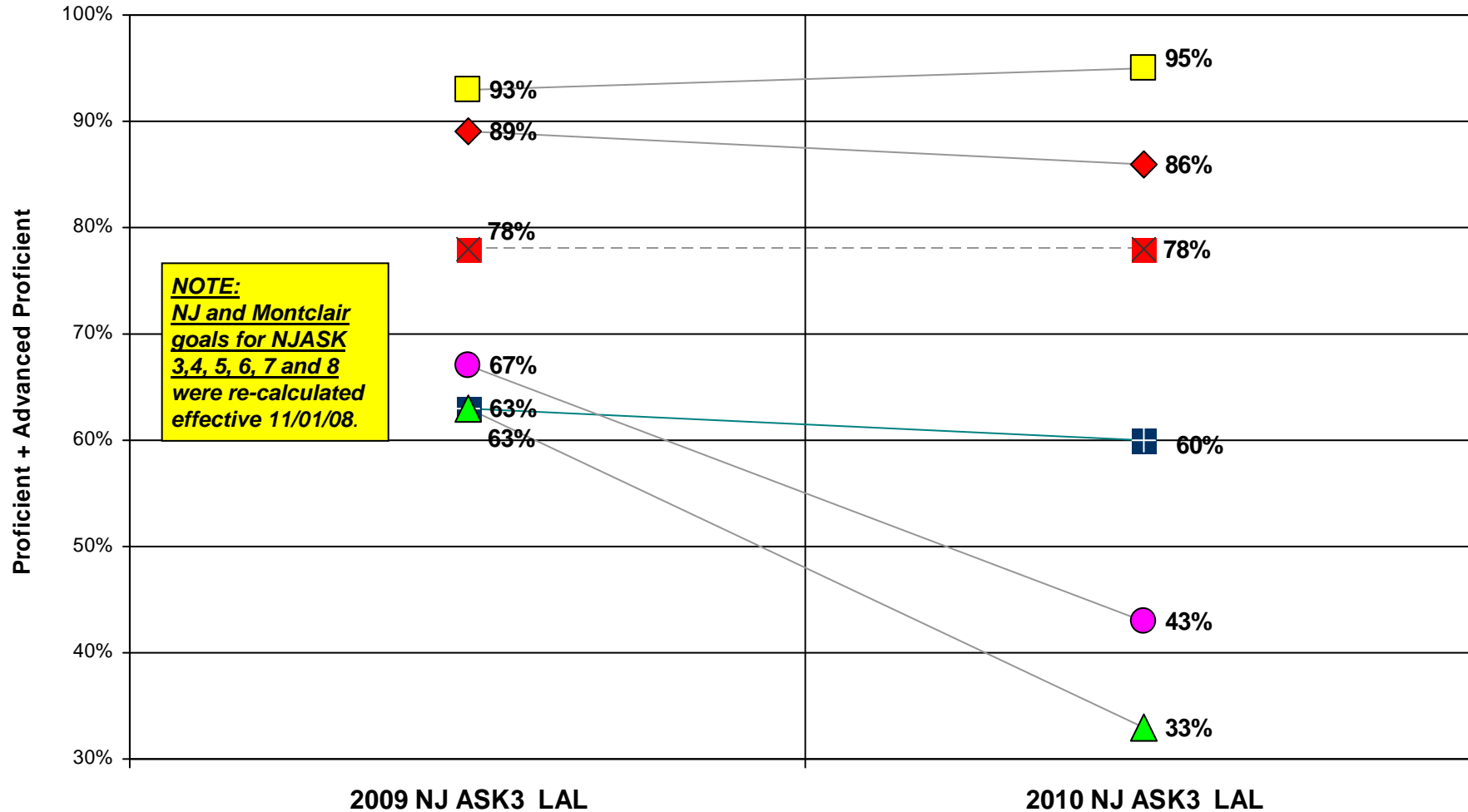


Grade 03 LAL (NJASK3) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf WATCHUNG By GROUP: 2009 - 2010

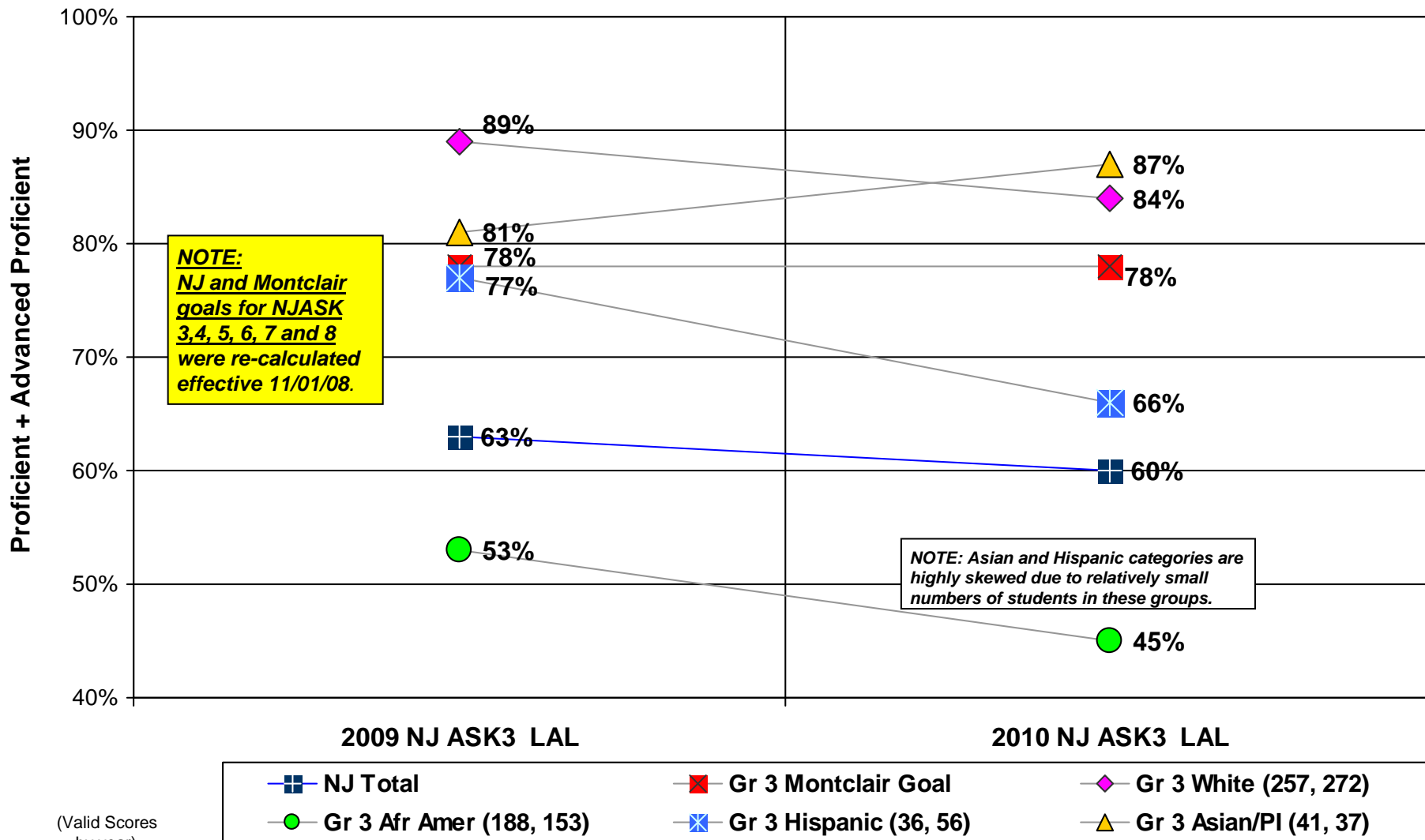

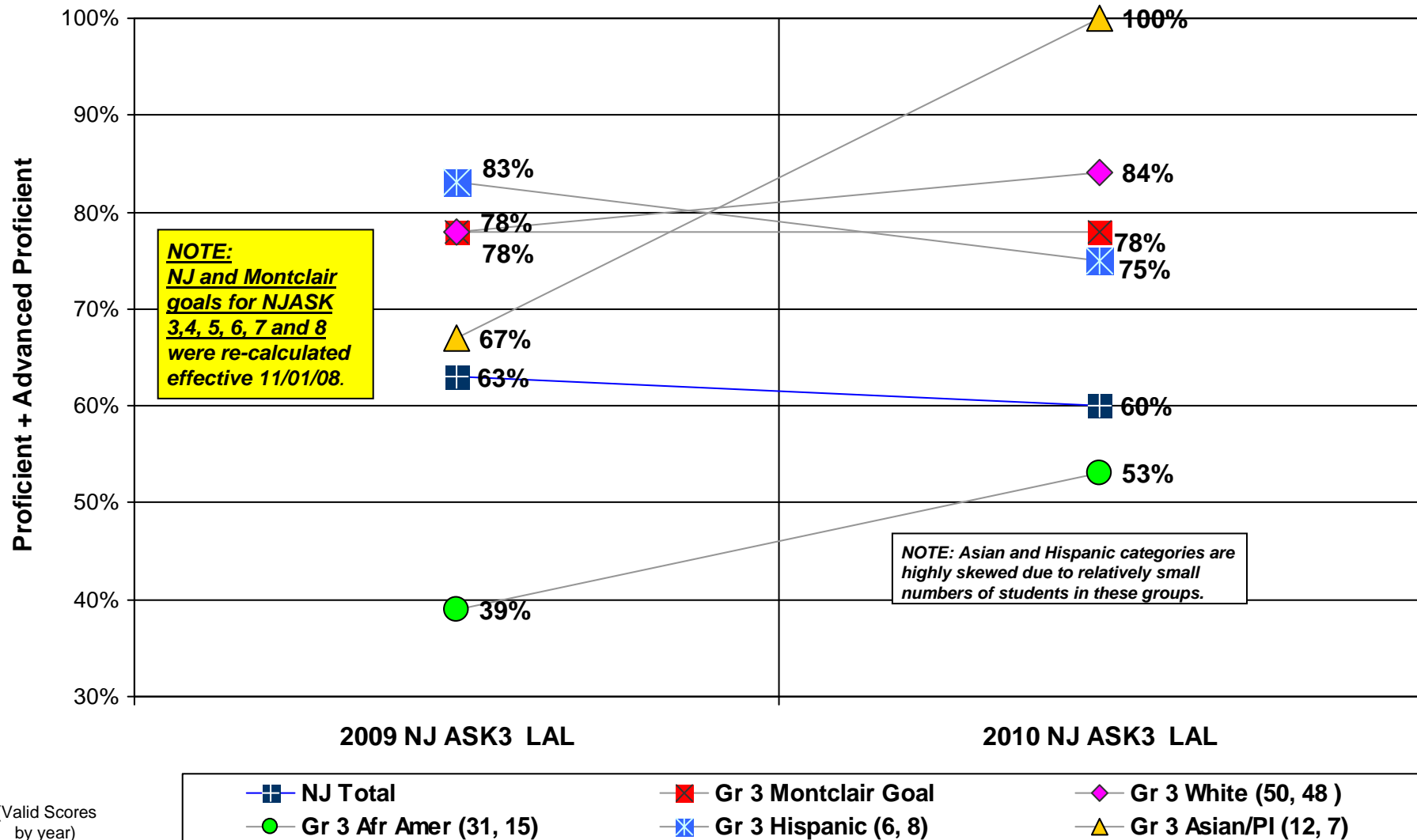


Grade 03 LAL (NJASK3) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf BRADFORD By ETHNICITY 2009 - 2010

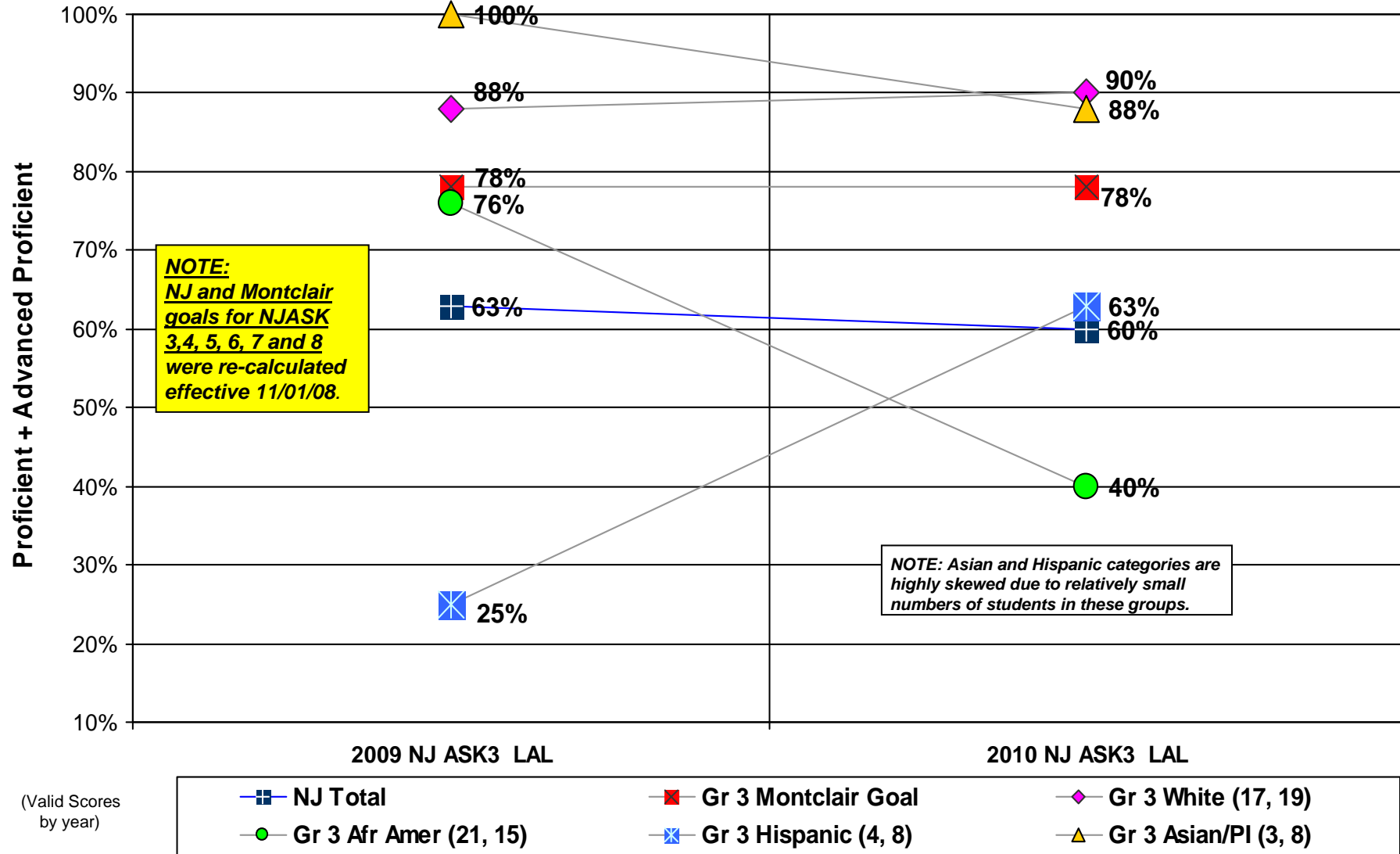

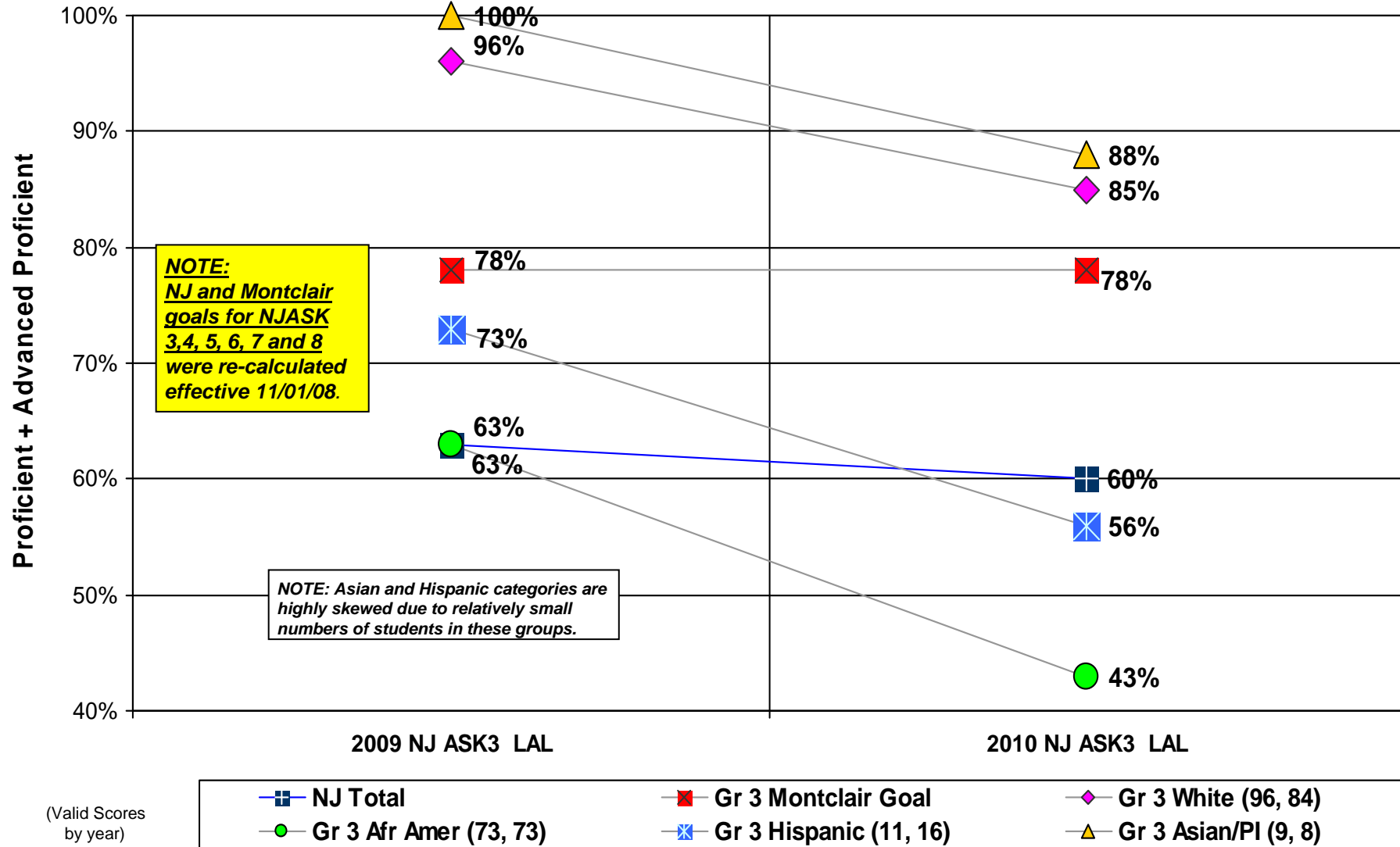


Grade 03 LAL (NJASK3) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf HILLSIDE By ETHNICITY 2009 - 2010

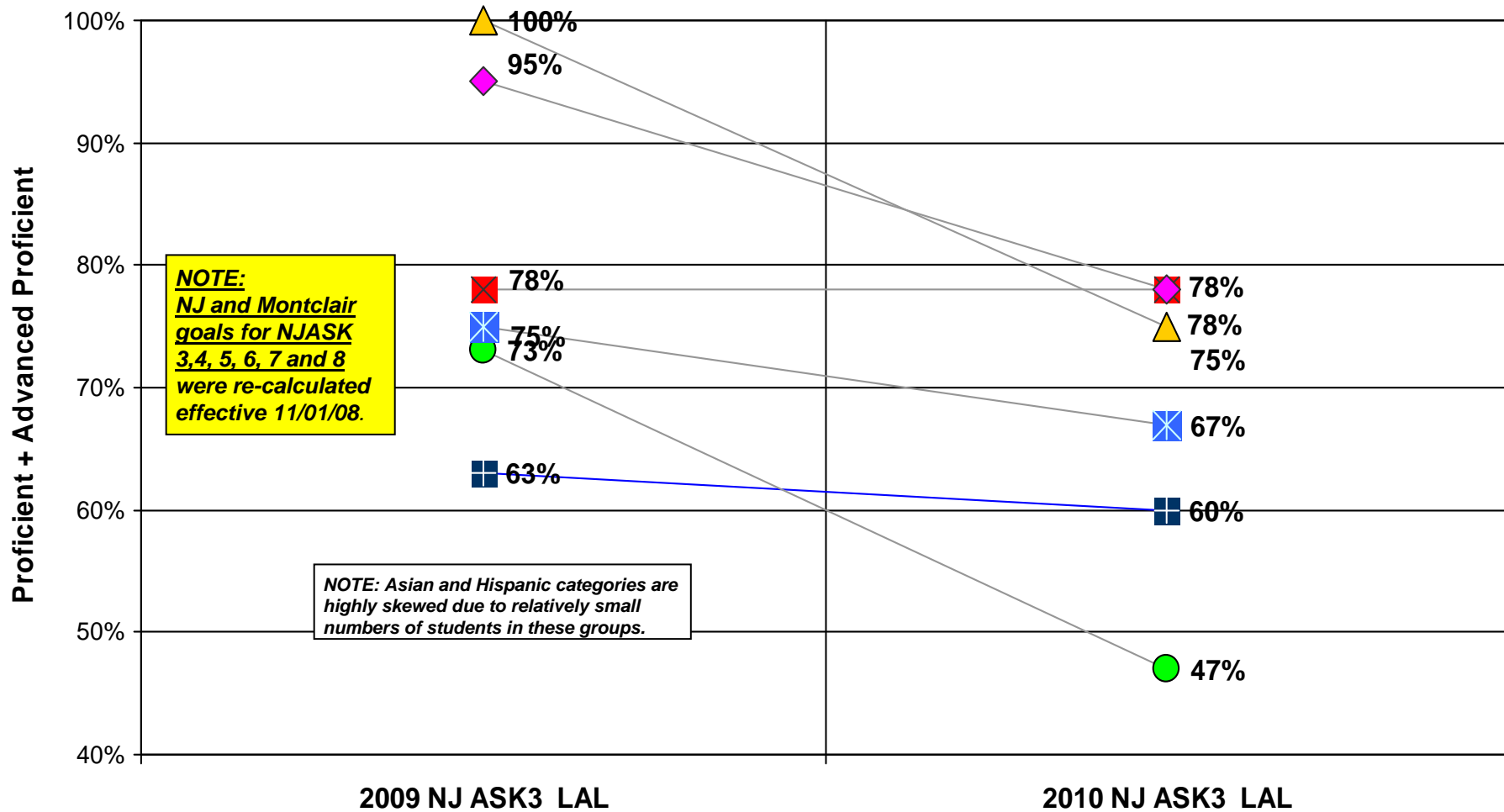


Grade 03 LAL (NJASK3) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf NORTHEAST By ETHNICITY 2009 - 2010

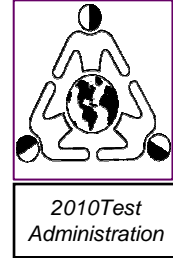

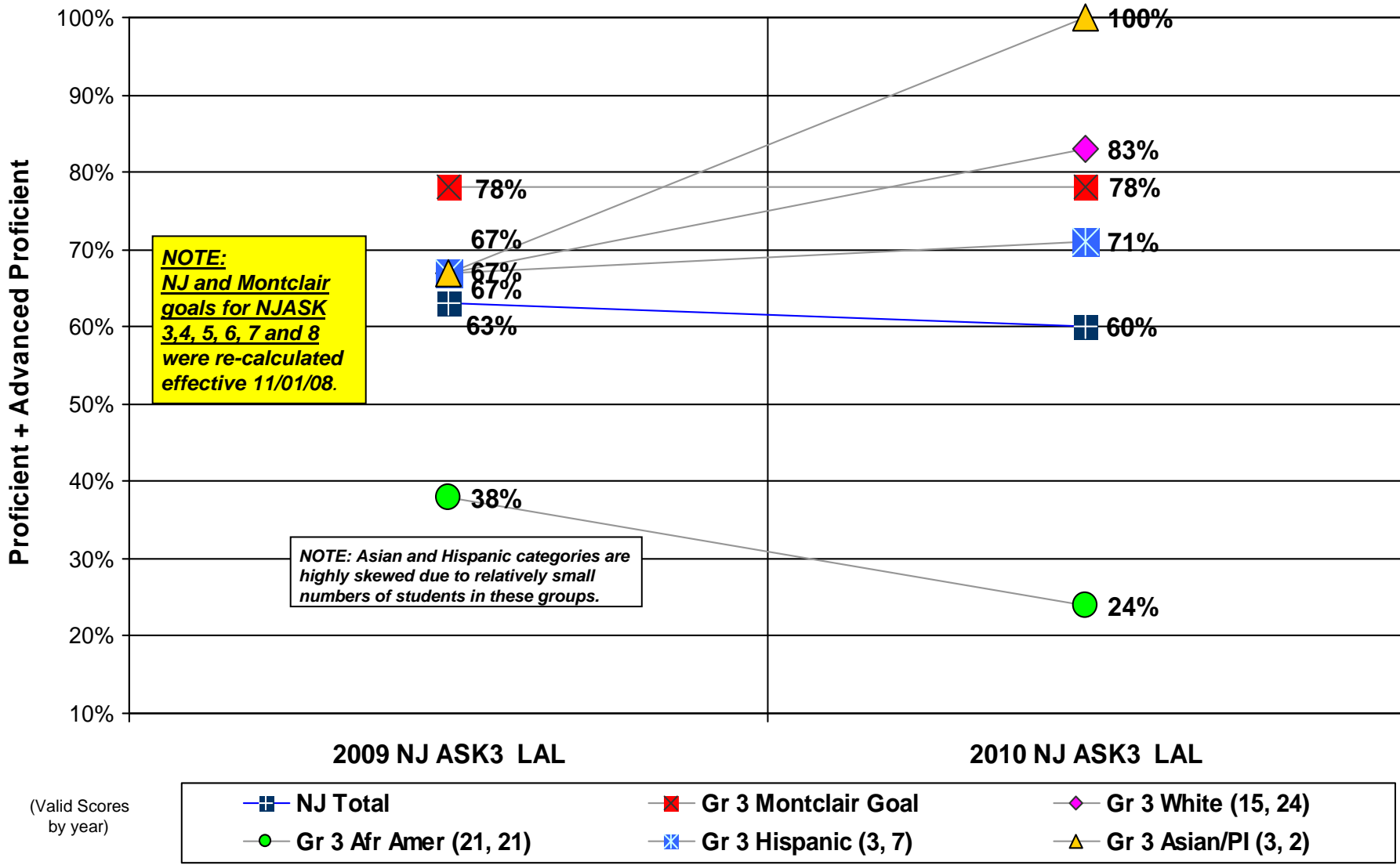

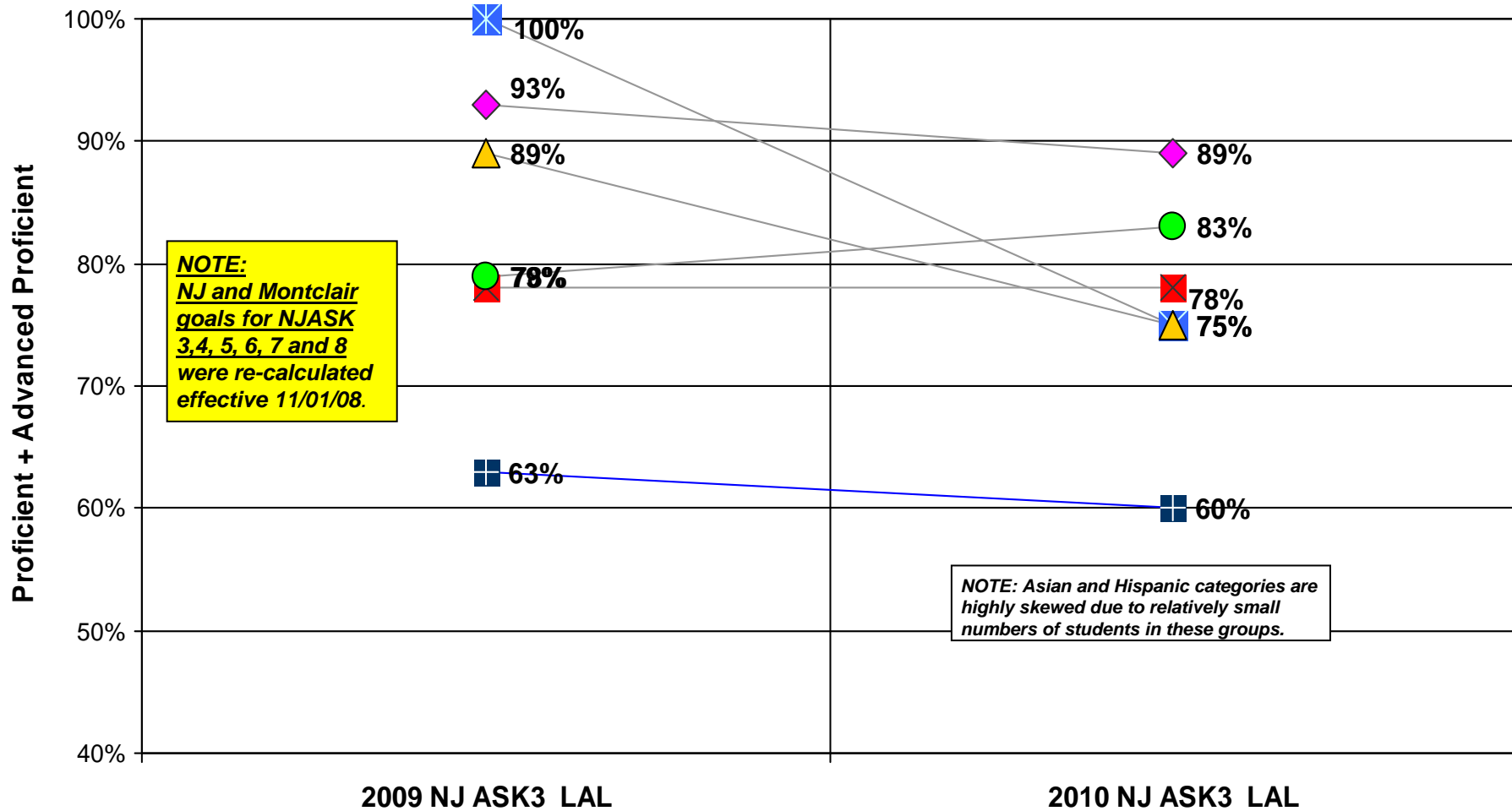


Grade 03 LAL (NJASK3) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf WATCHUNG By ETHNICITY 2009 - 2010

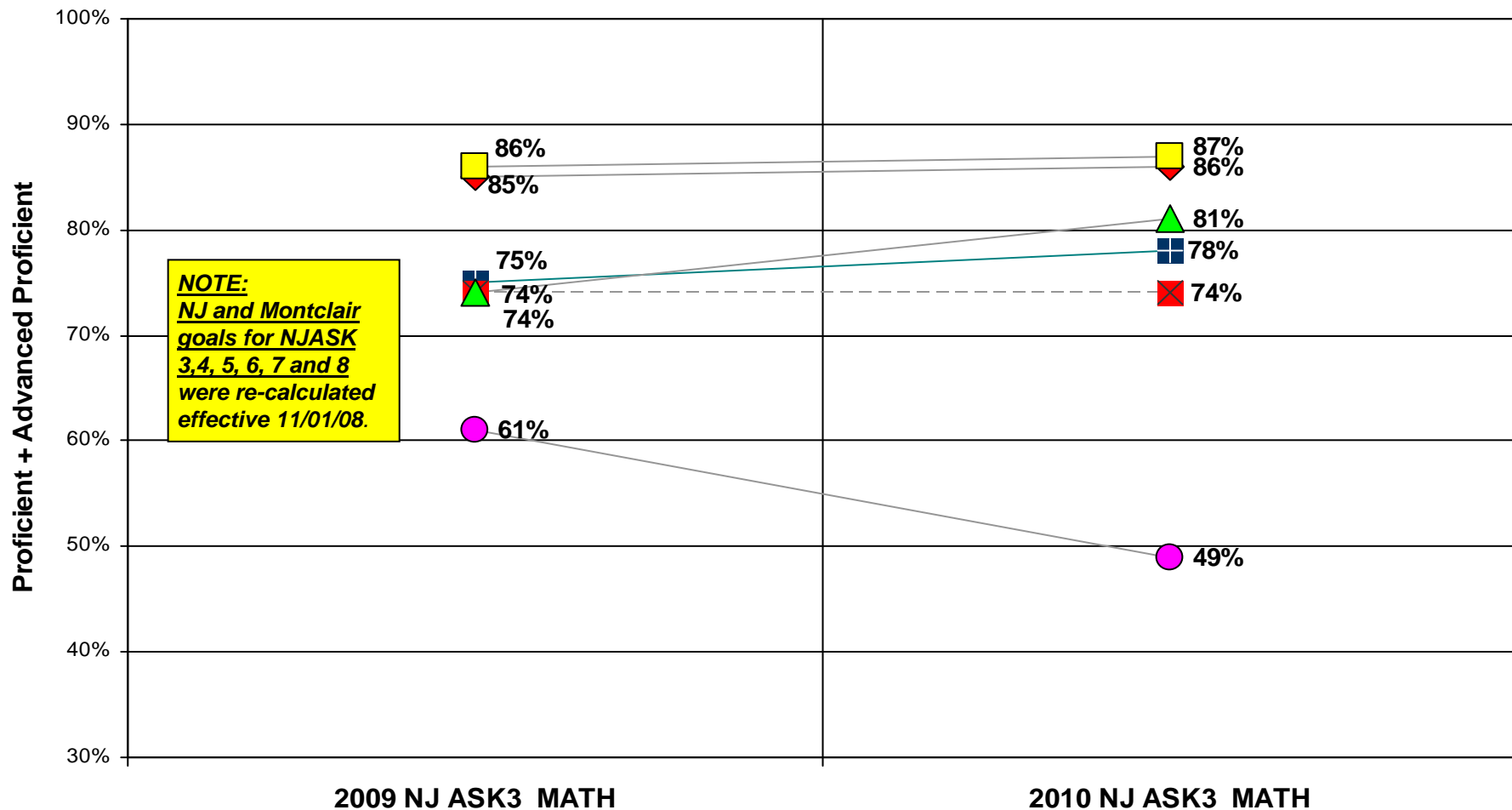


Grade 03 MATH (NJASK3) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf DISTRICT By GROUP: 2009 - 2010

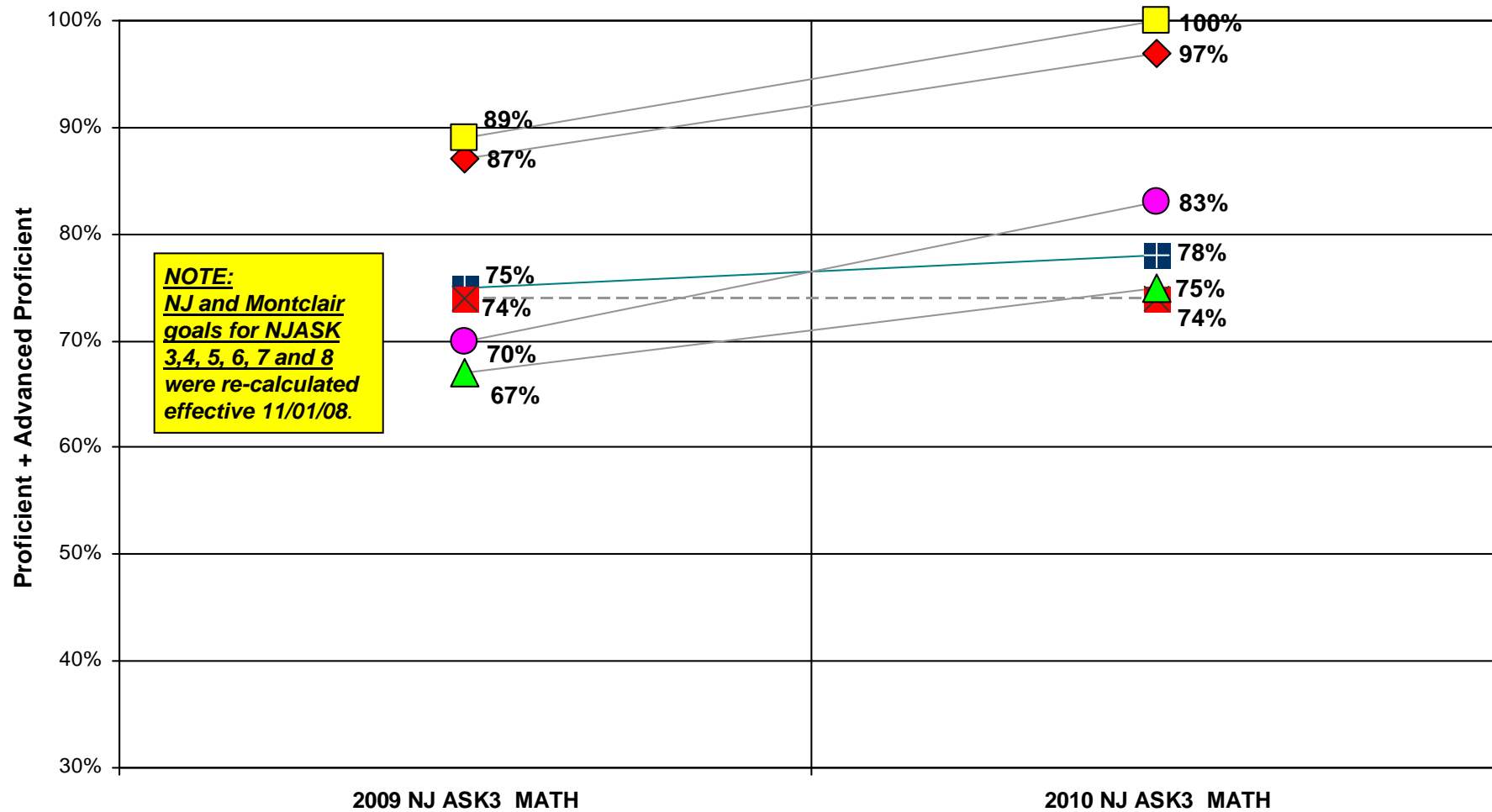

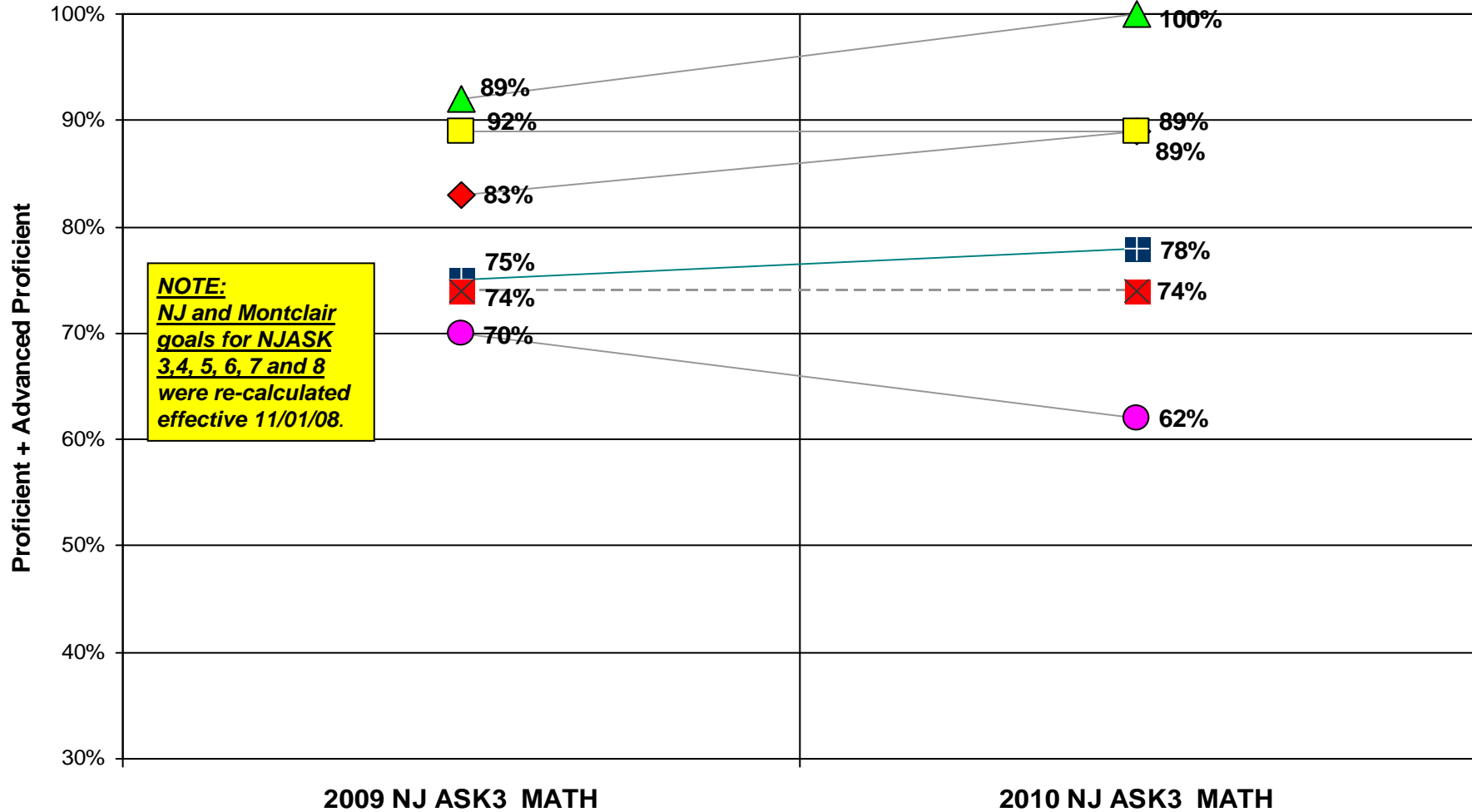


Grade 03 MATH (NJASK3) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf NORTHEAST By GROUP: 2009 - 2010

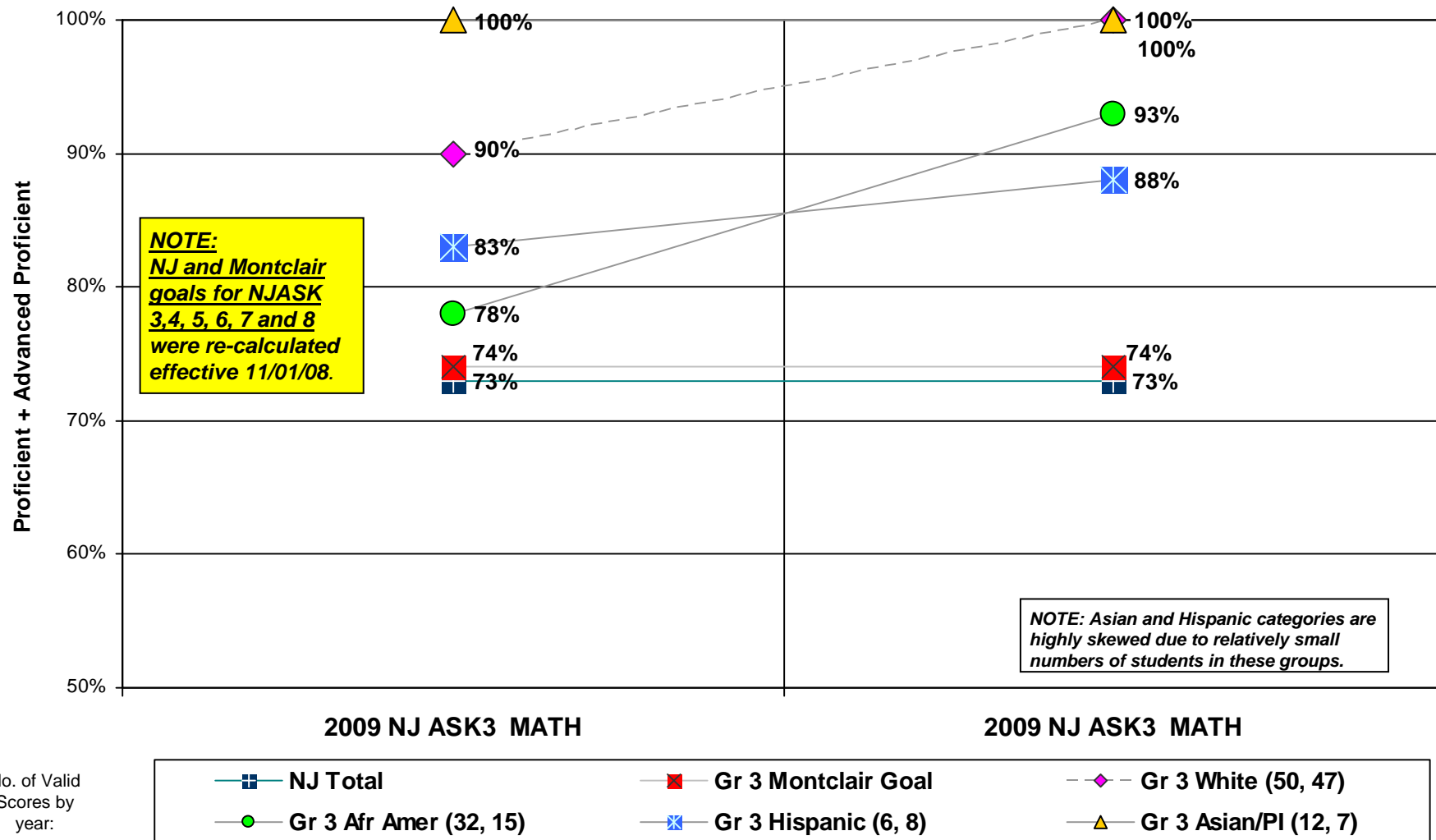


Grade 03 MATH (NJASK3) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf BRADFORD By ETHNICITY 2009 - 2010

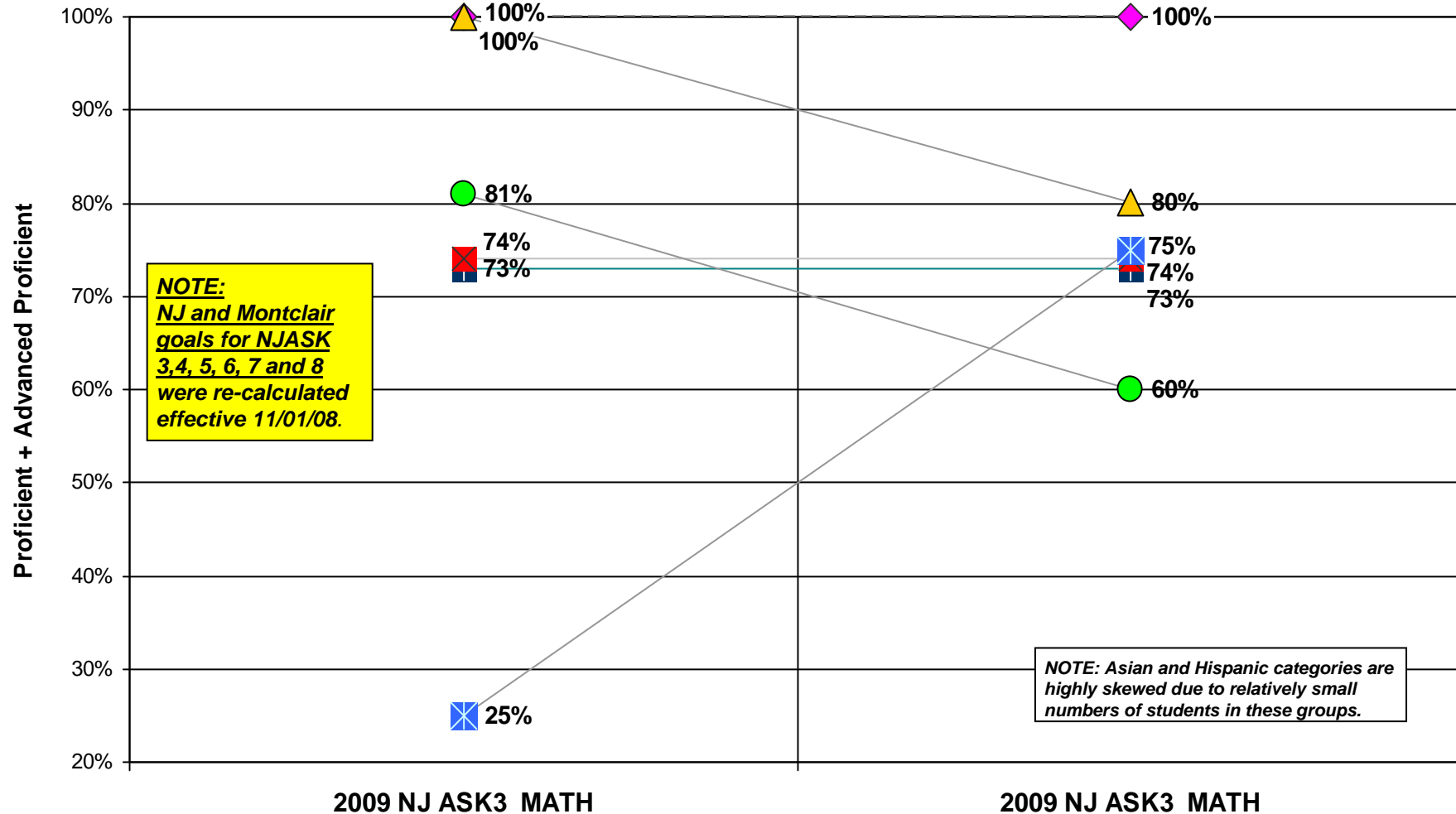


Grade 03 MATH (NJASK3) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf EDGEMONT By ETHNICITY 2009 - 2010

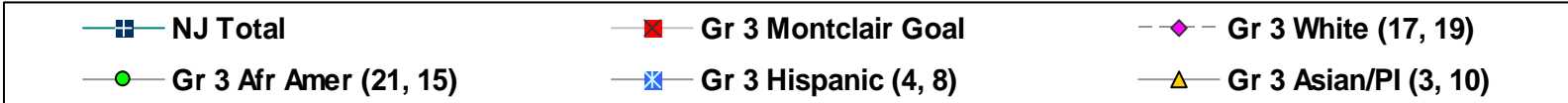

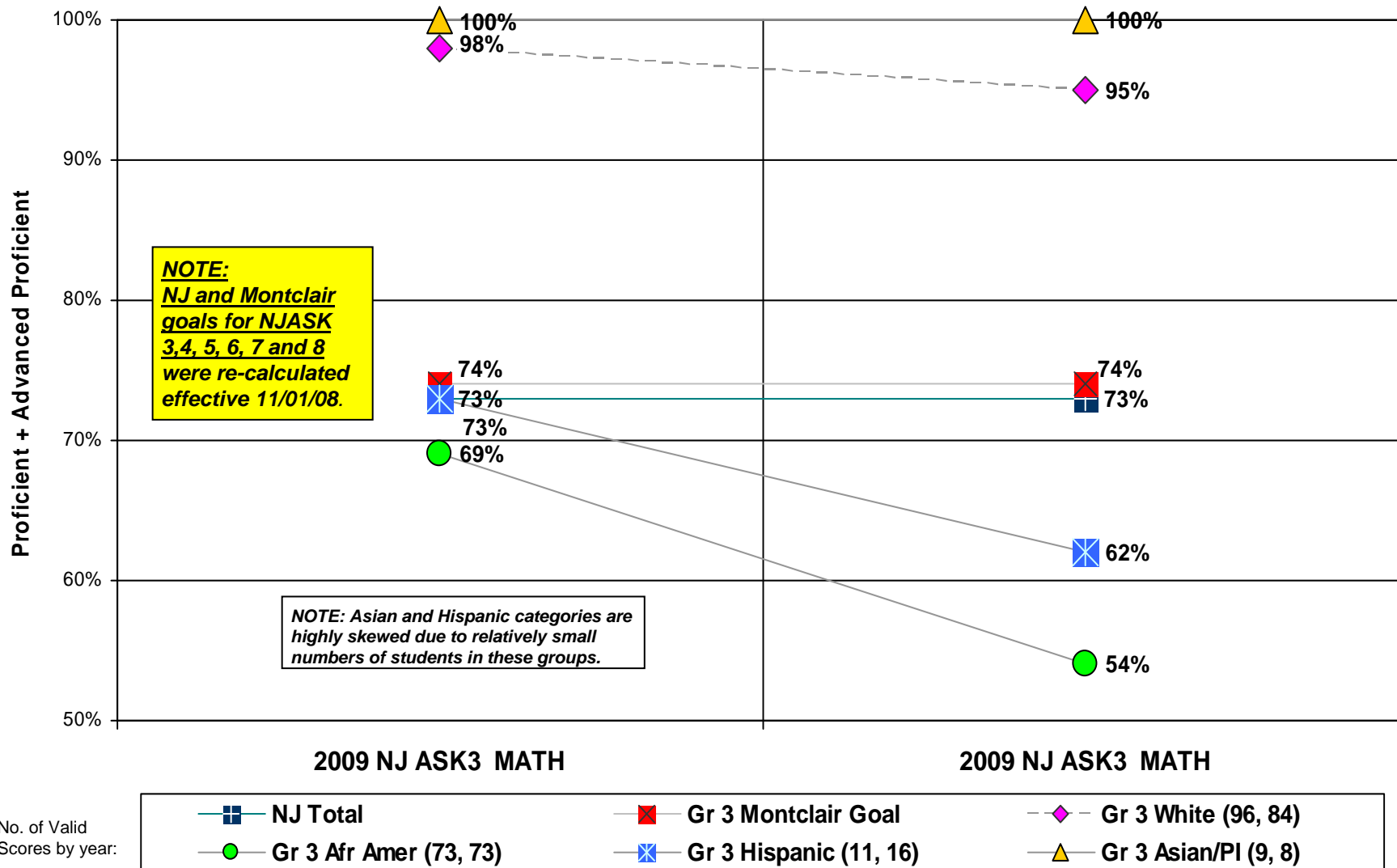


Grade 03 MATH (NJASK3) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf HILLSIDE By ETHNICITY 2009 - 2010

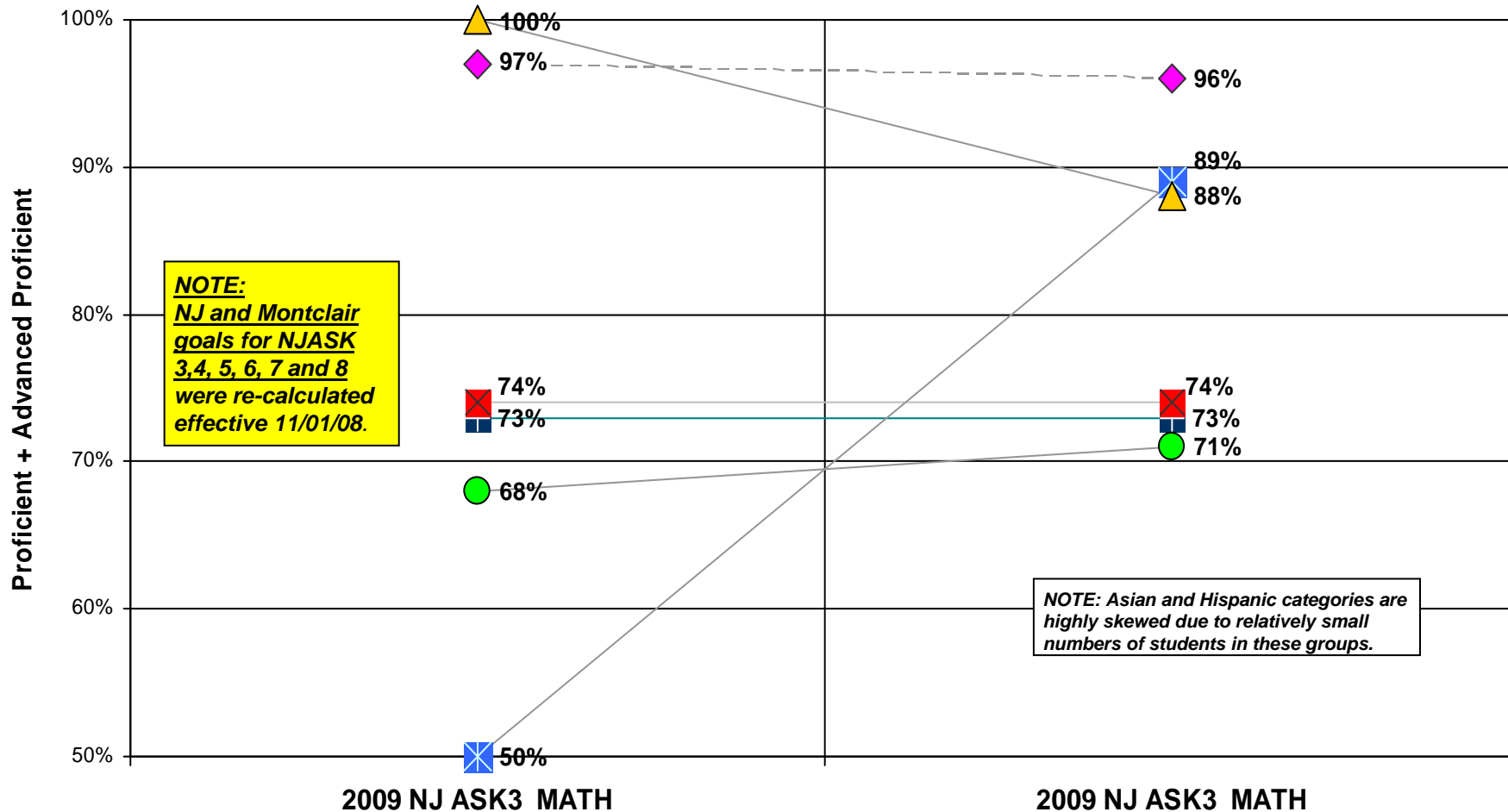


Grade 03 MATH (NJASK3) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf NORTHEAST By ETHNICITY 2009 - 2010

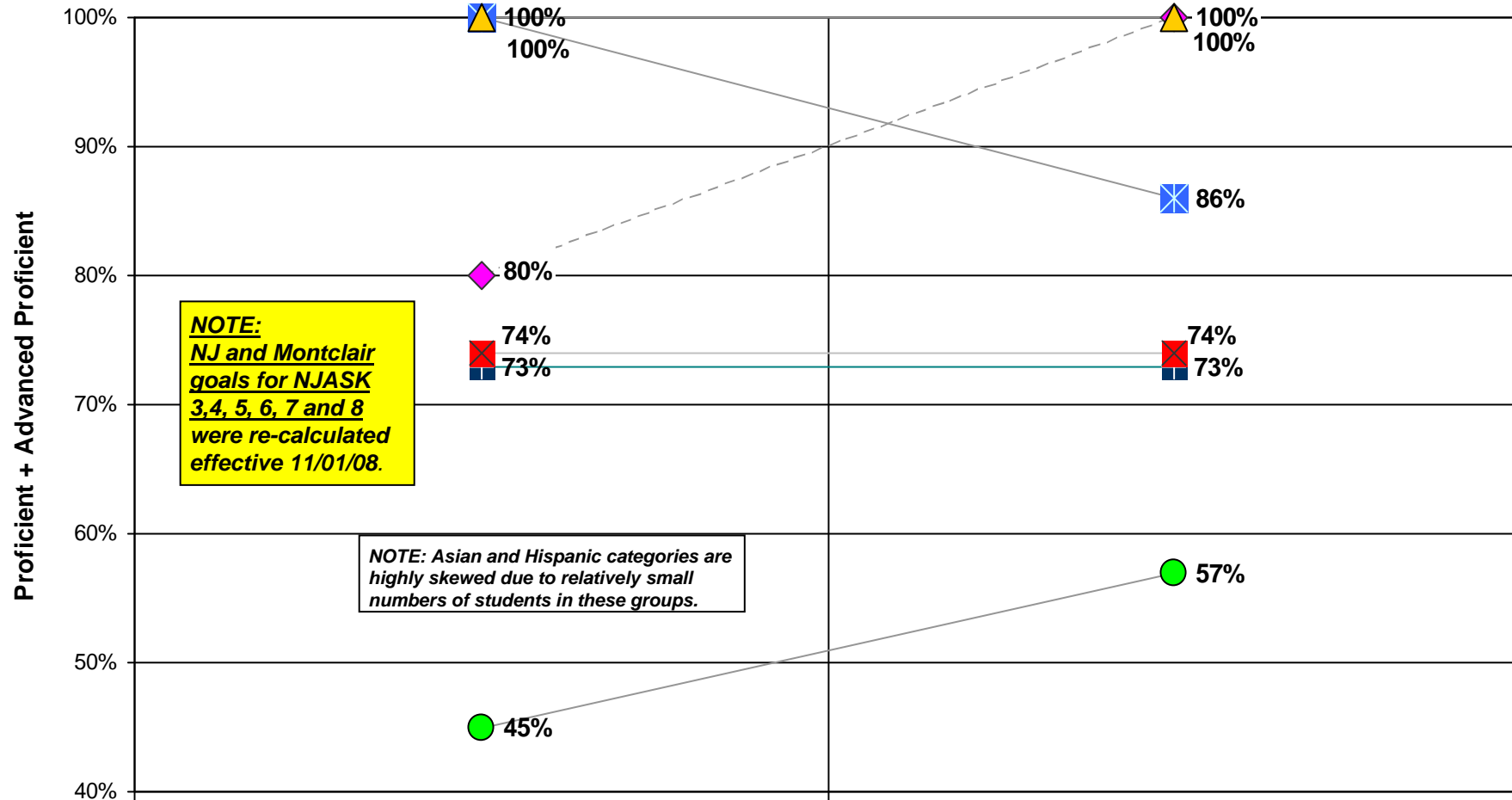

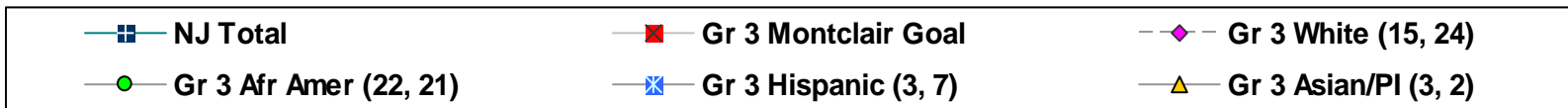

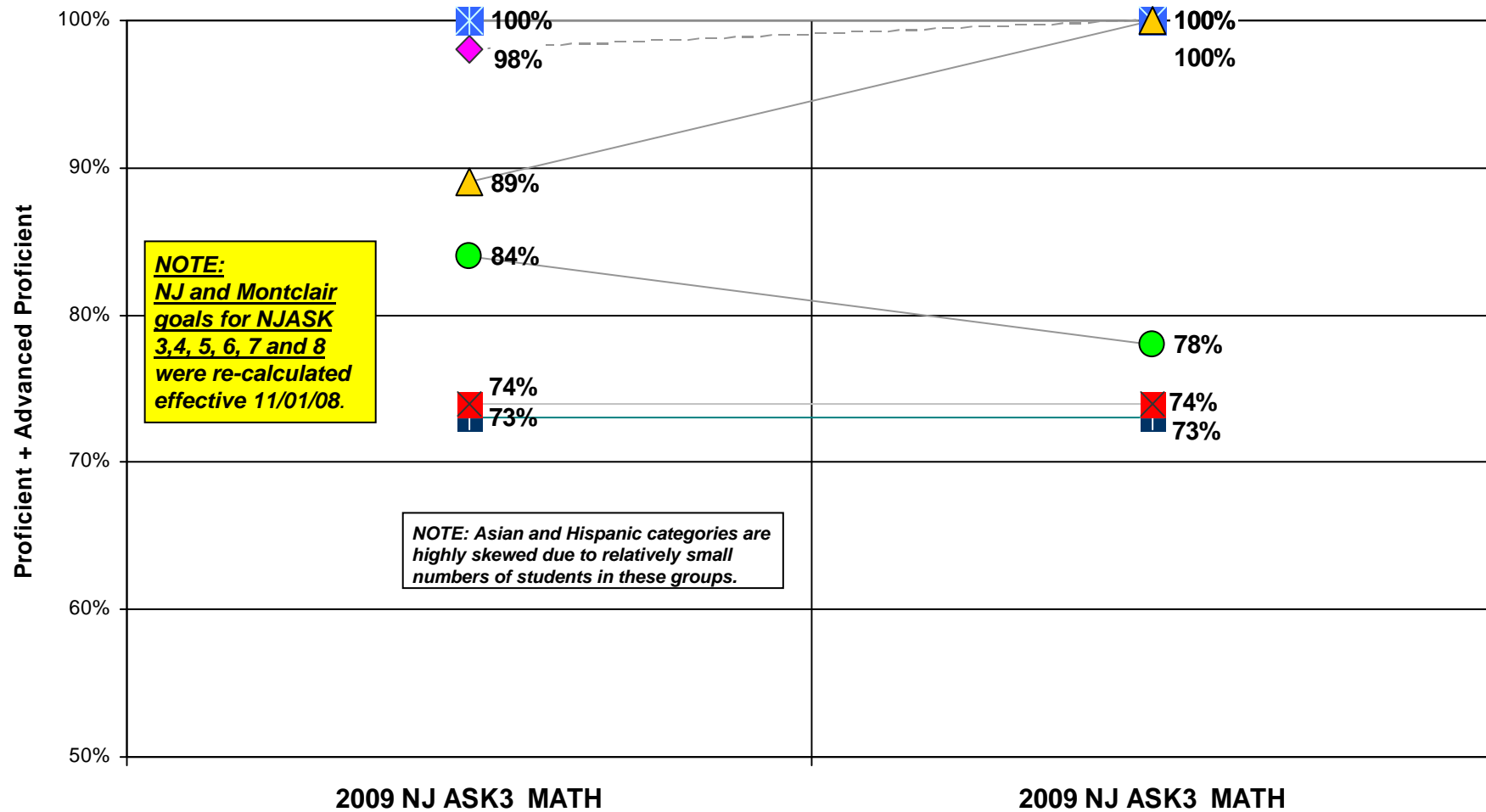


Grade 03 MATH (NJASK3) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf WATCHUNG By ETHNICITY 2009 - 2010

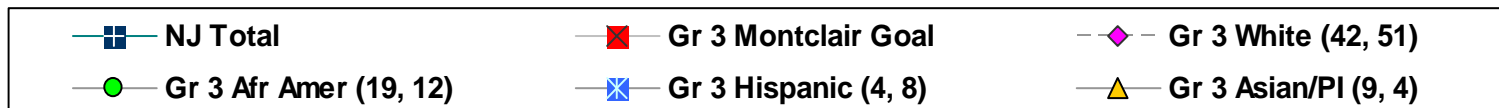

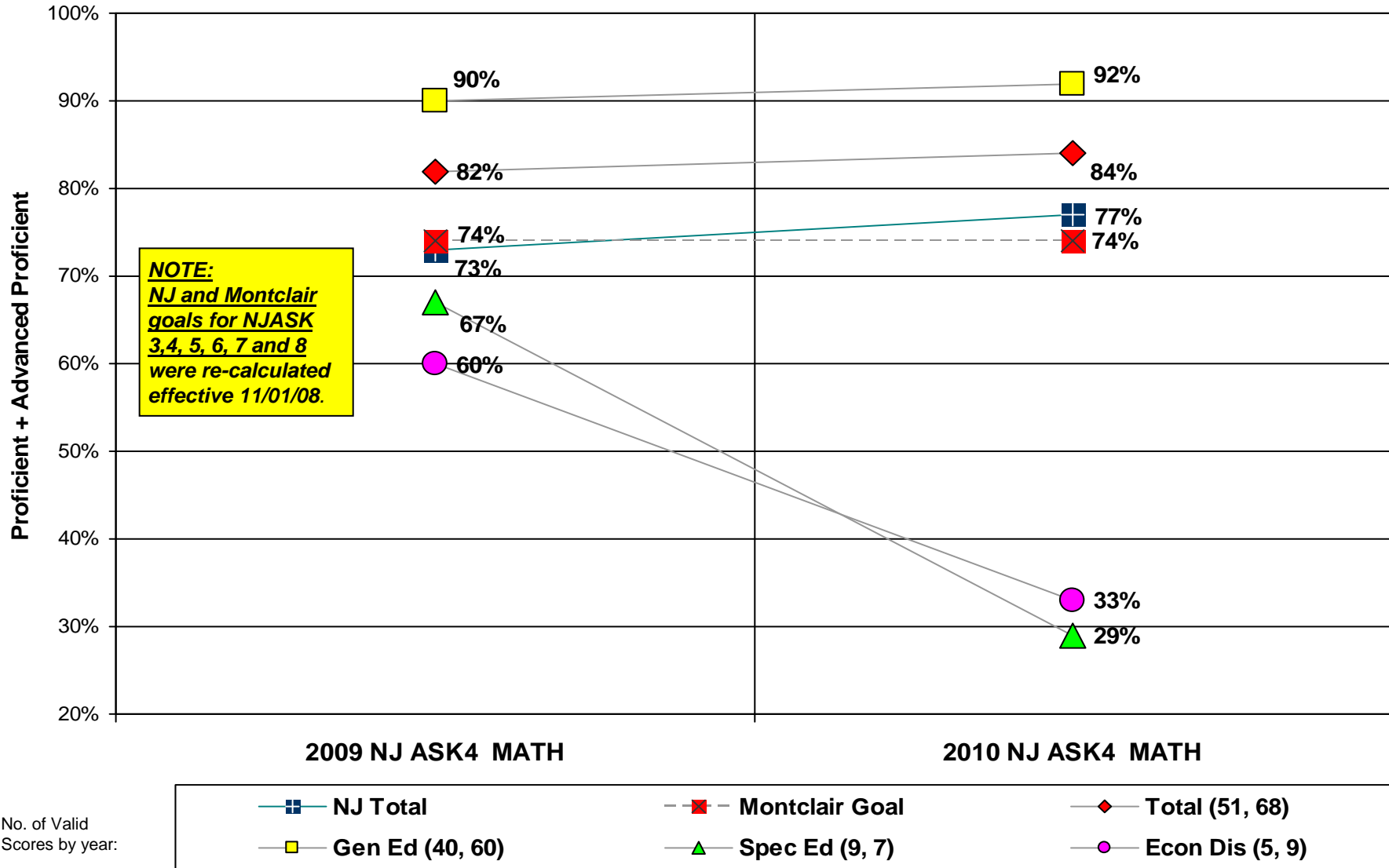


Grade 04 MATH (NJASK4) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf NORTHEAST By GROUP: 2009 - 2010

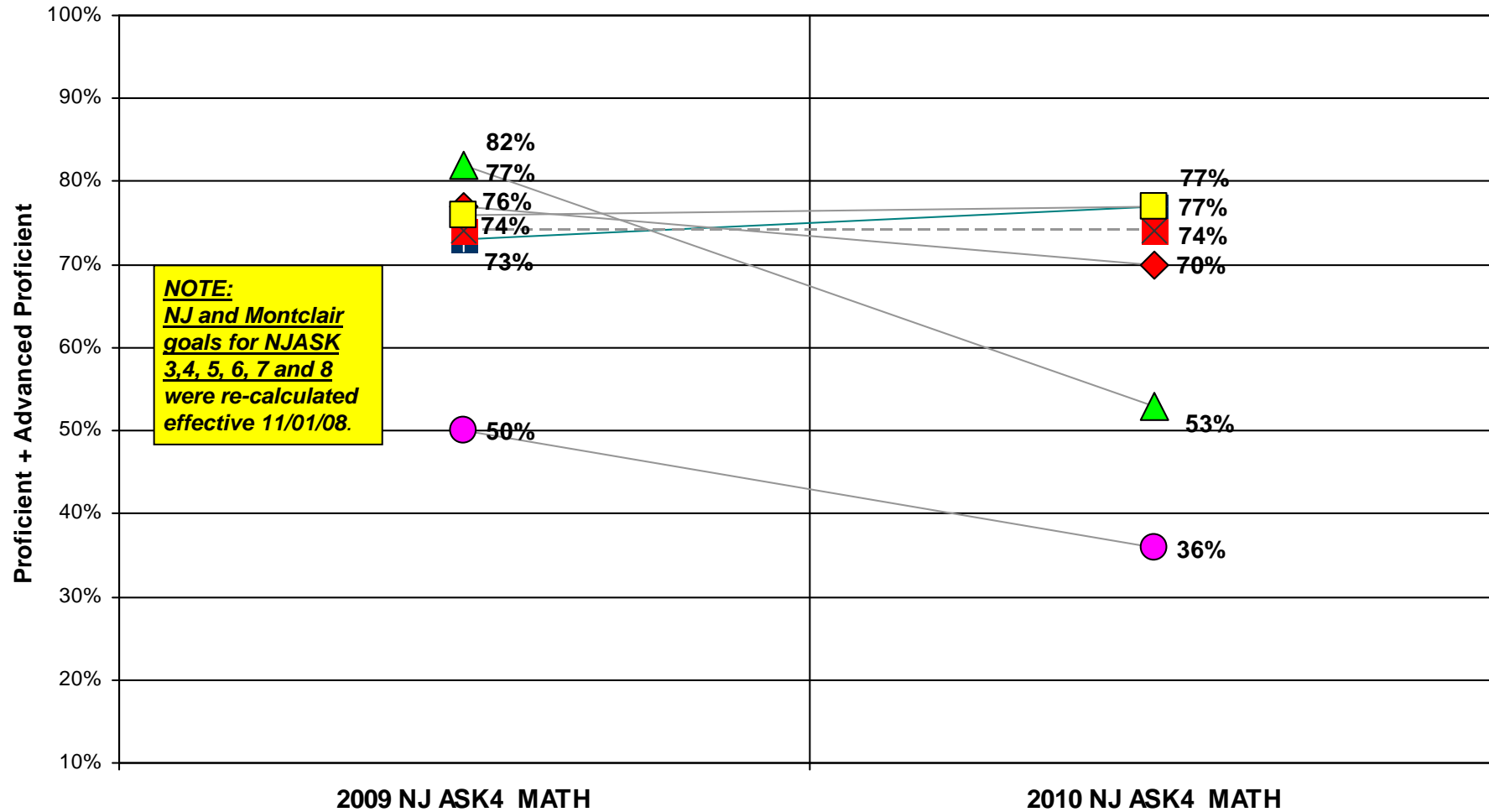


Grade 04 MATH (NJASK4) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf RAND By GROUP: 2009 - 2010

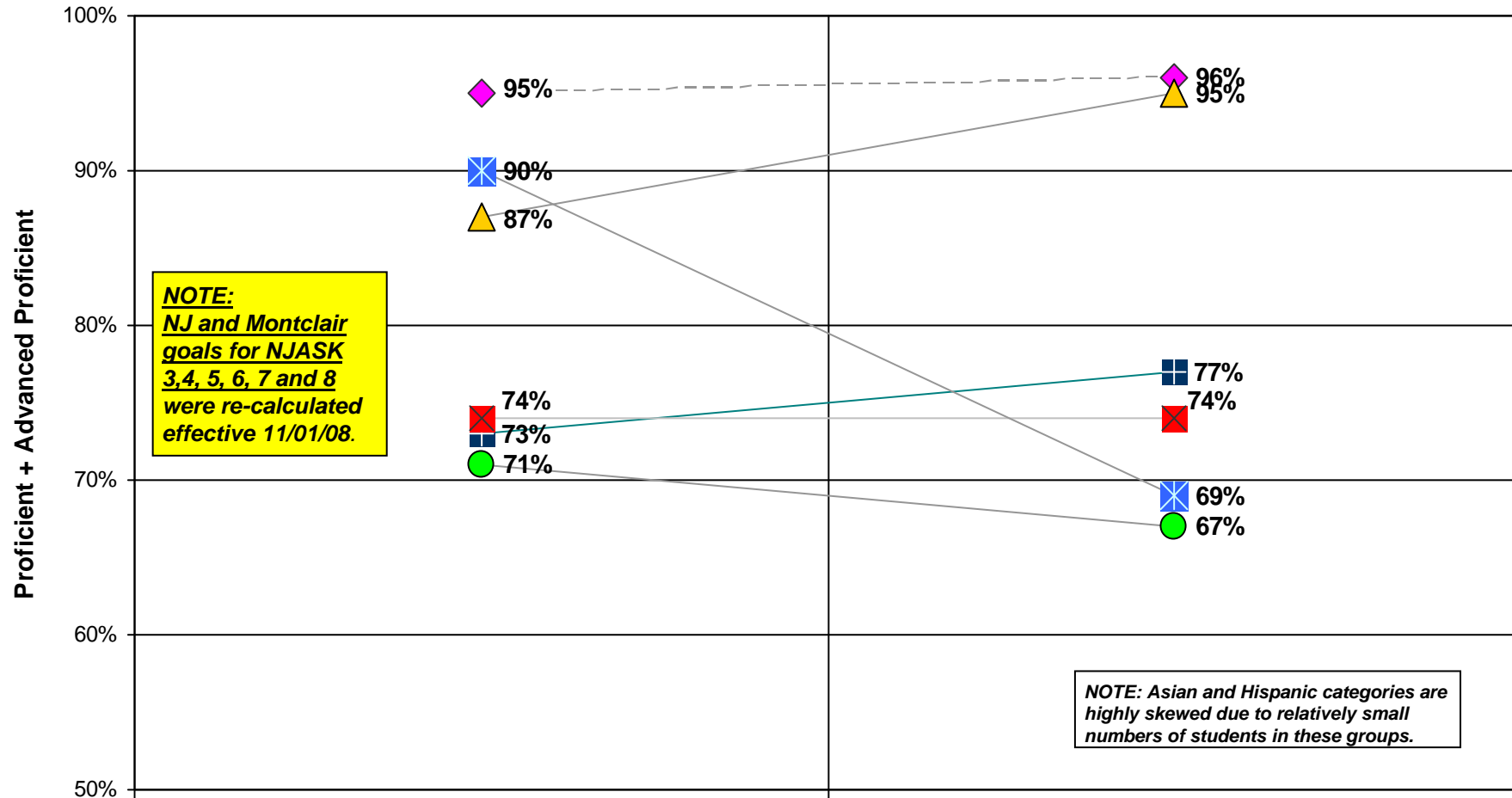

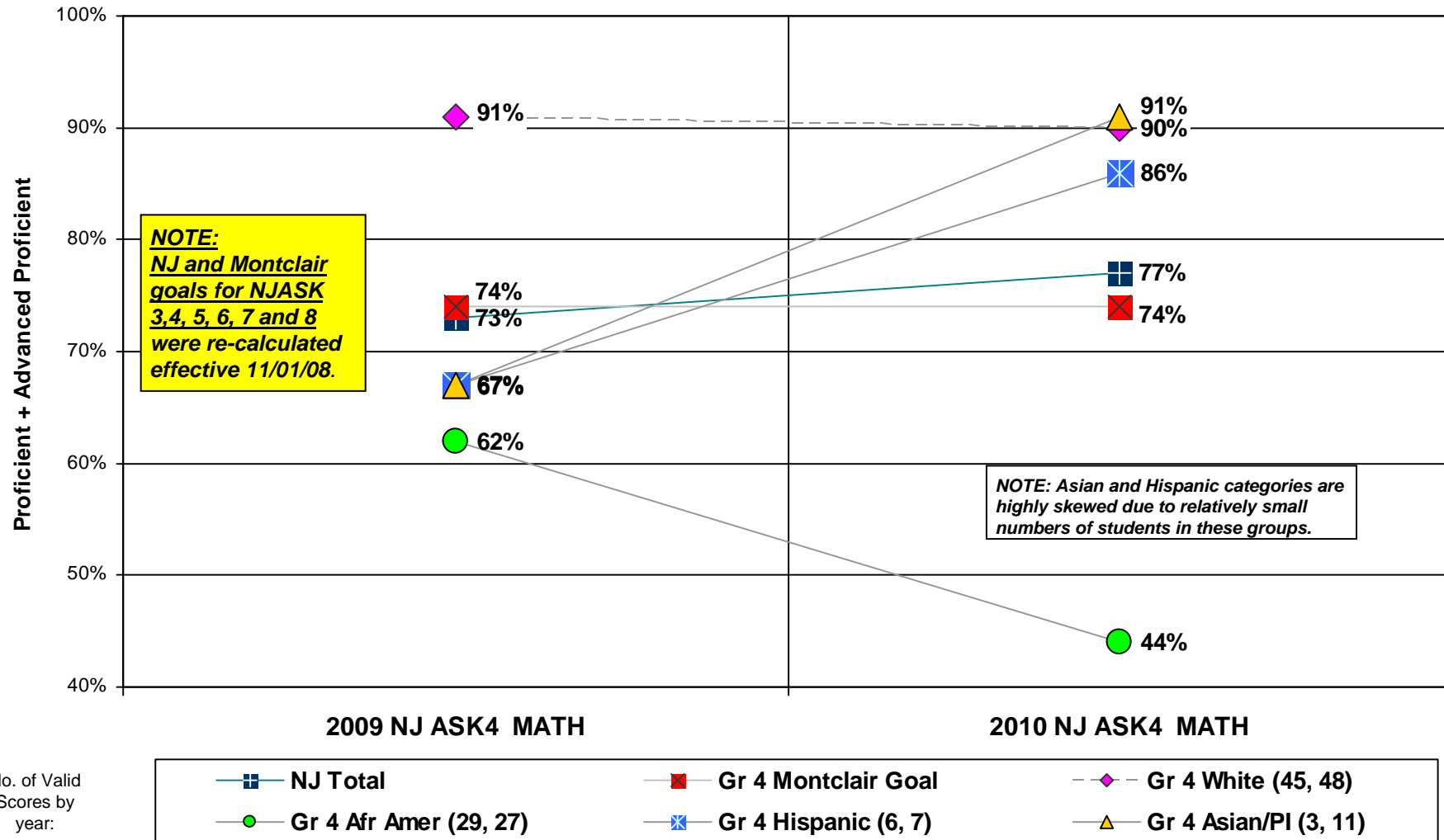


Grade 04 MATH (NJASK4) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf BRADFORD By ETHNICITY 2009 - 2010

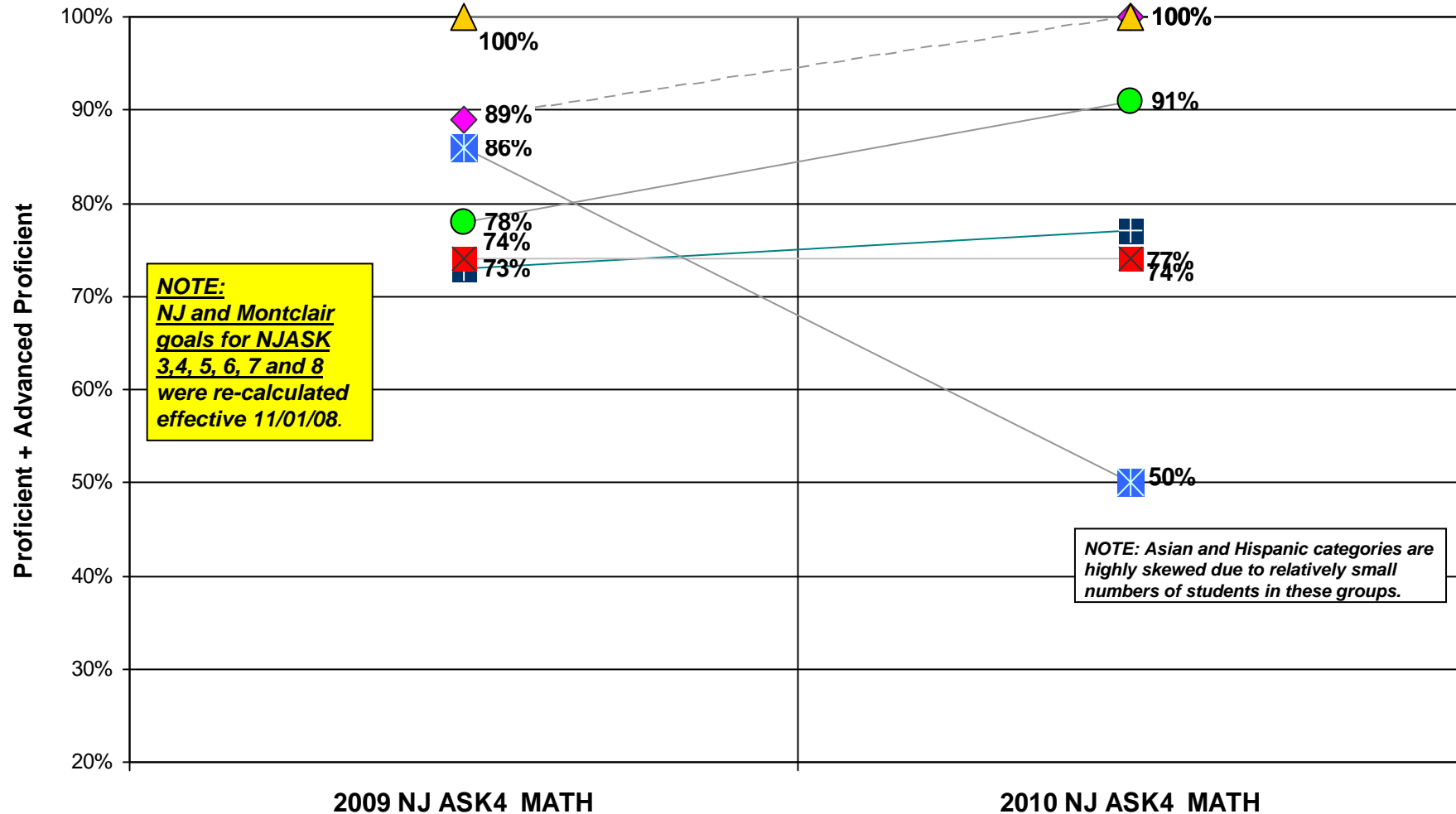


Grade 04 MATH (NJASK4) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf EDGEMONT By ETHNICITY 2009 - 2010

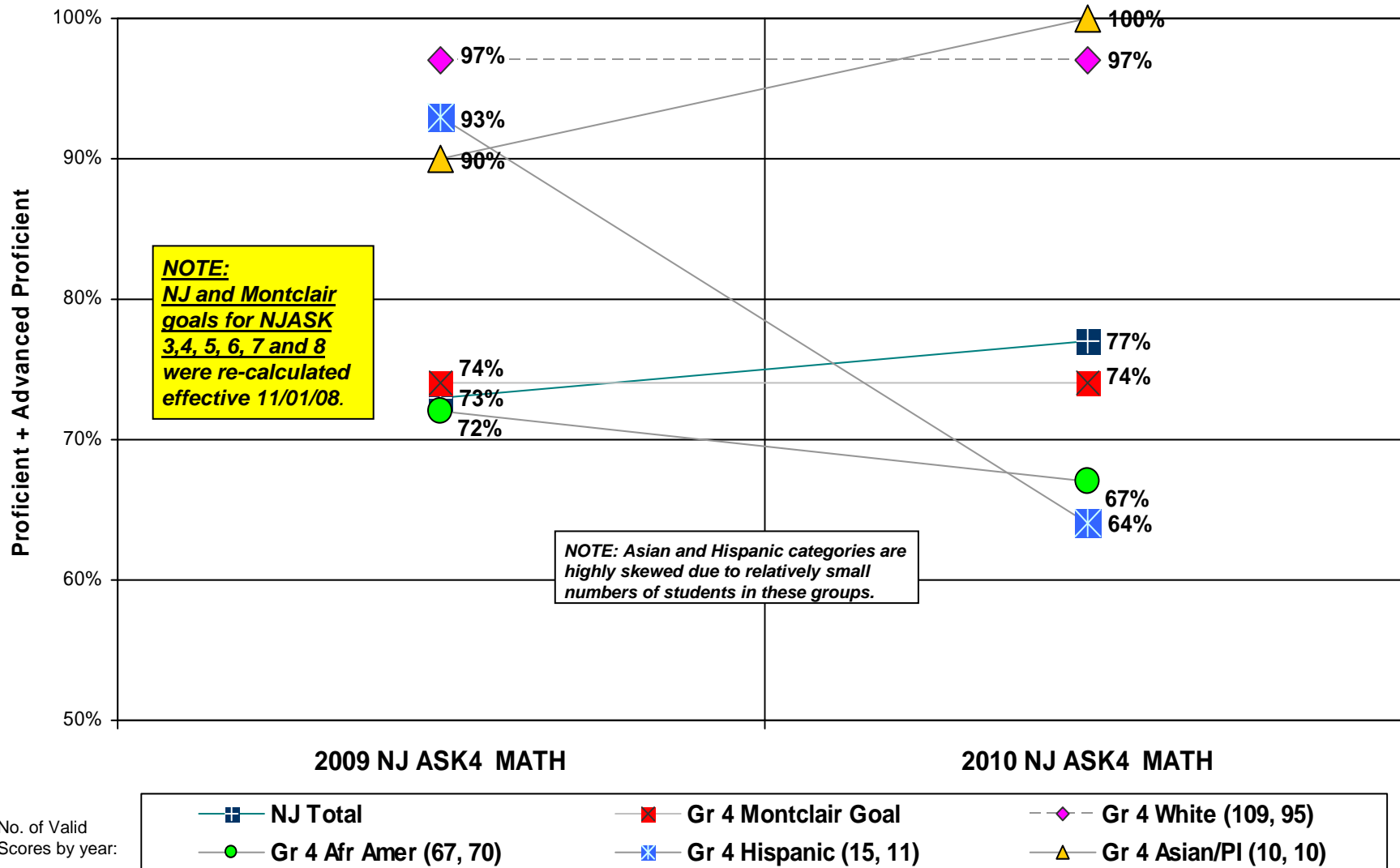


Grade 04 MATH (NJASK4) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf HILLSIDE By ETHNICITY 2009 - 2010

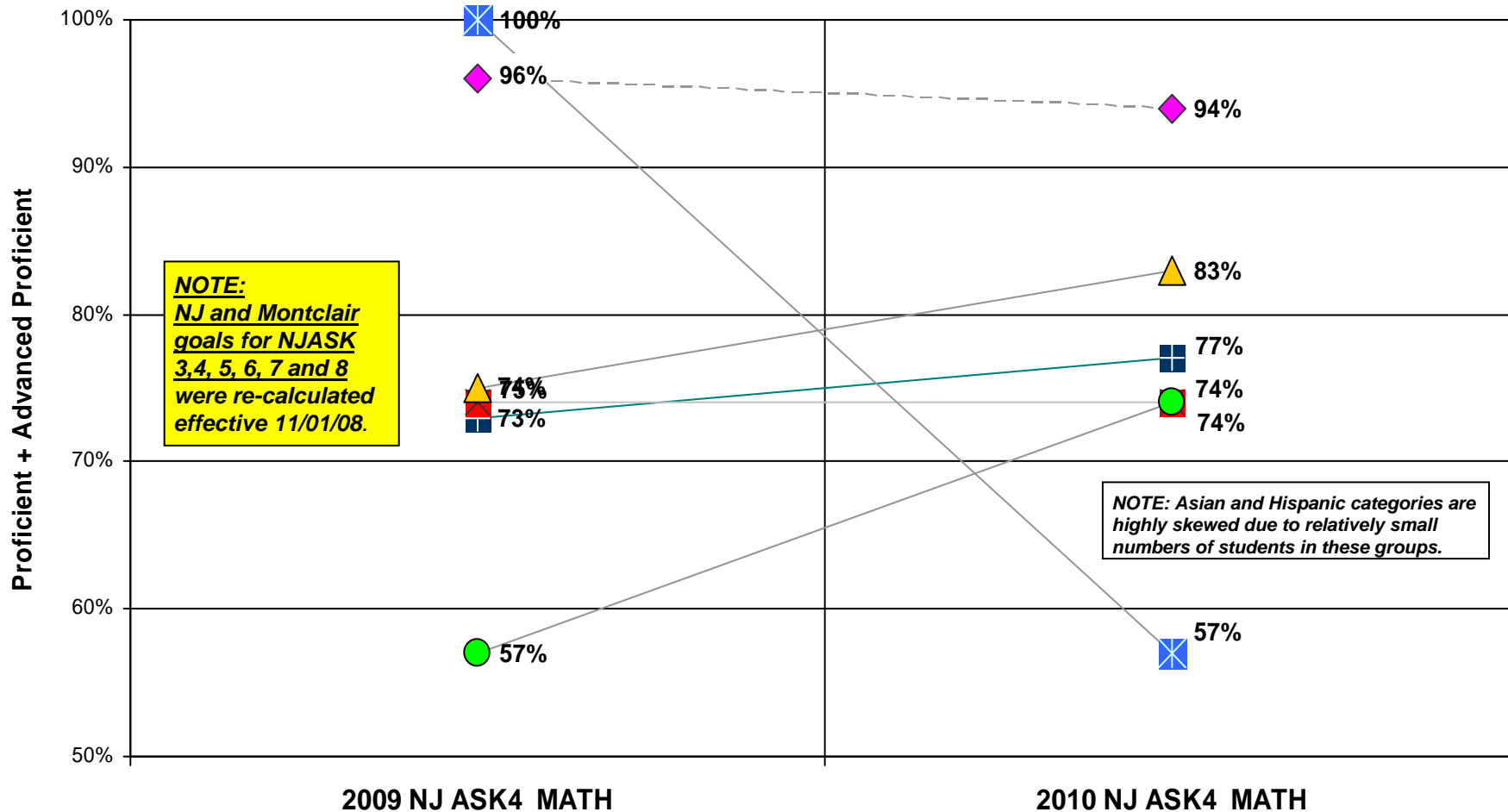


Grade 04 MATH (NJASK4) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf NORTHEAST By ETHNICITY 2009 - 2010

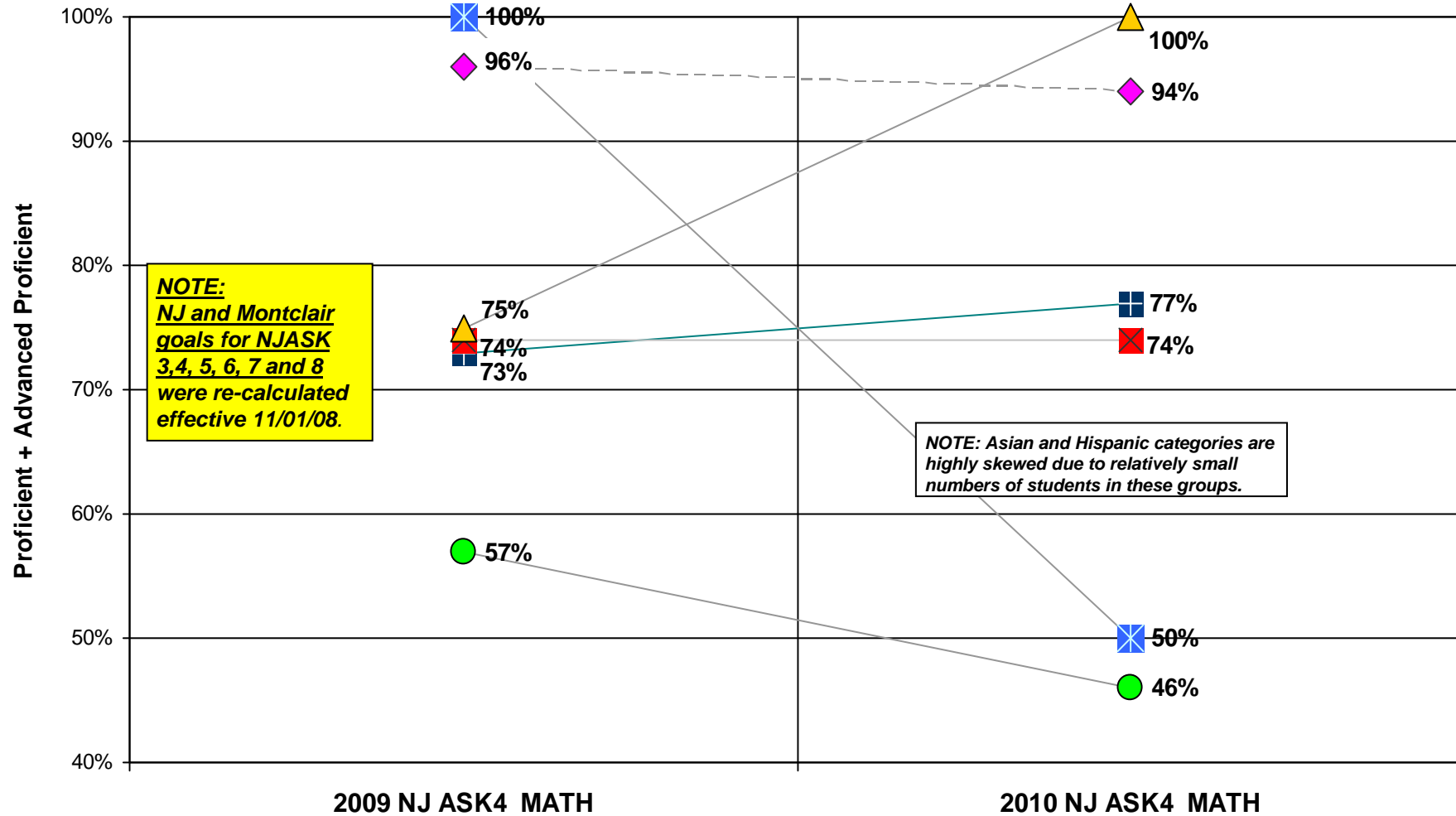

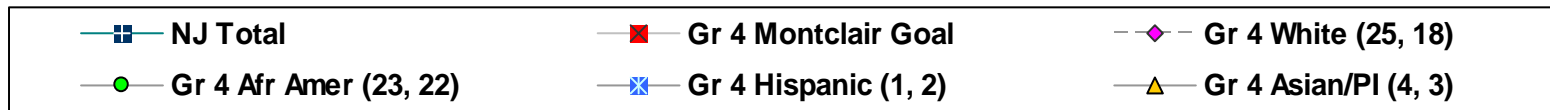

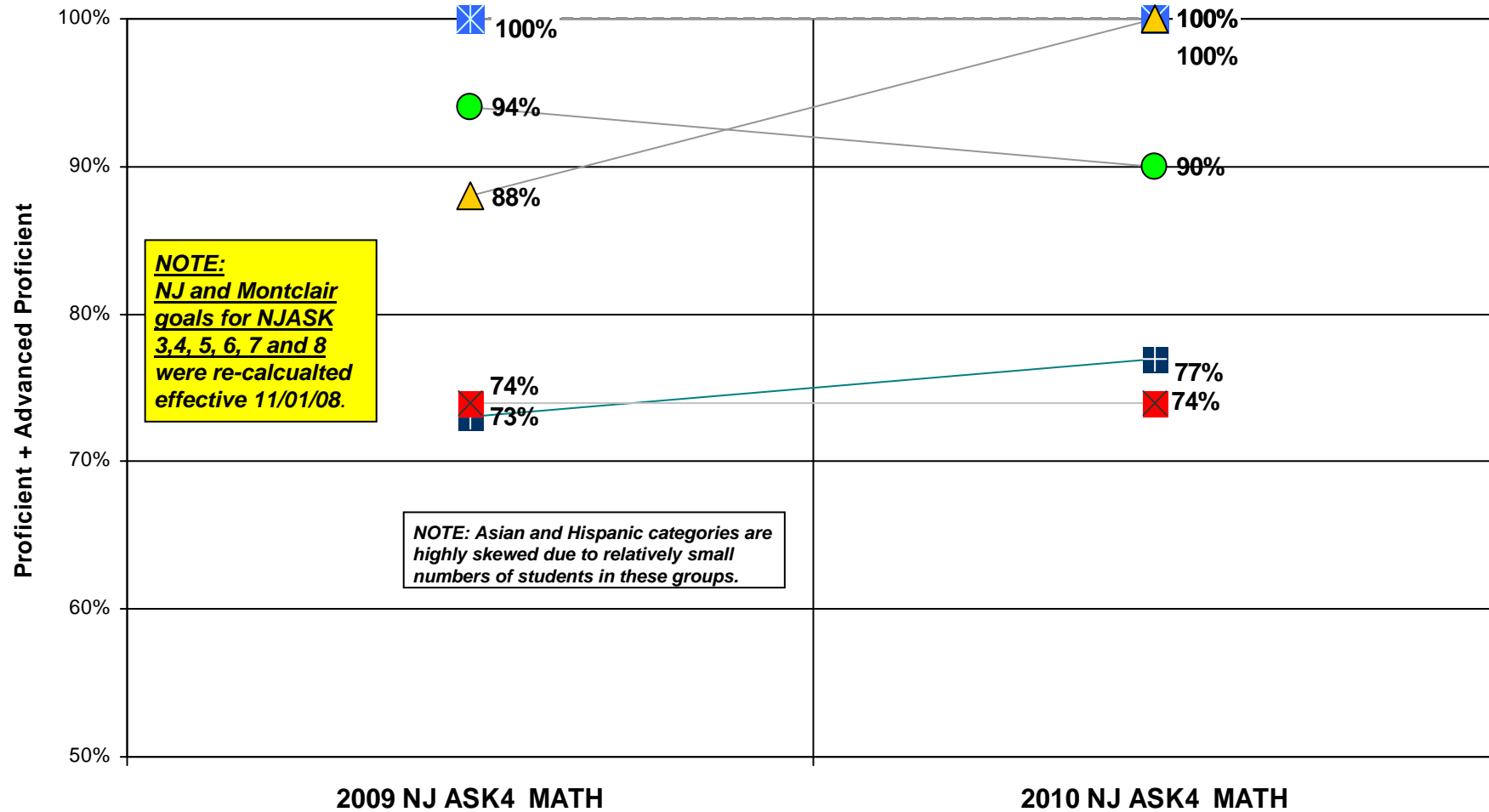


Grade 04 MATH (NJASK4) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf WATCHUNG By ETHNICITY 2009 - 2010

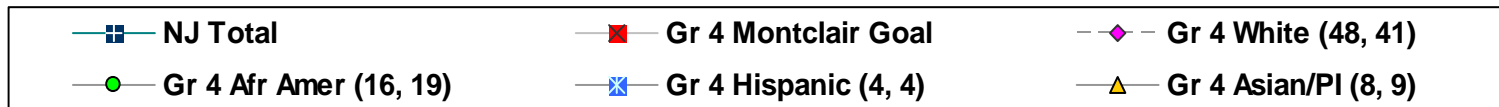

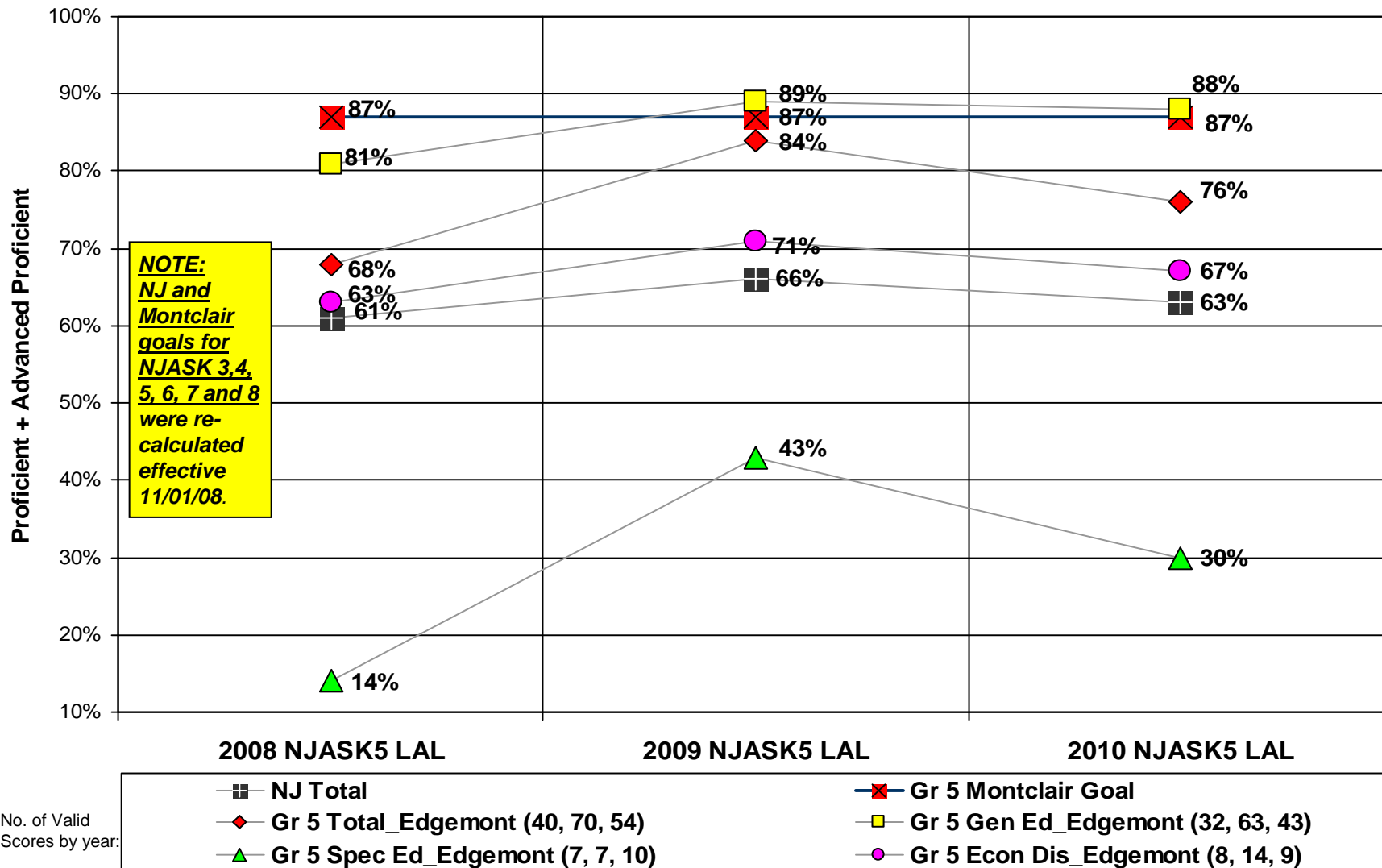

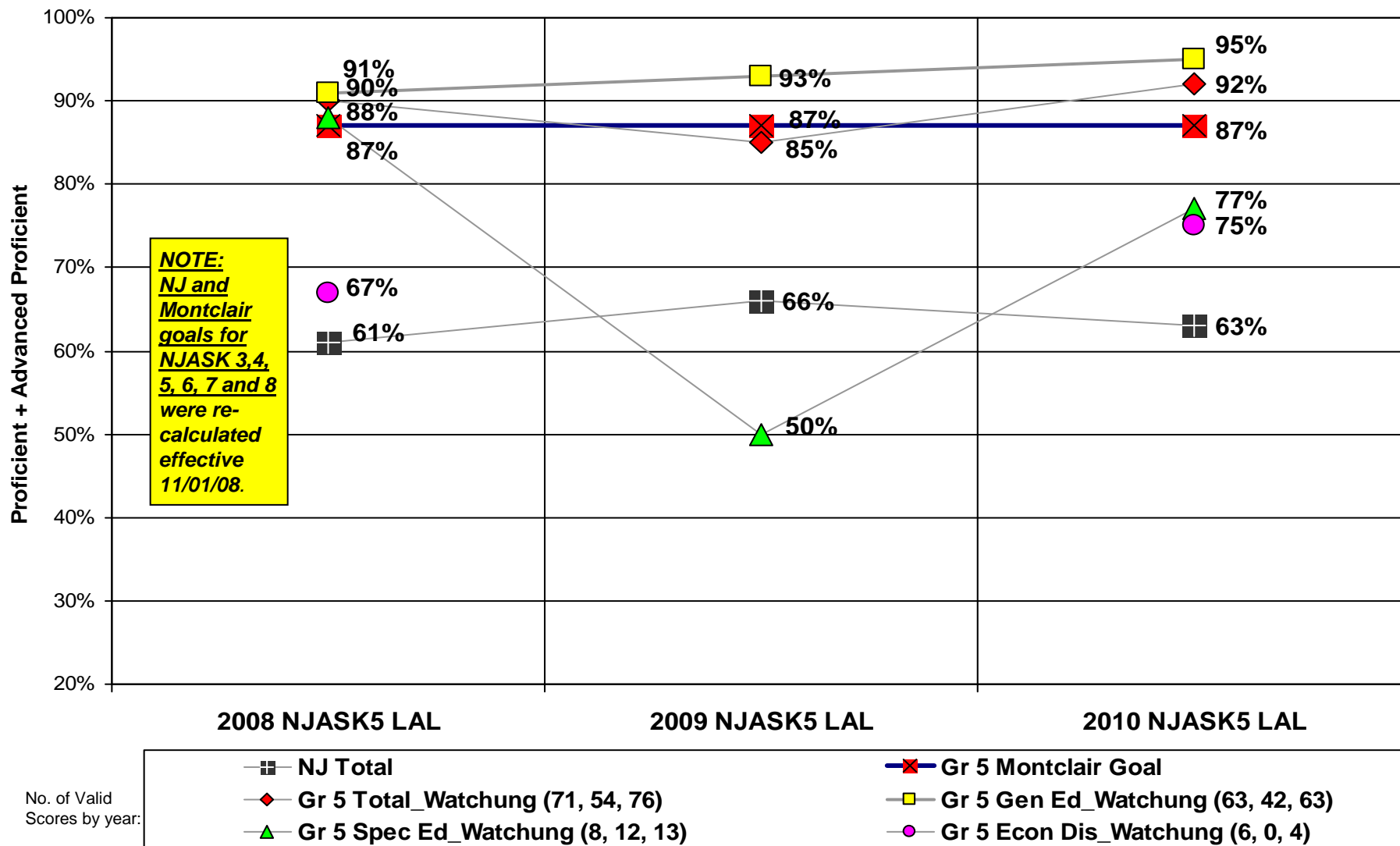

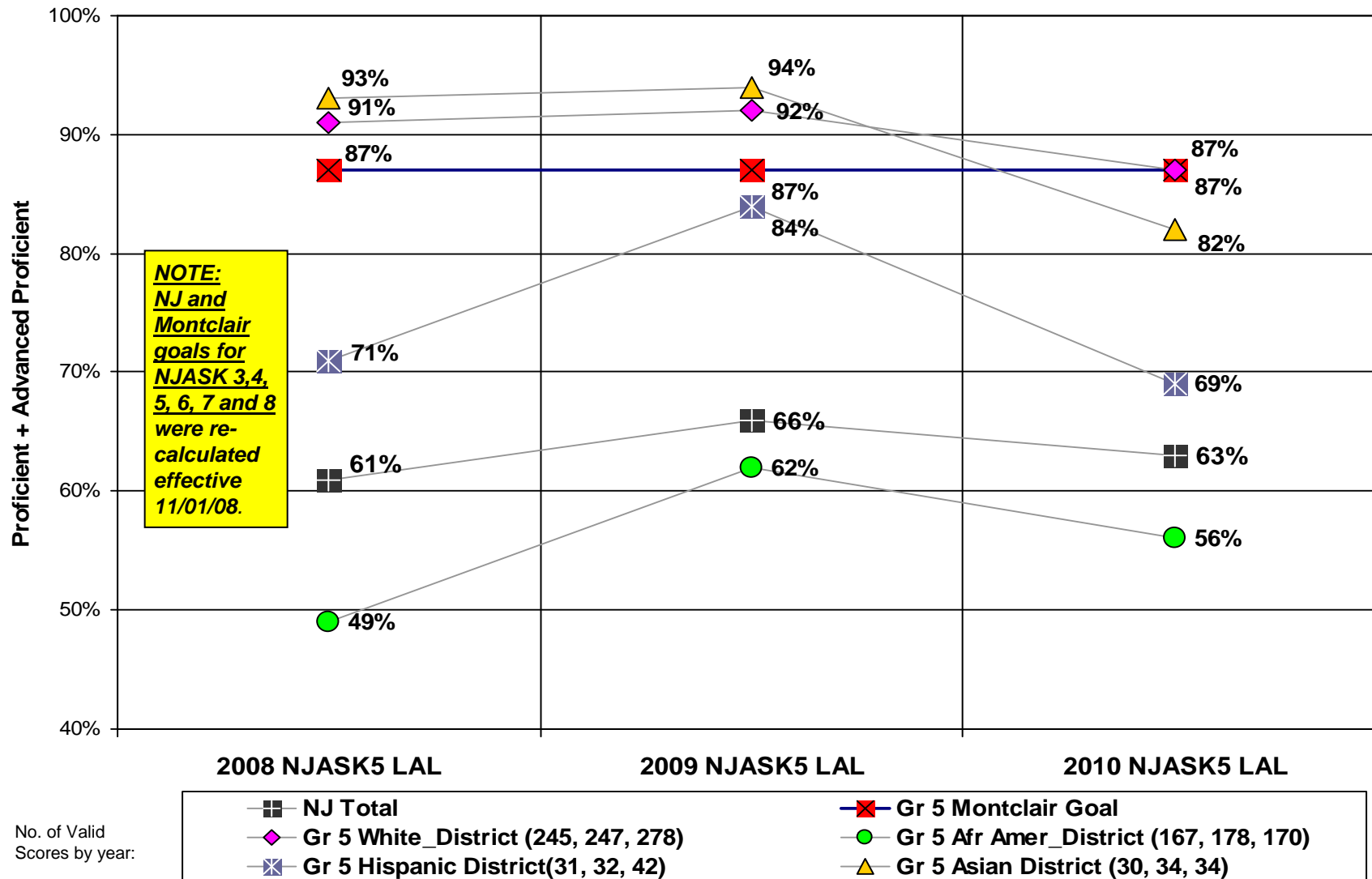

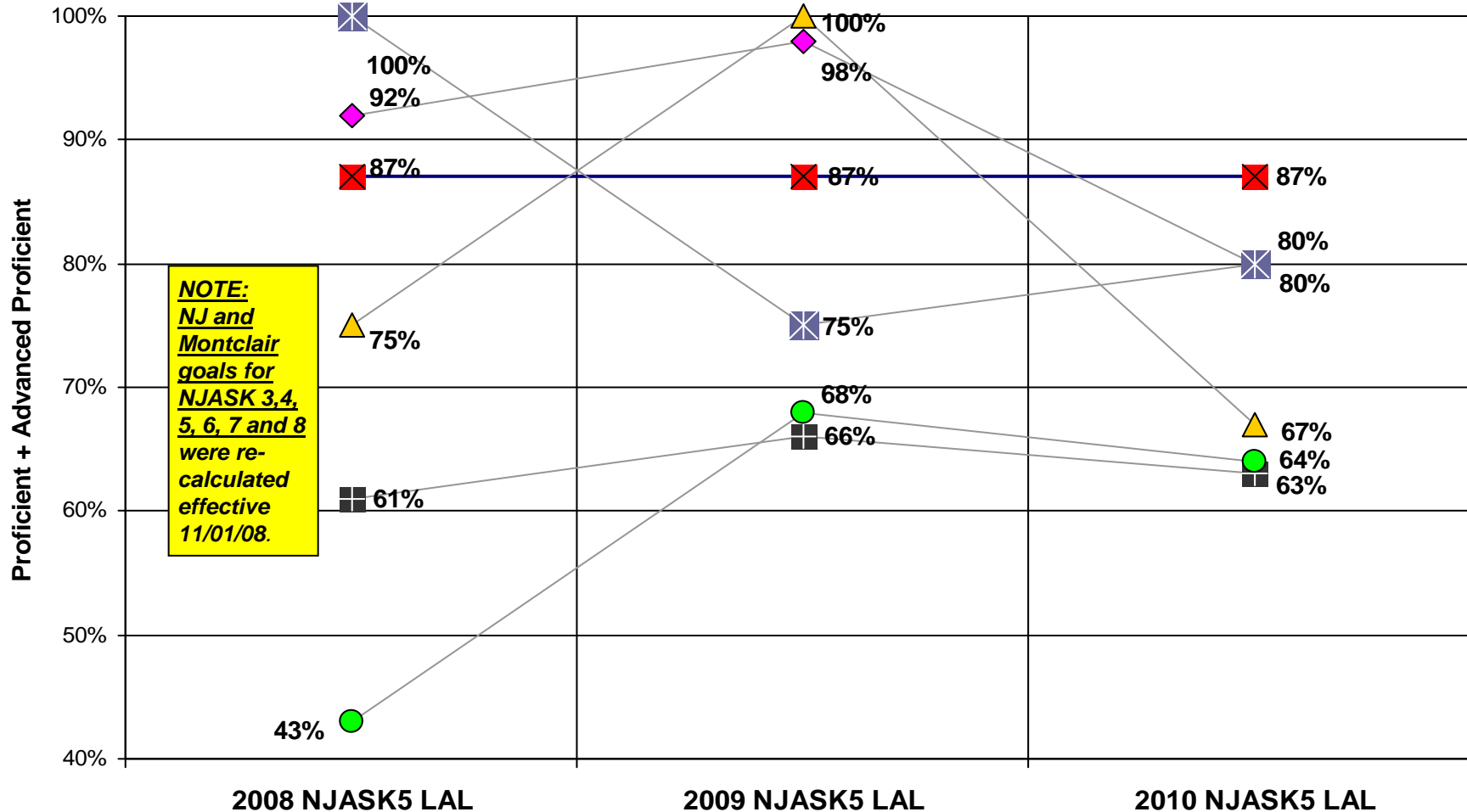

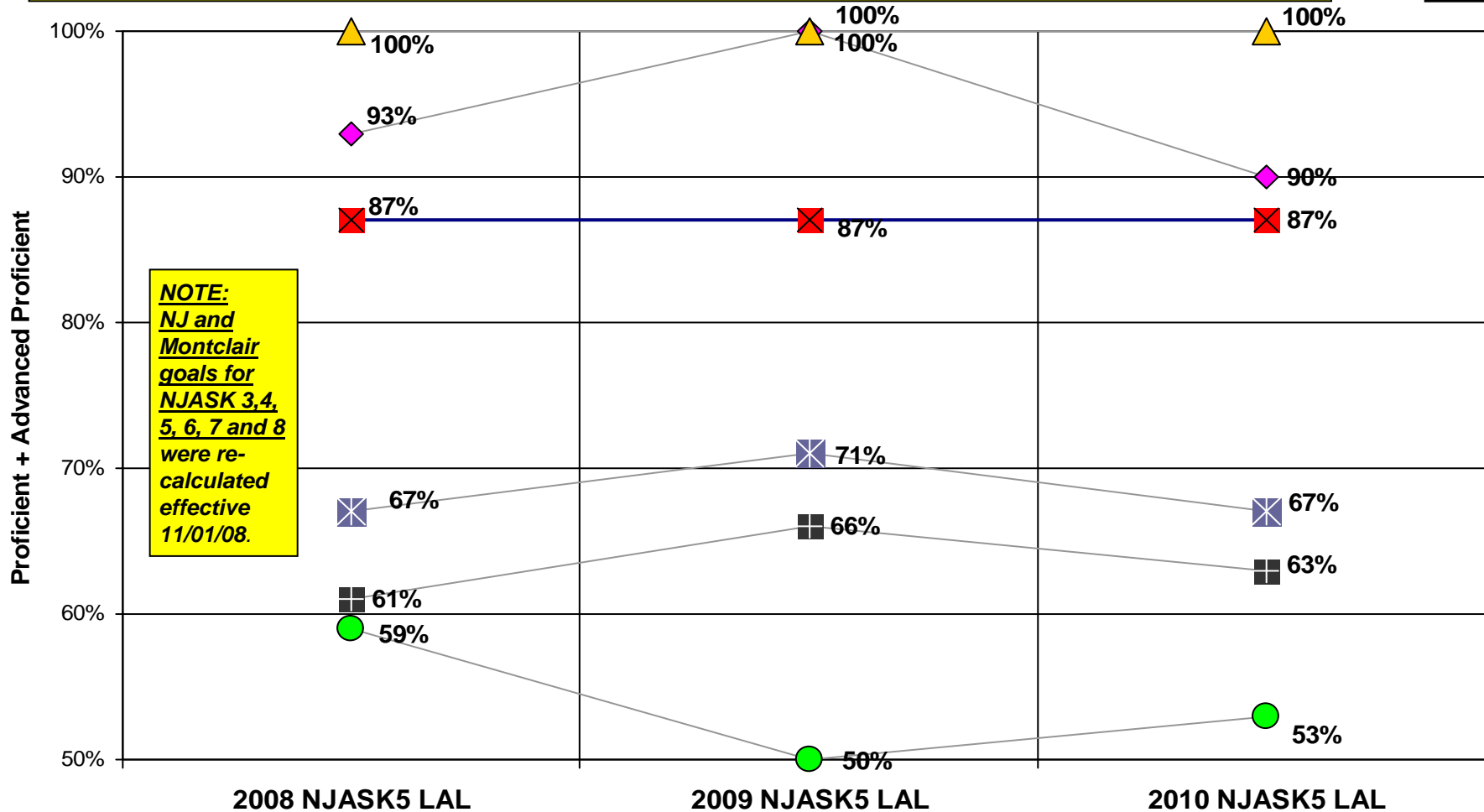

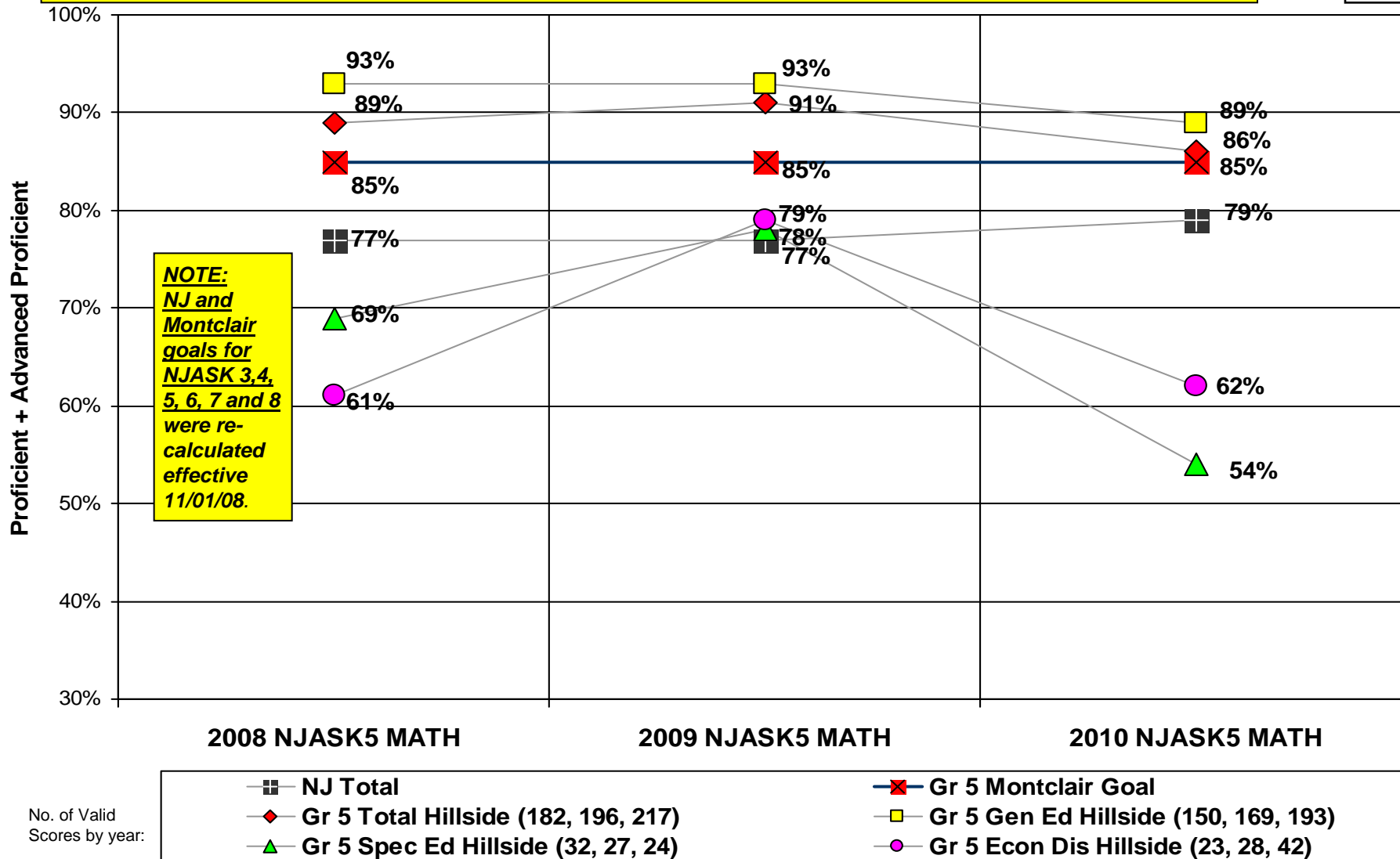


Grade 05 MATH (NJASK5) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf HILLSIDE By GROUP: 2008 - 2010

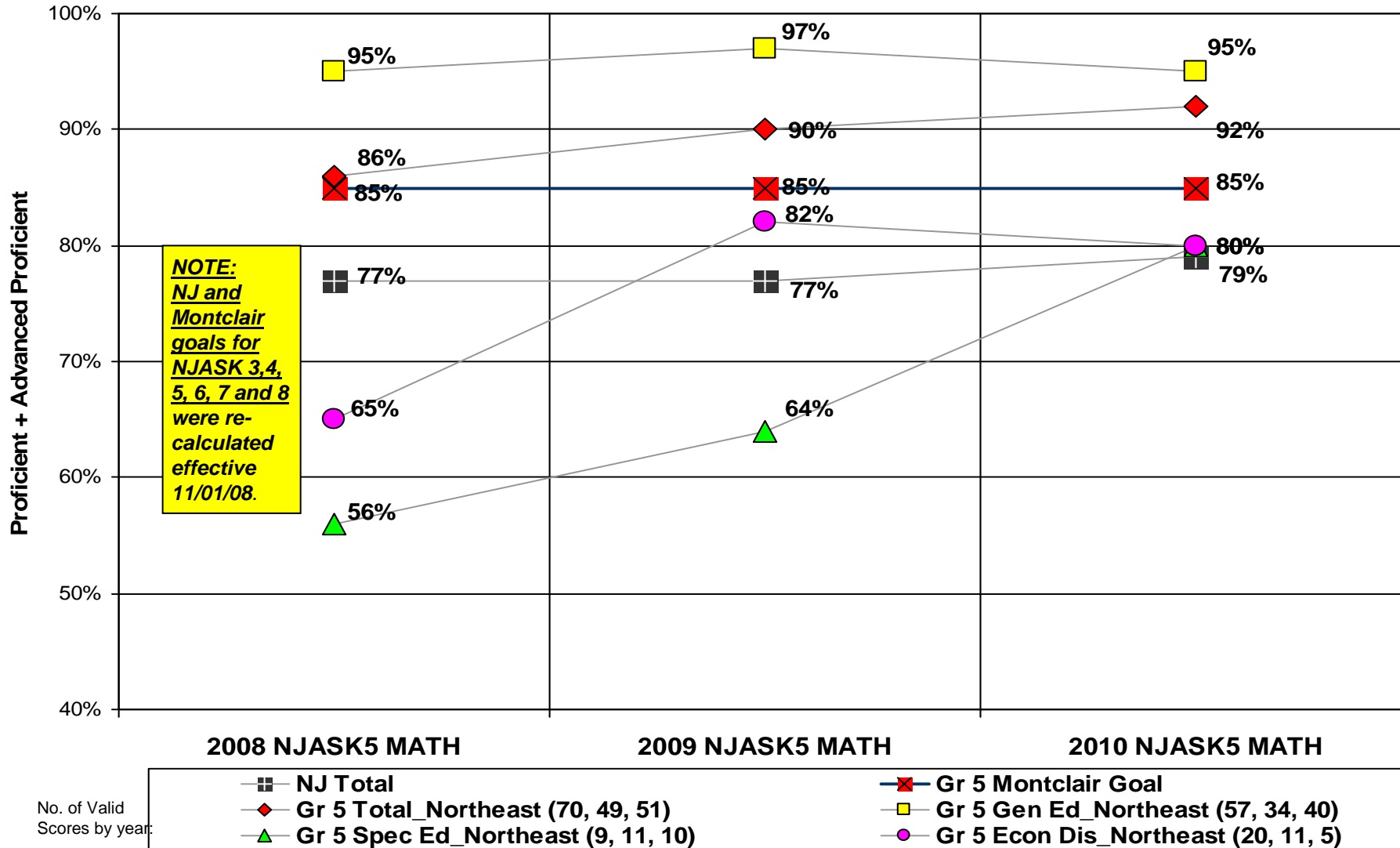


Grade 05 MATH (NJASK5) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf NORTHEAST By GROUP: 2008 - 2010

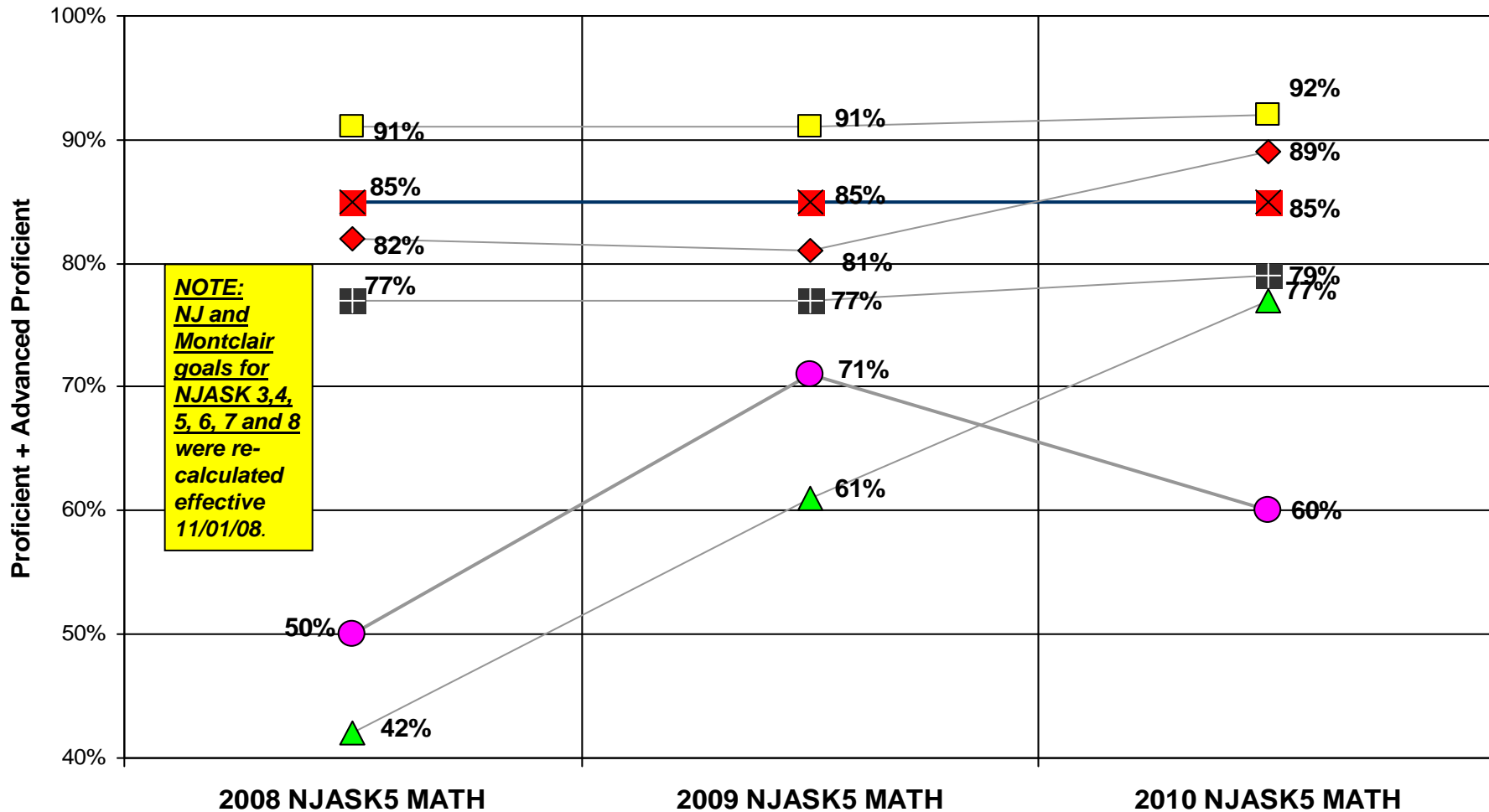


Grade 05 MATH (NJASK5) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf RAND By GROUP: 2008 - 2010

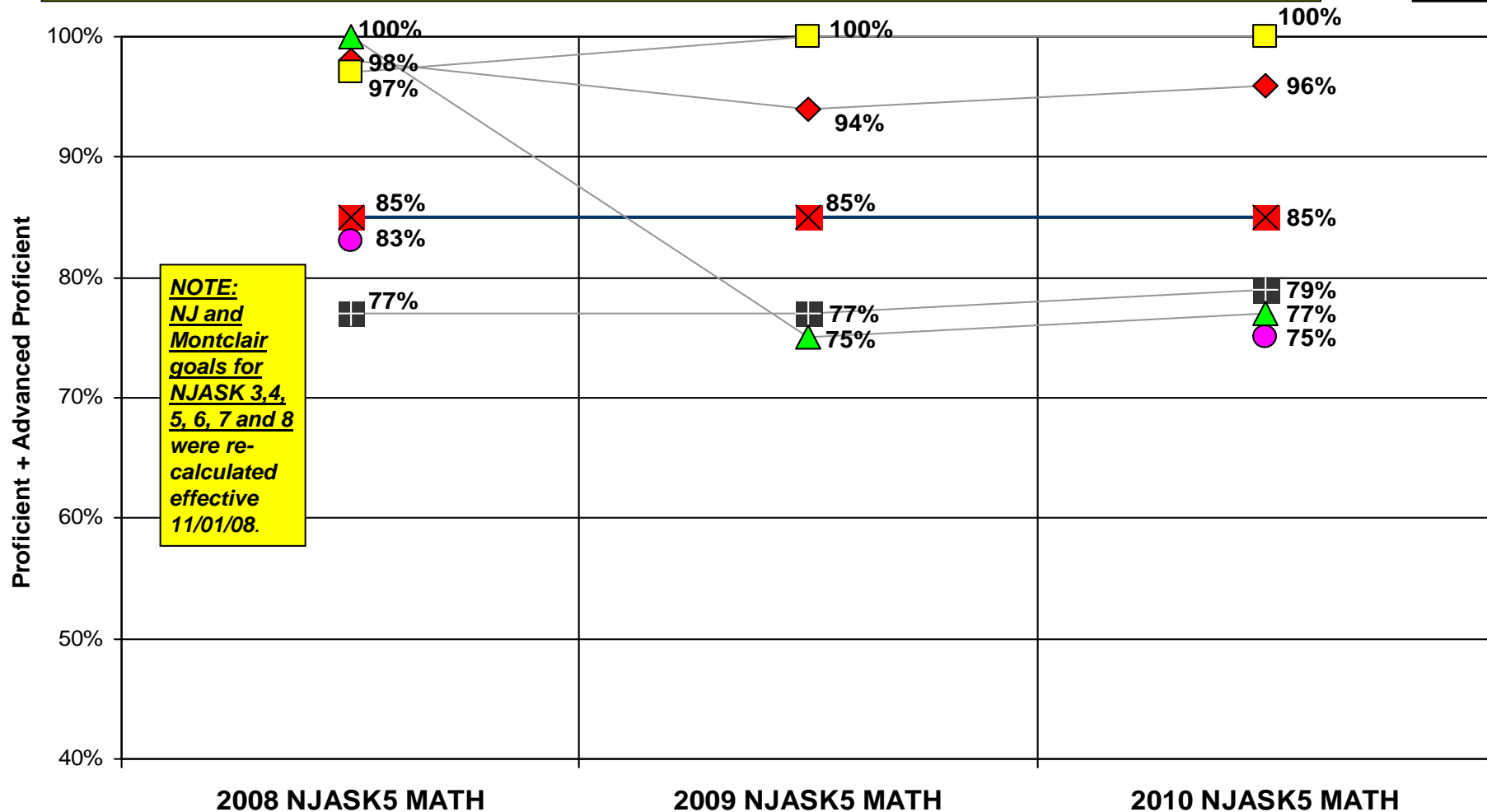

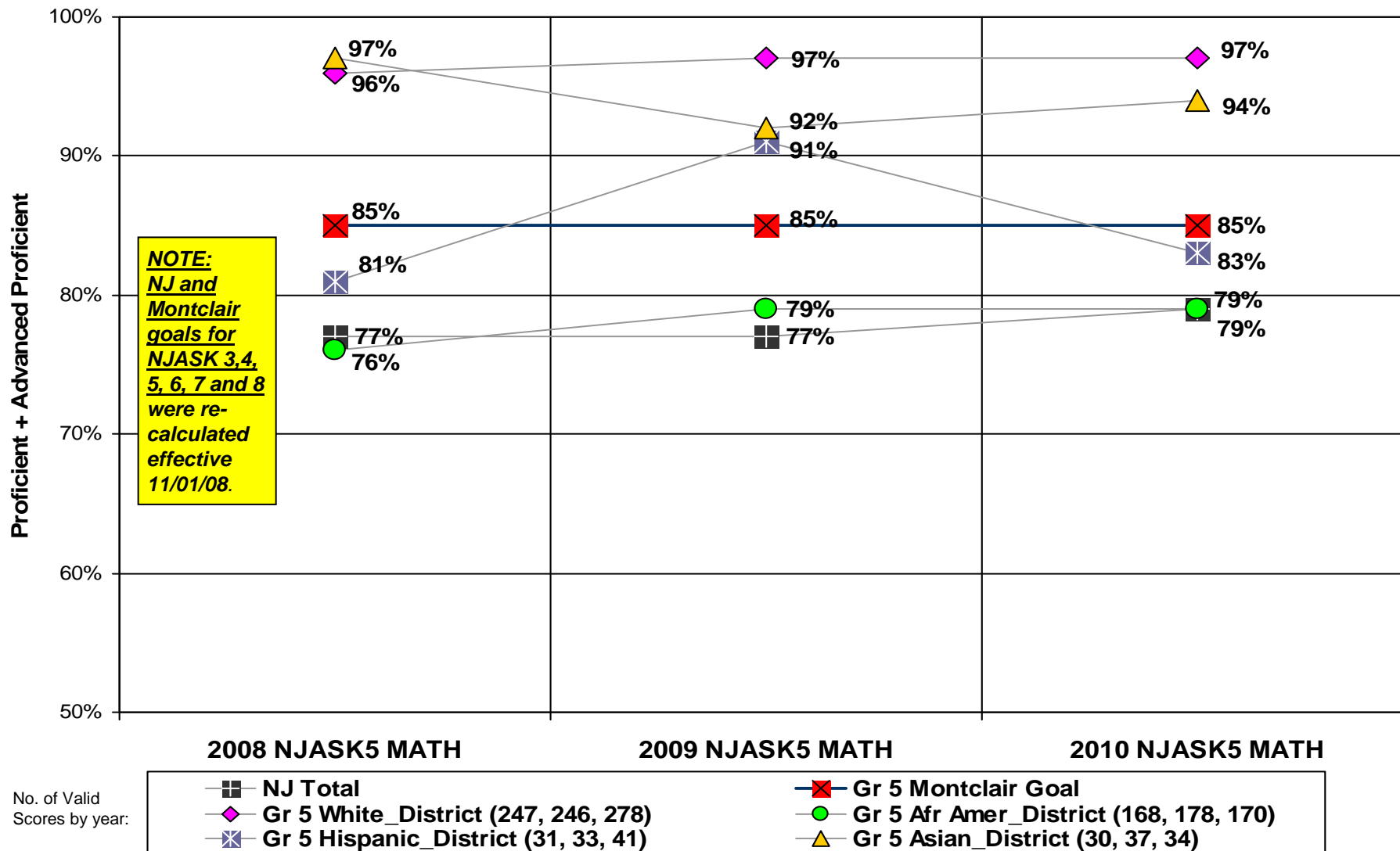

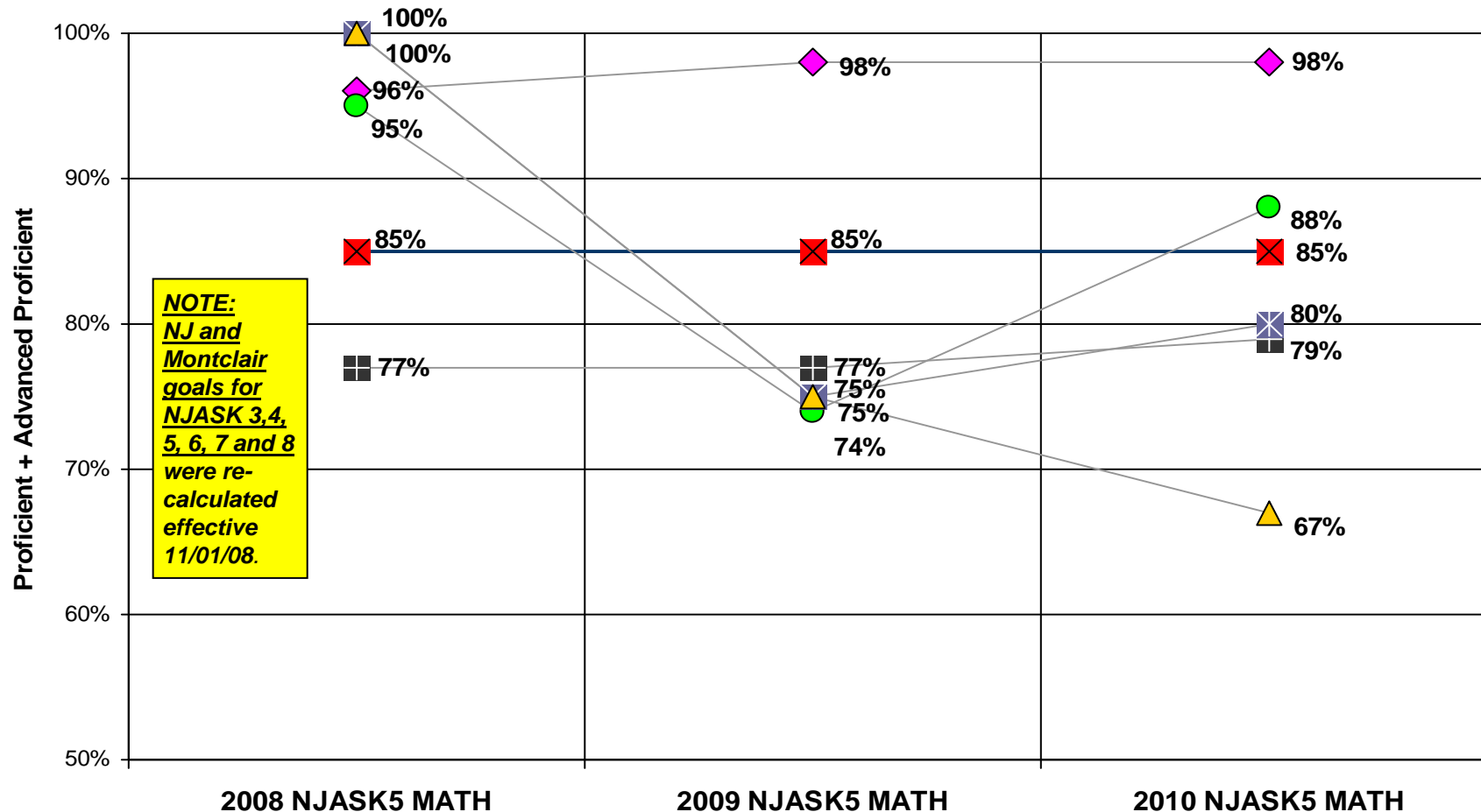


Grade 05 MATH (NJASK5) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf BRADFORD By ETHNICITY: 2008 - 2010

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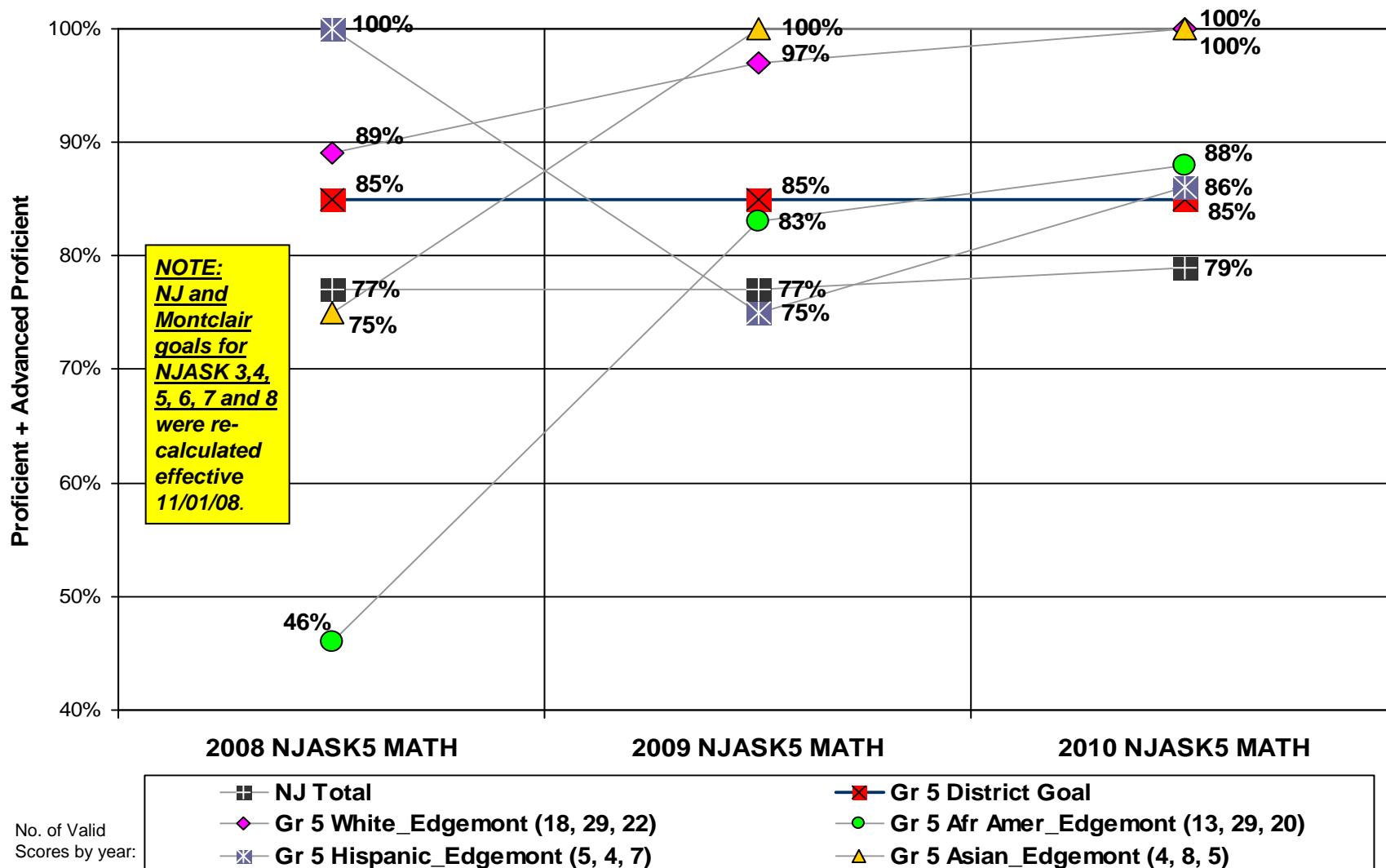

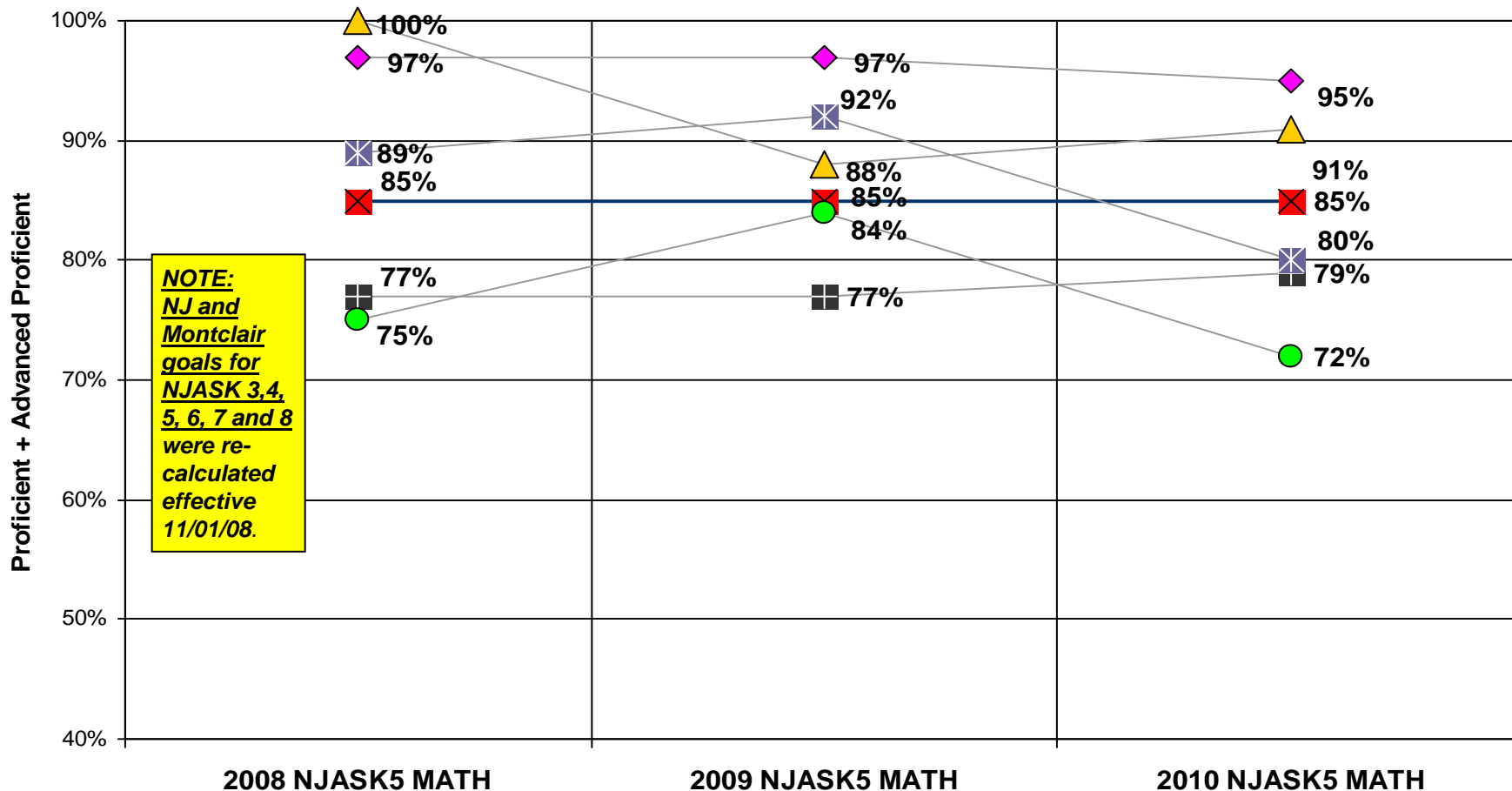


Grade 05 MATH (NJASK5) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf HILLSIDE By ETHNICITY : 2008 - 2010

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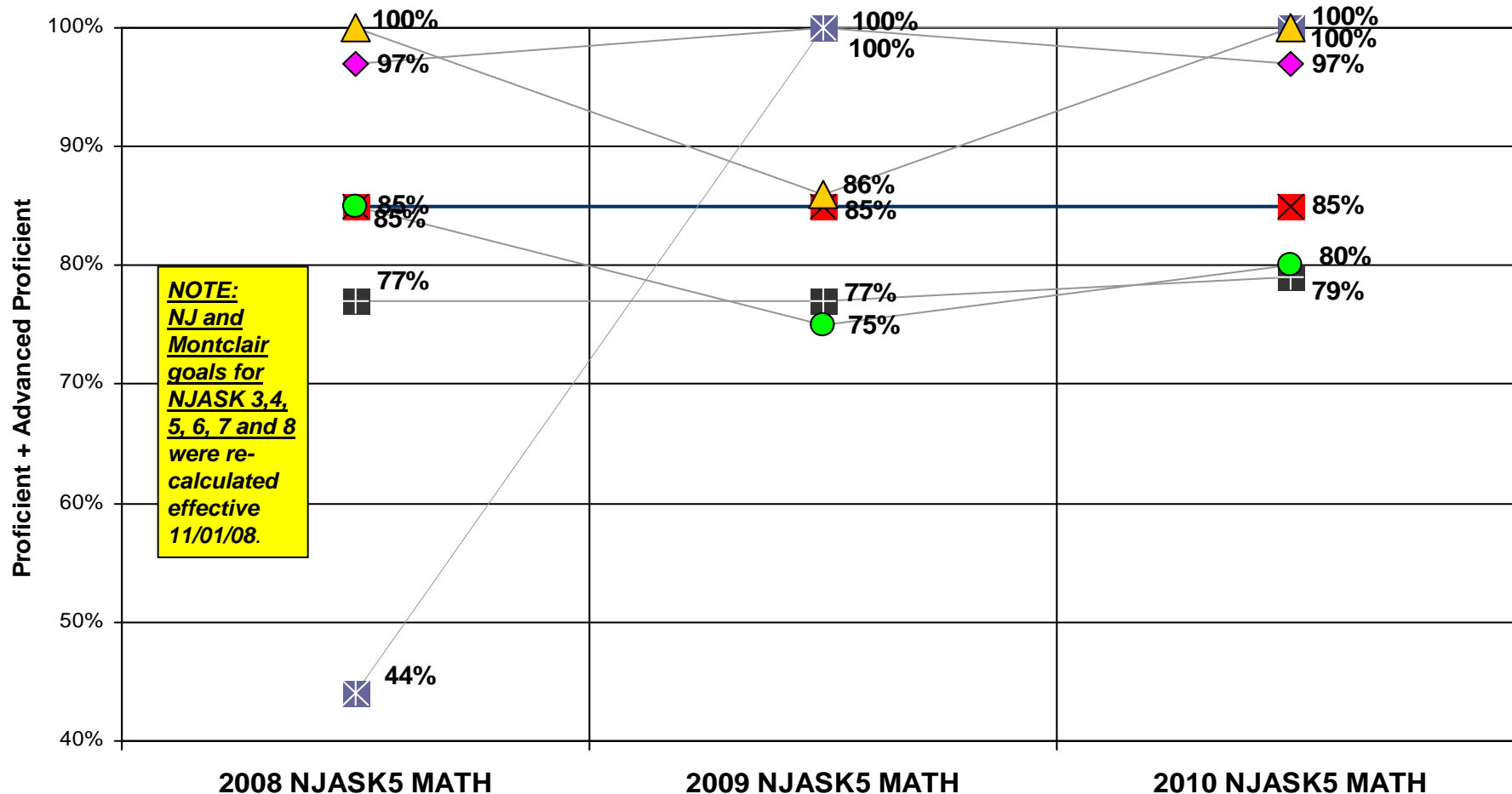

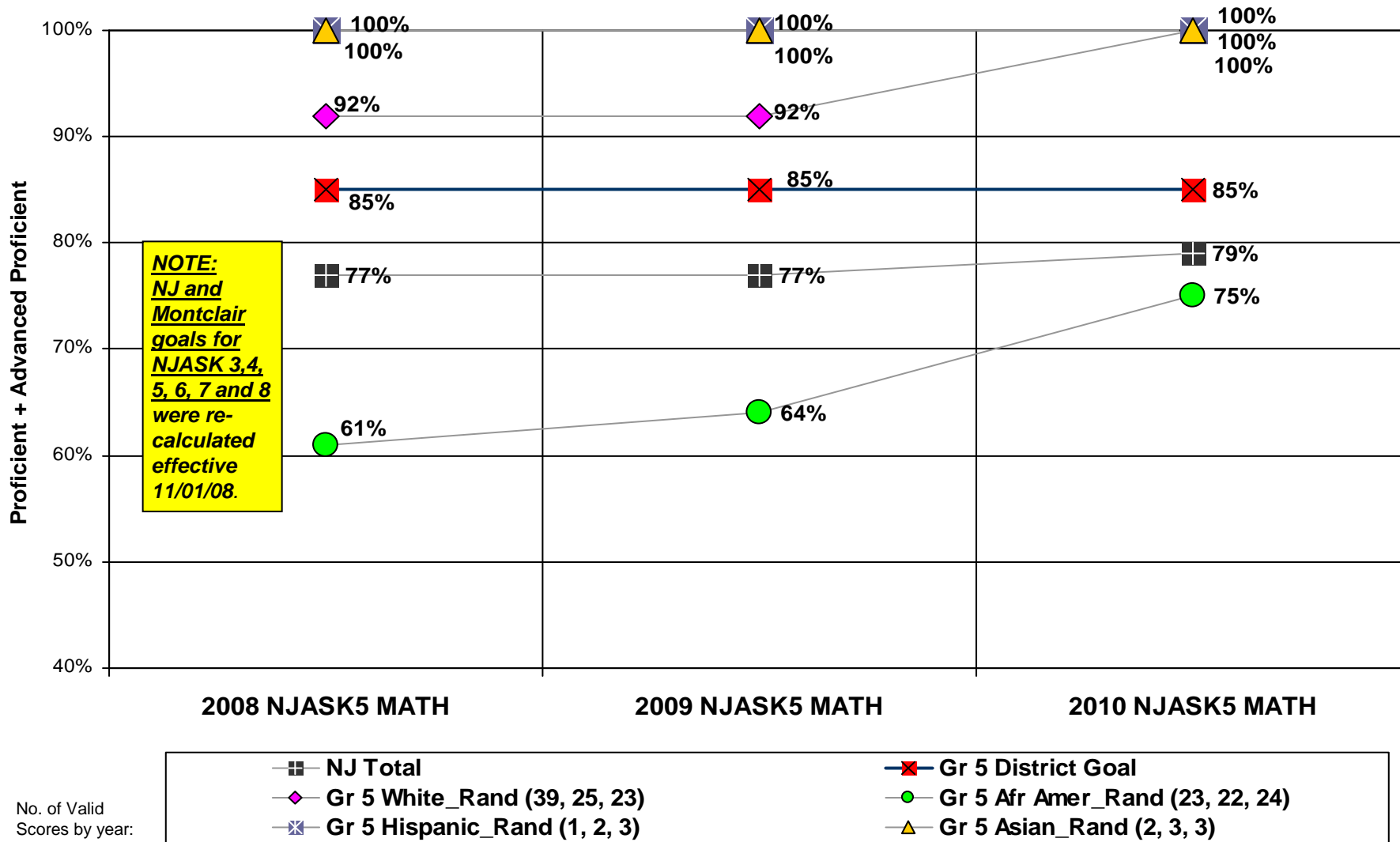

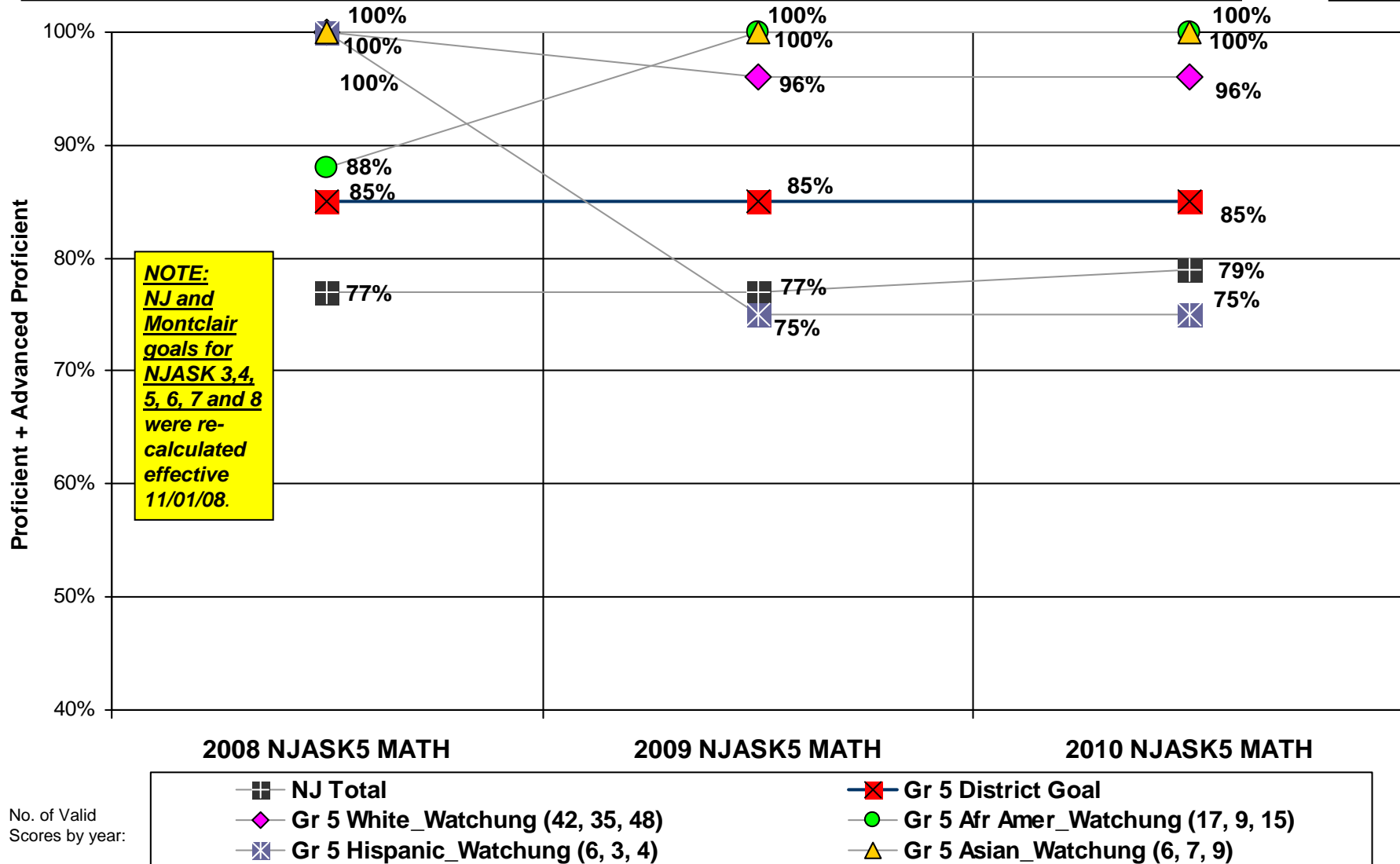


Grade 05 MATH (NJASK5) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf WATCHUNG By ETHNICITY: 2008 - 2010

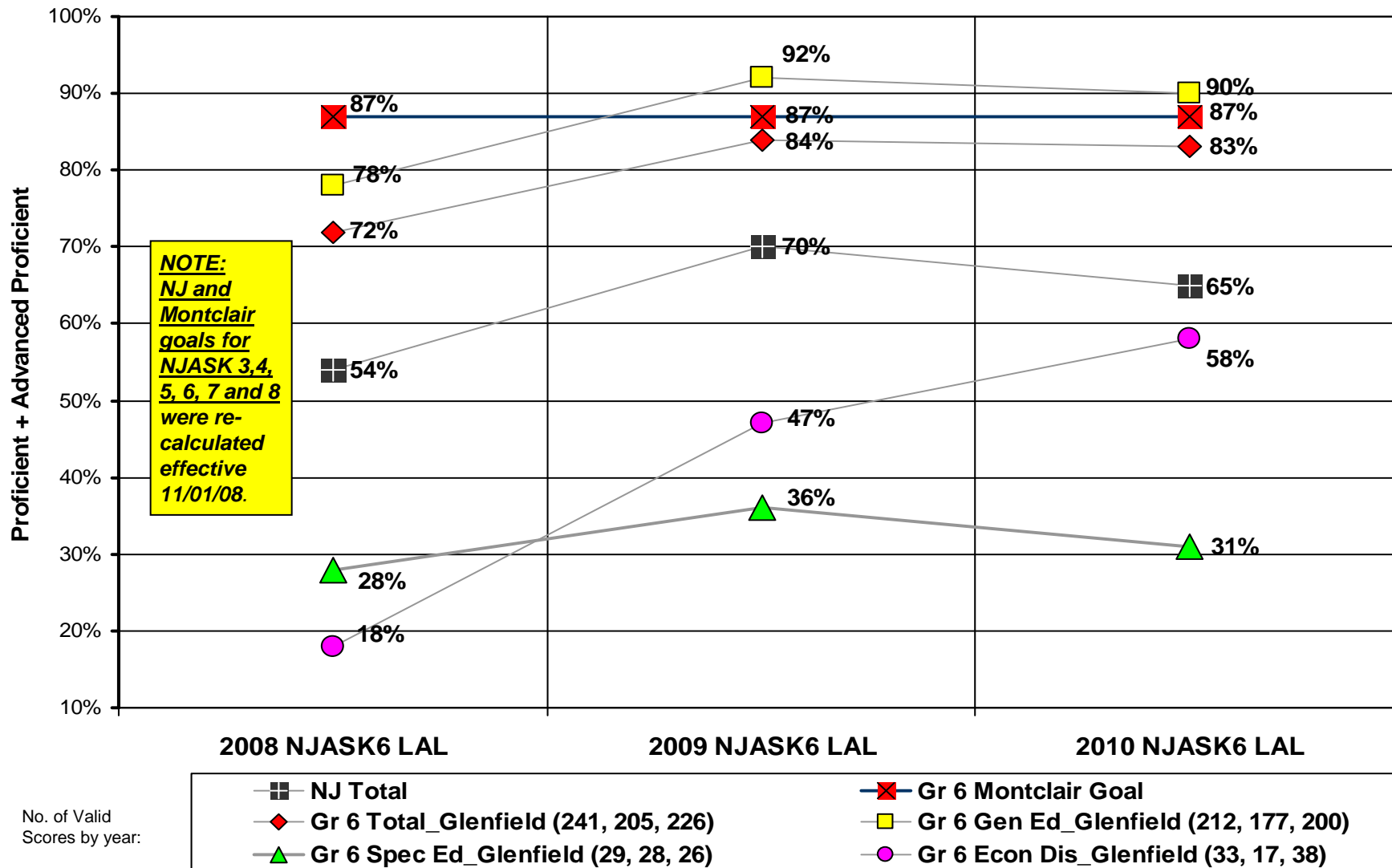

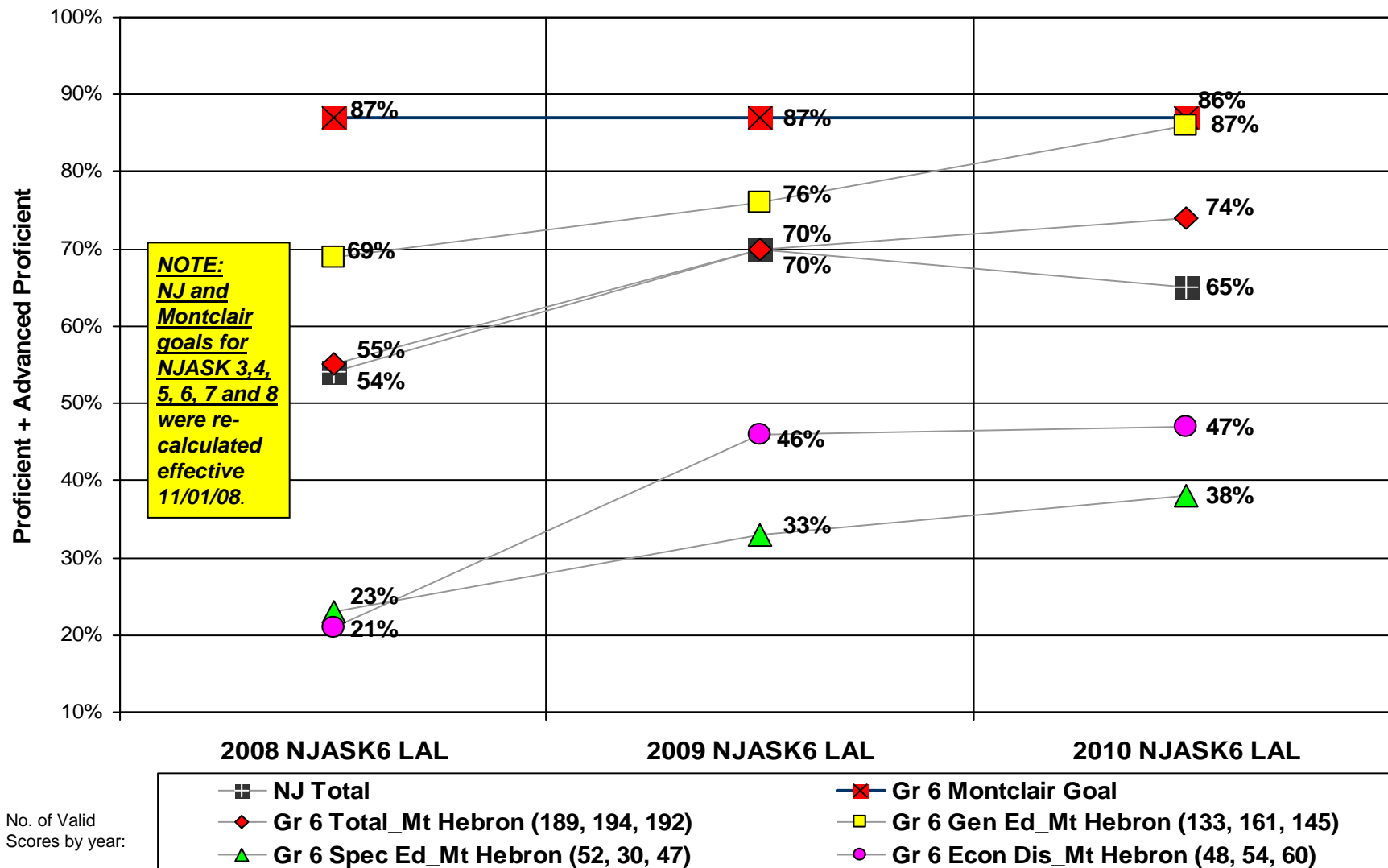


Grade 06 LAL (NJASK6) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf MT HEBRON By GROUP: 2008 - 2010

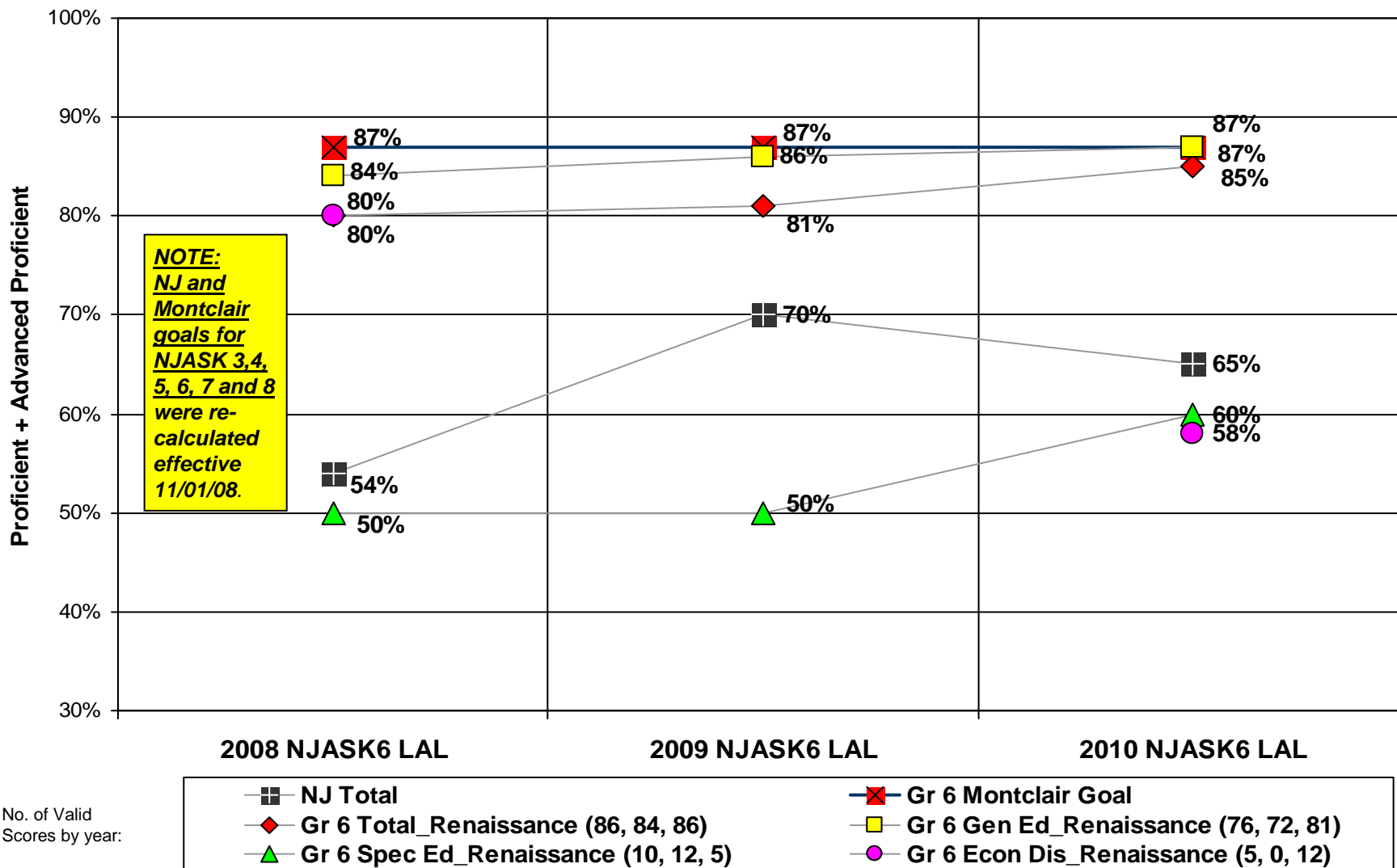

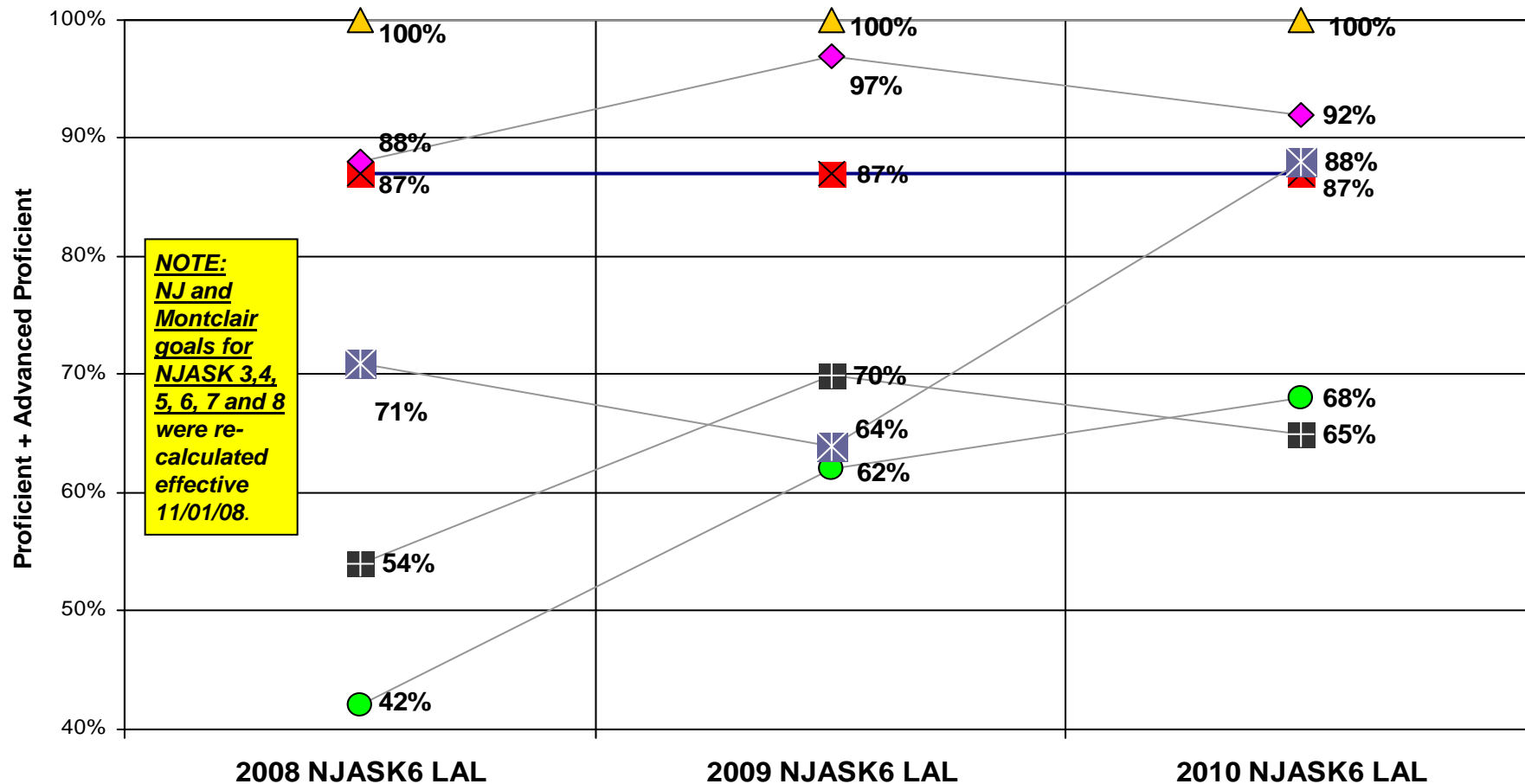

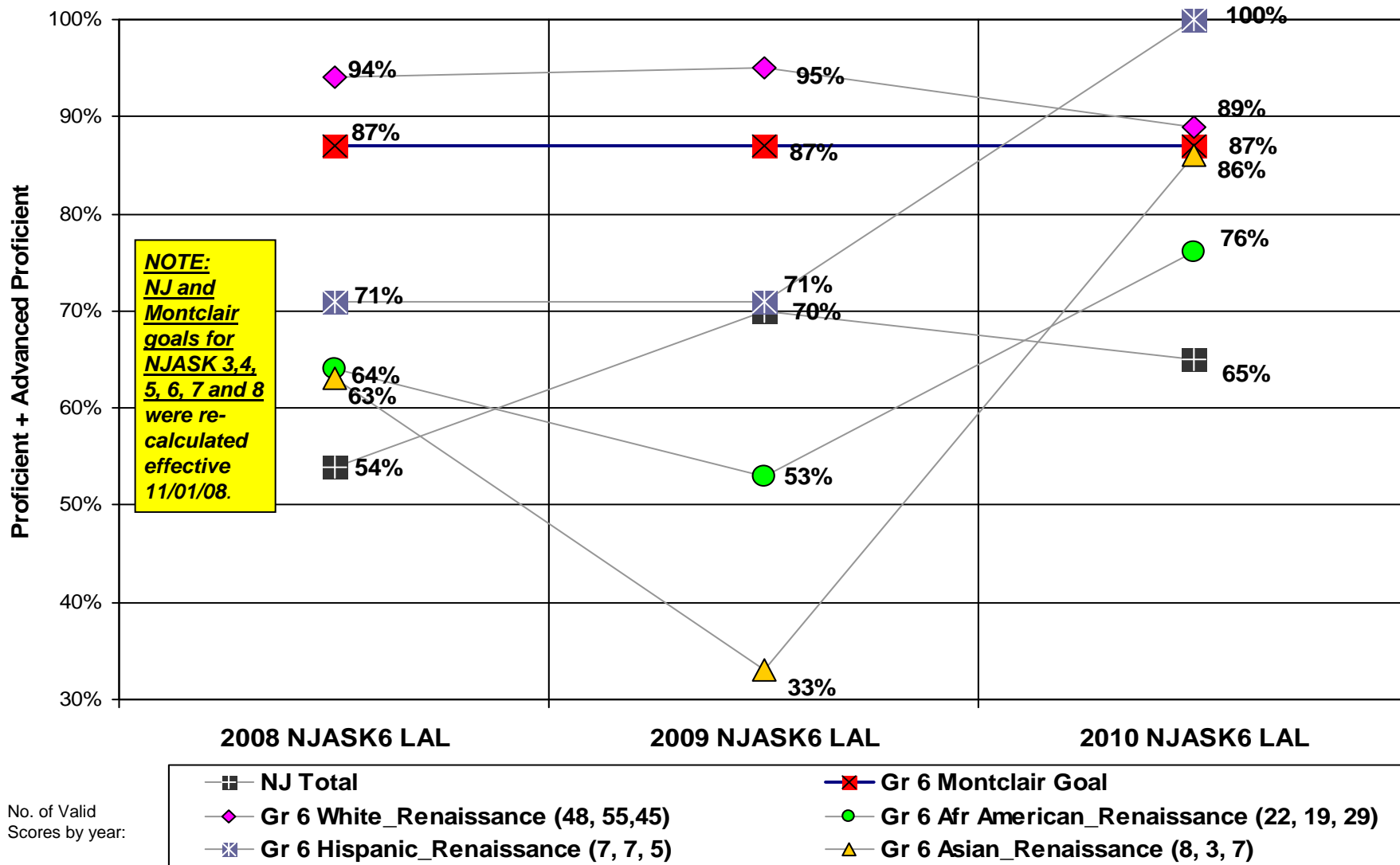

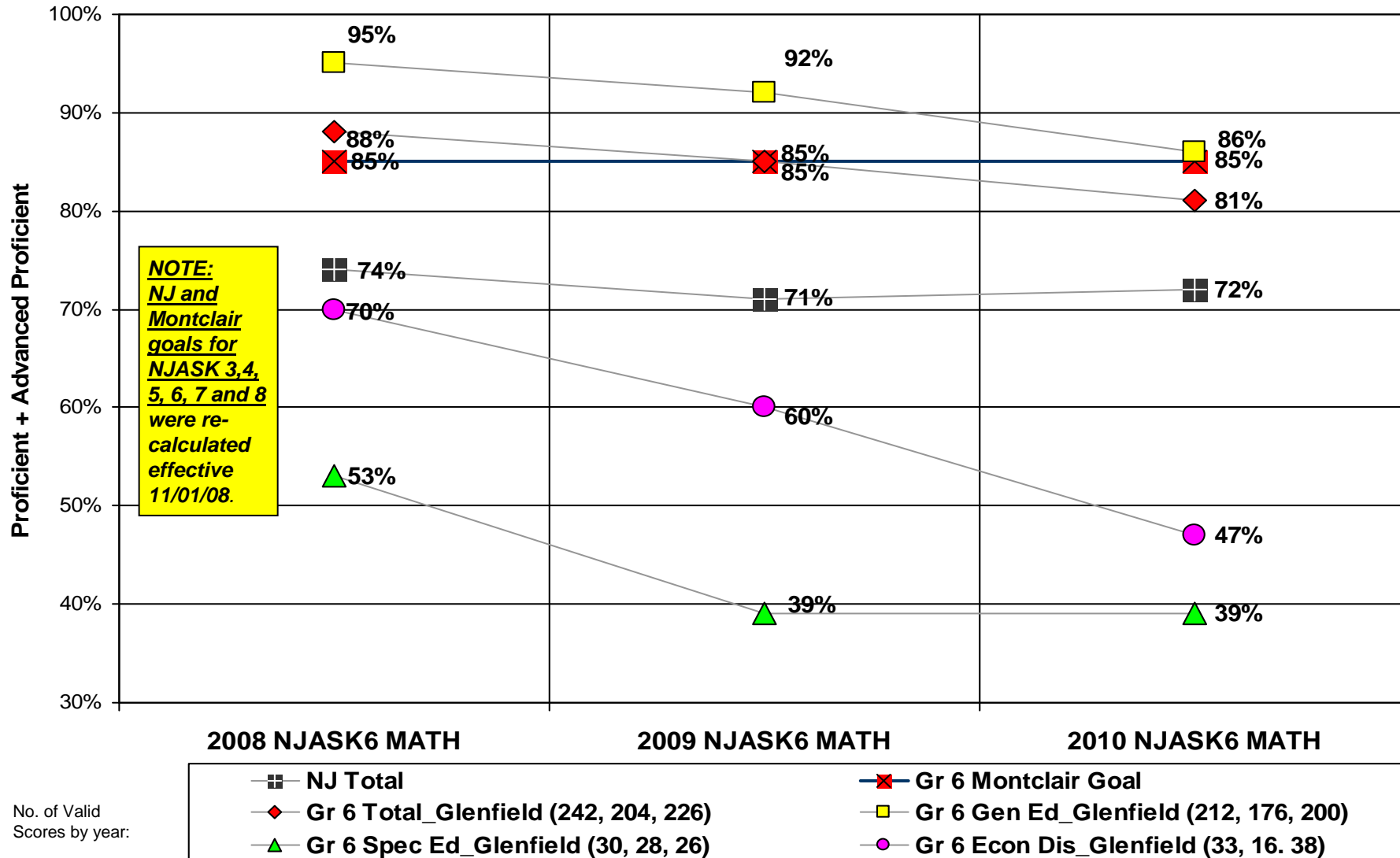

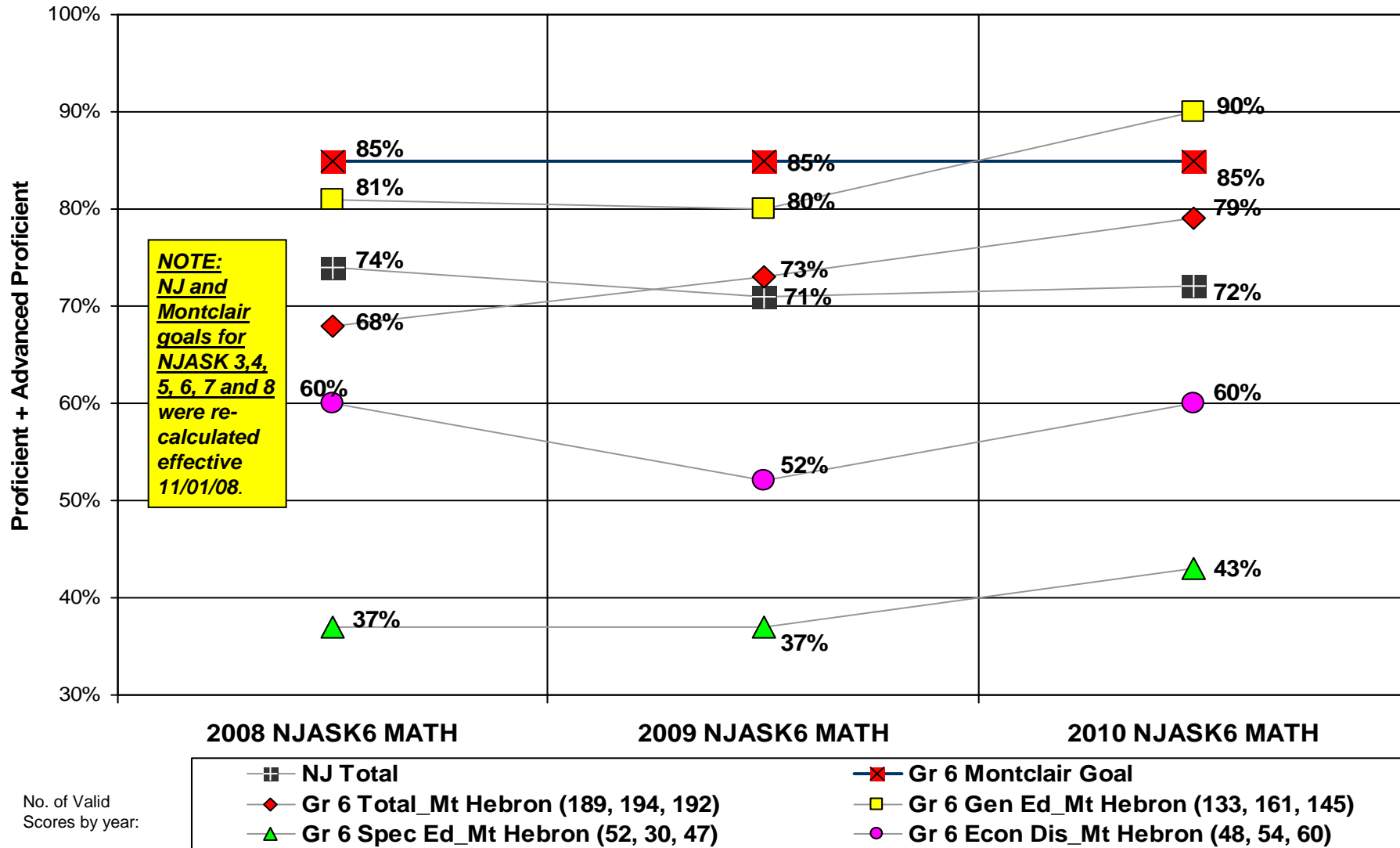


Grade 06 MATH (NJASK6) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf MT HEBRON By GROUP: 2008 - 2010

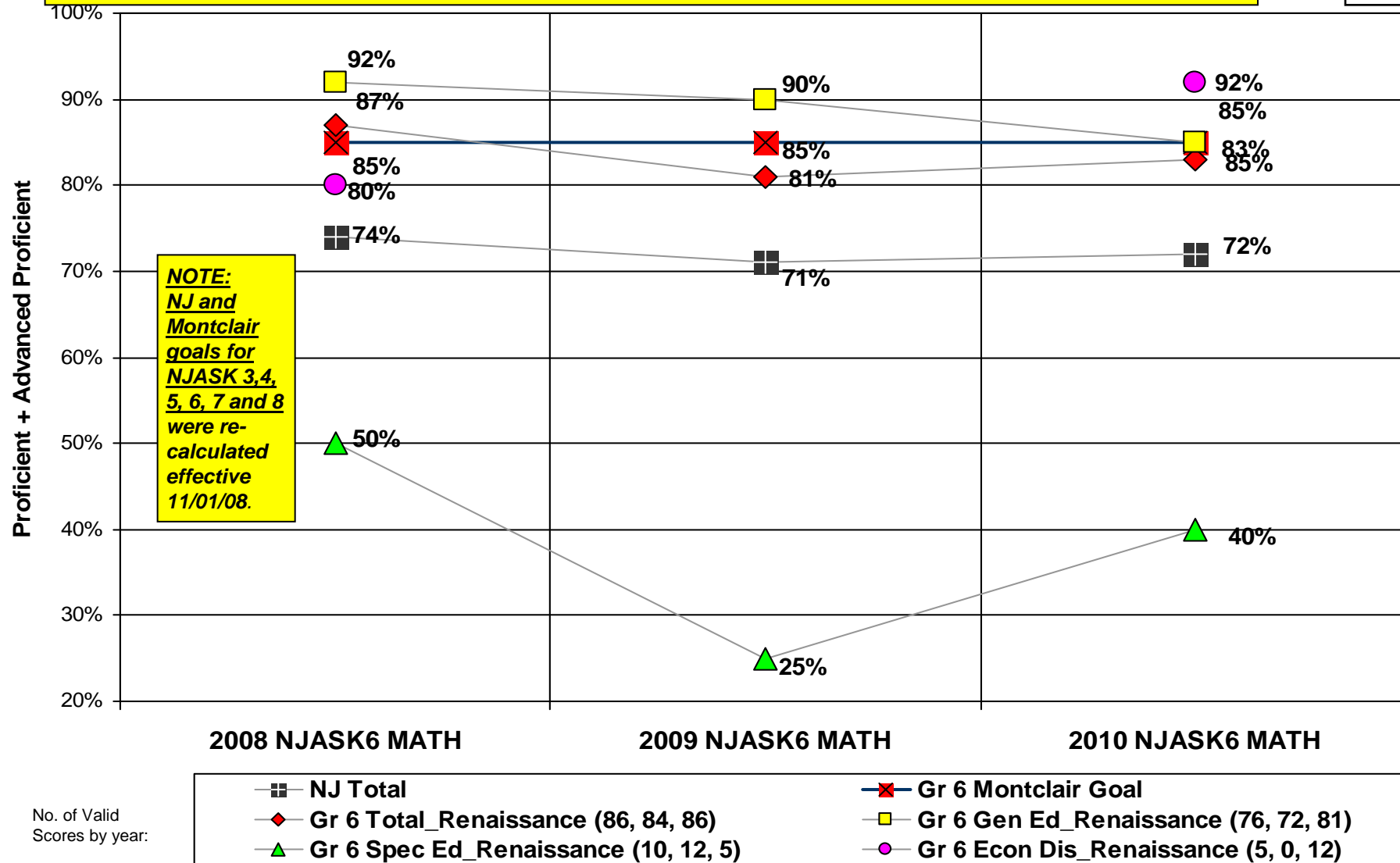

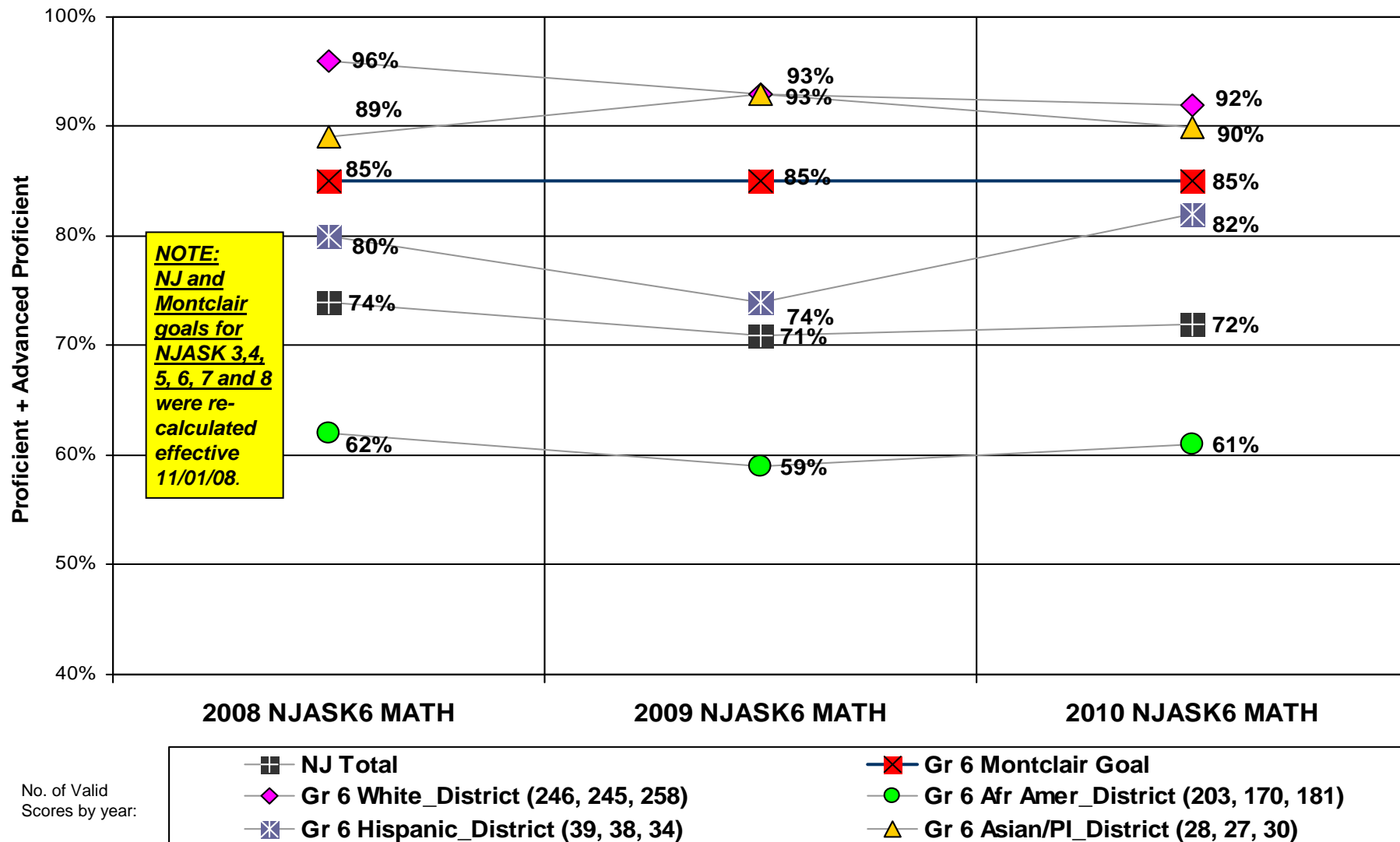

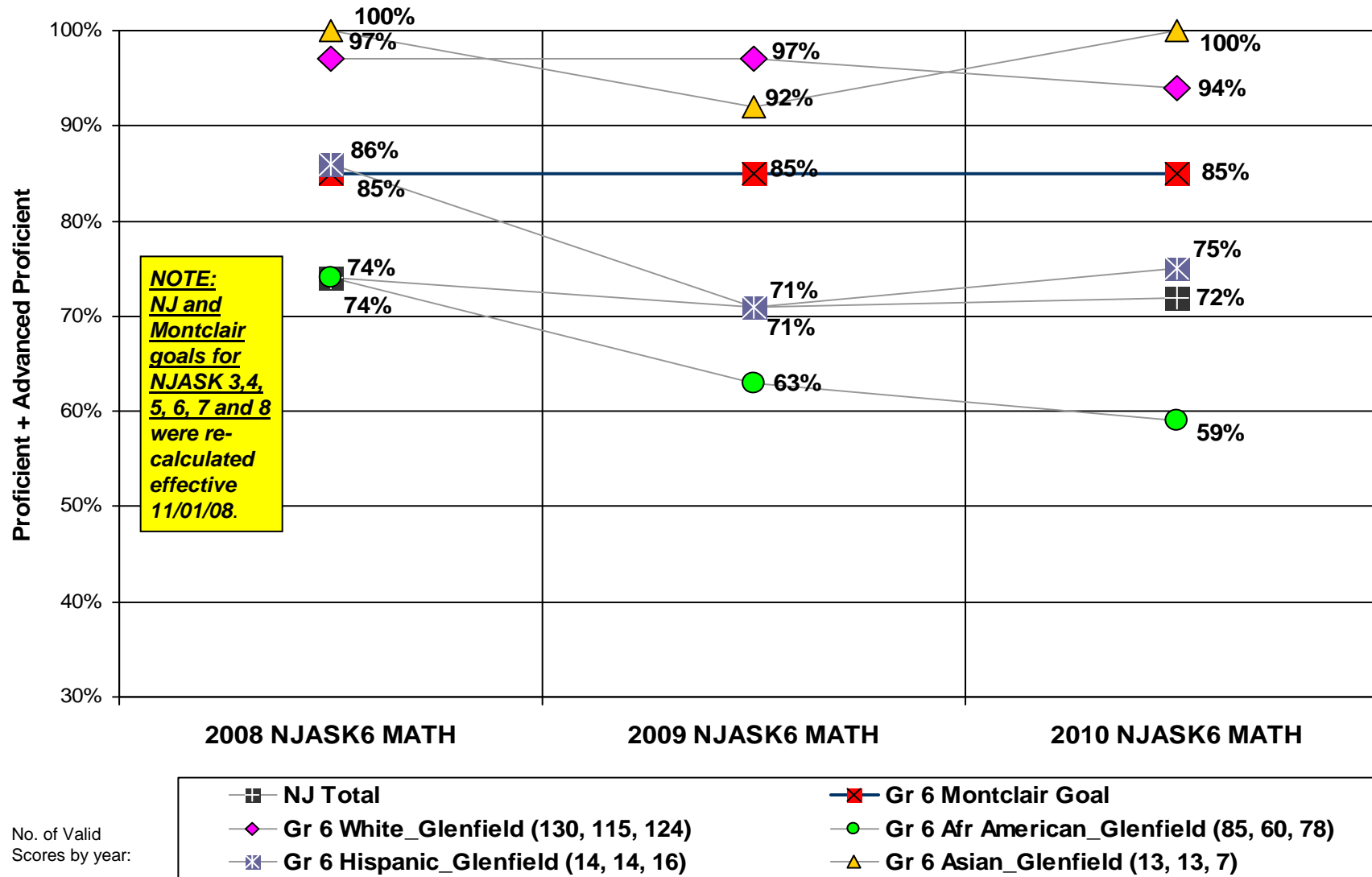

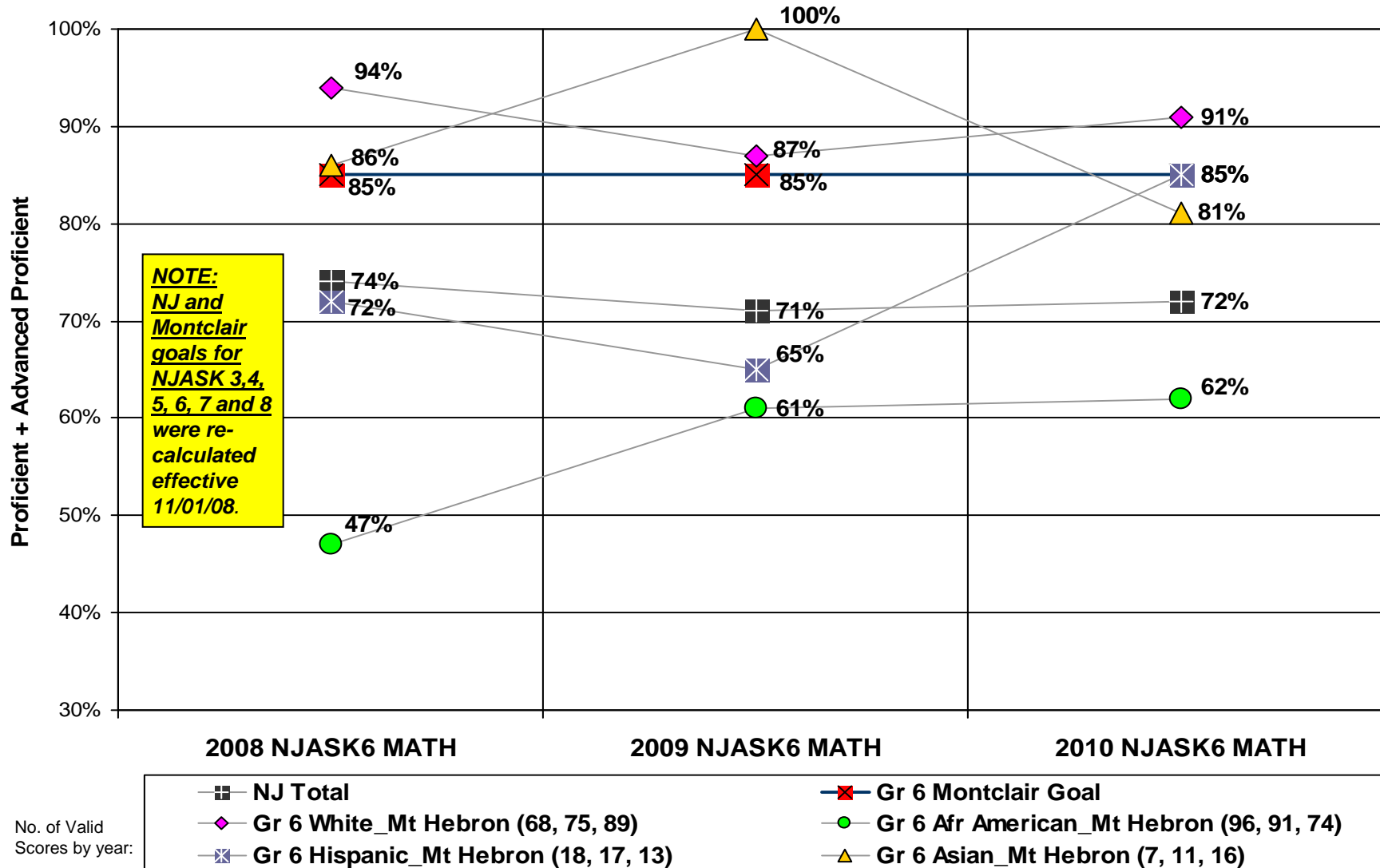

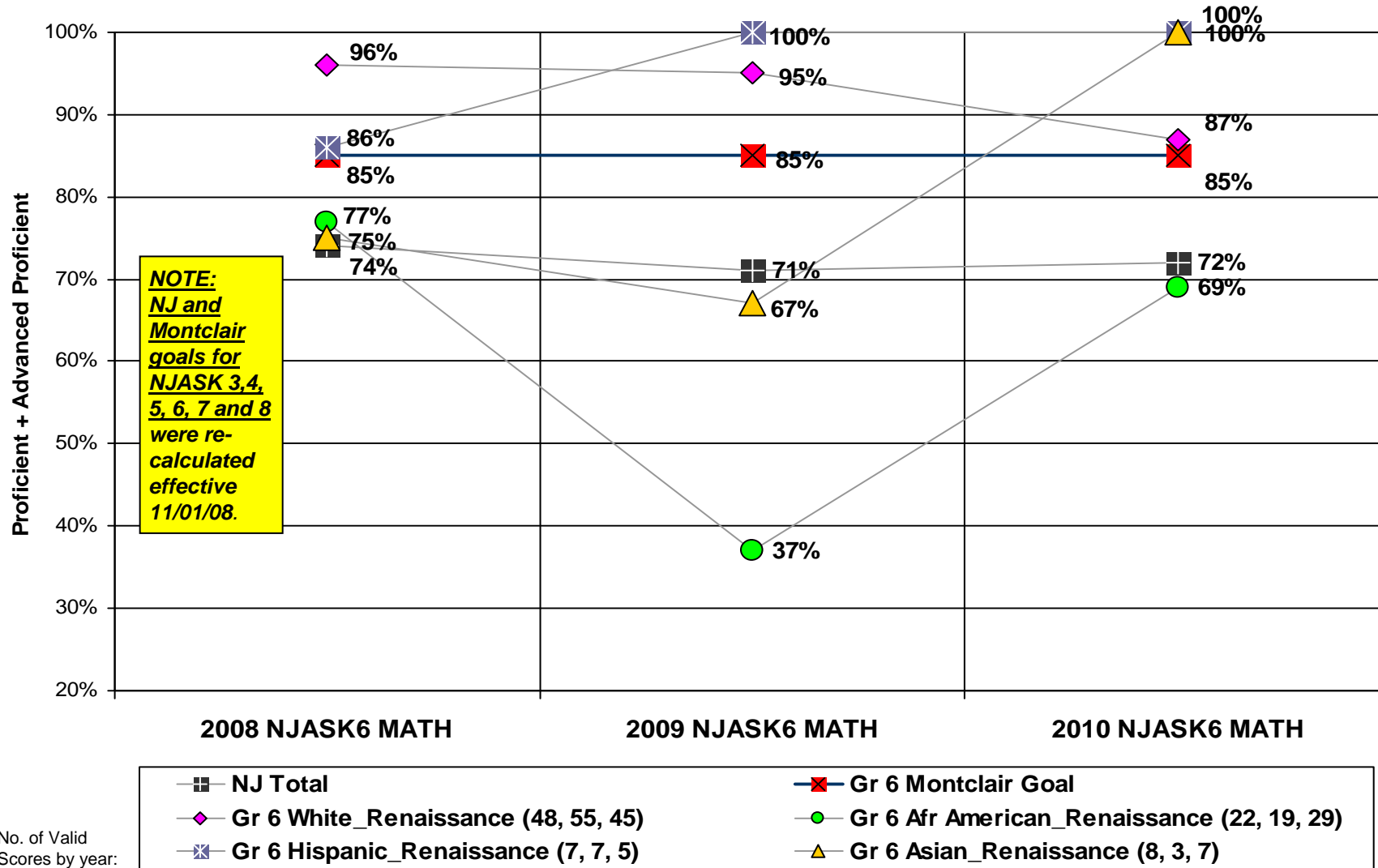

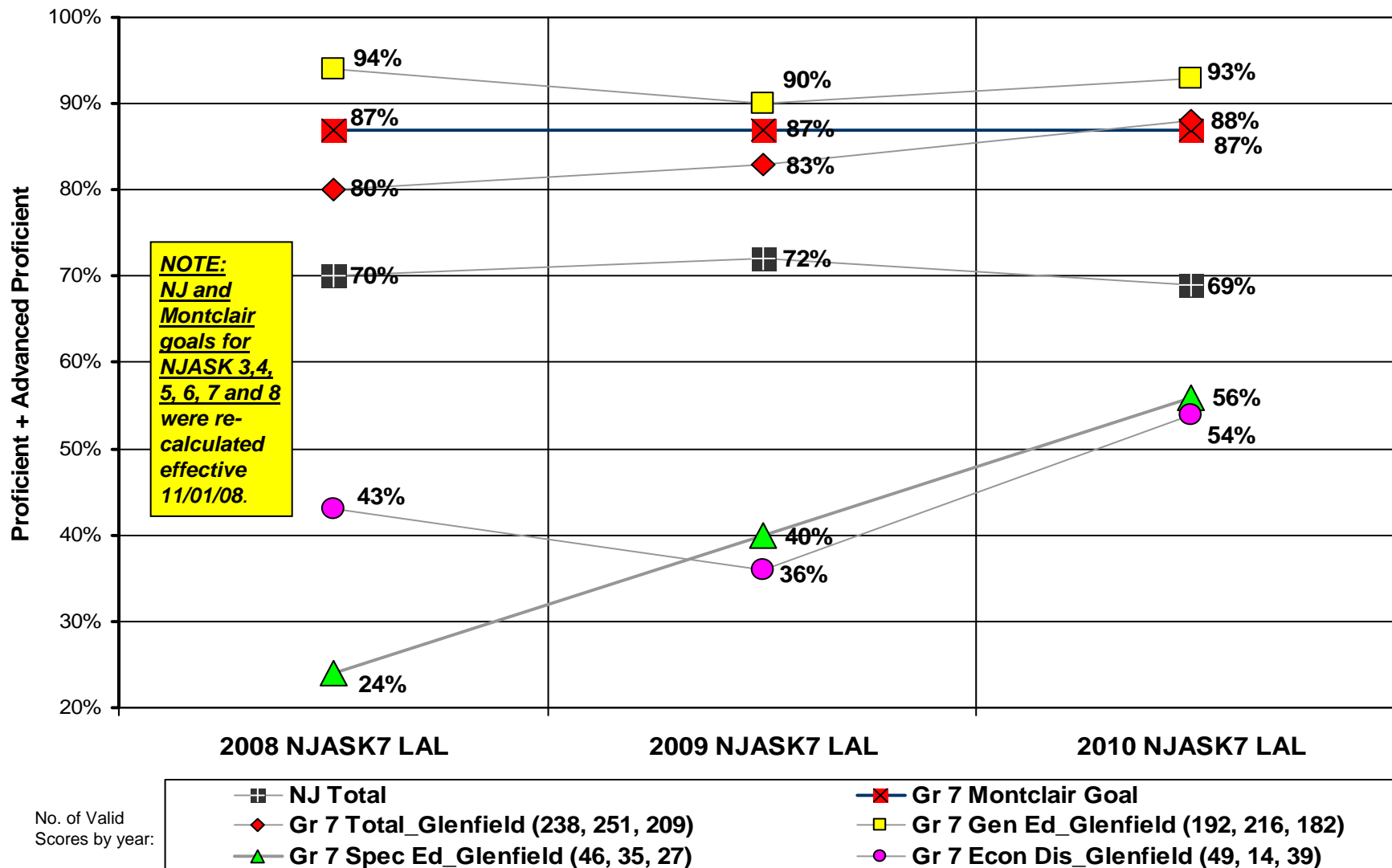


Grade 07 LAL (NJASK7) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf GLENFIELD By GROUP: 2008 - 2010

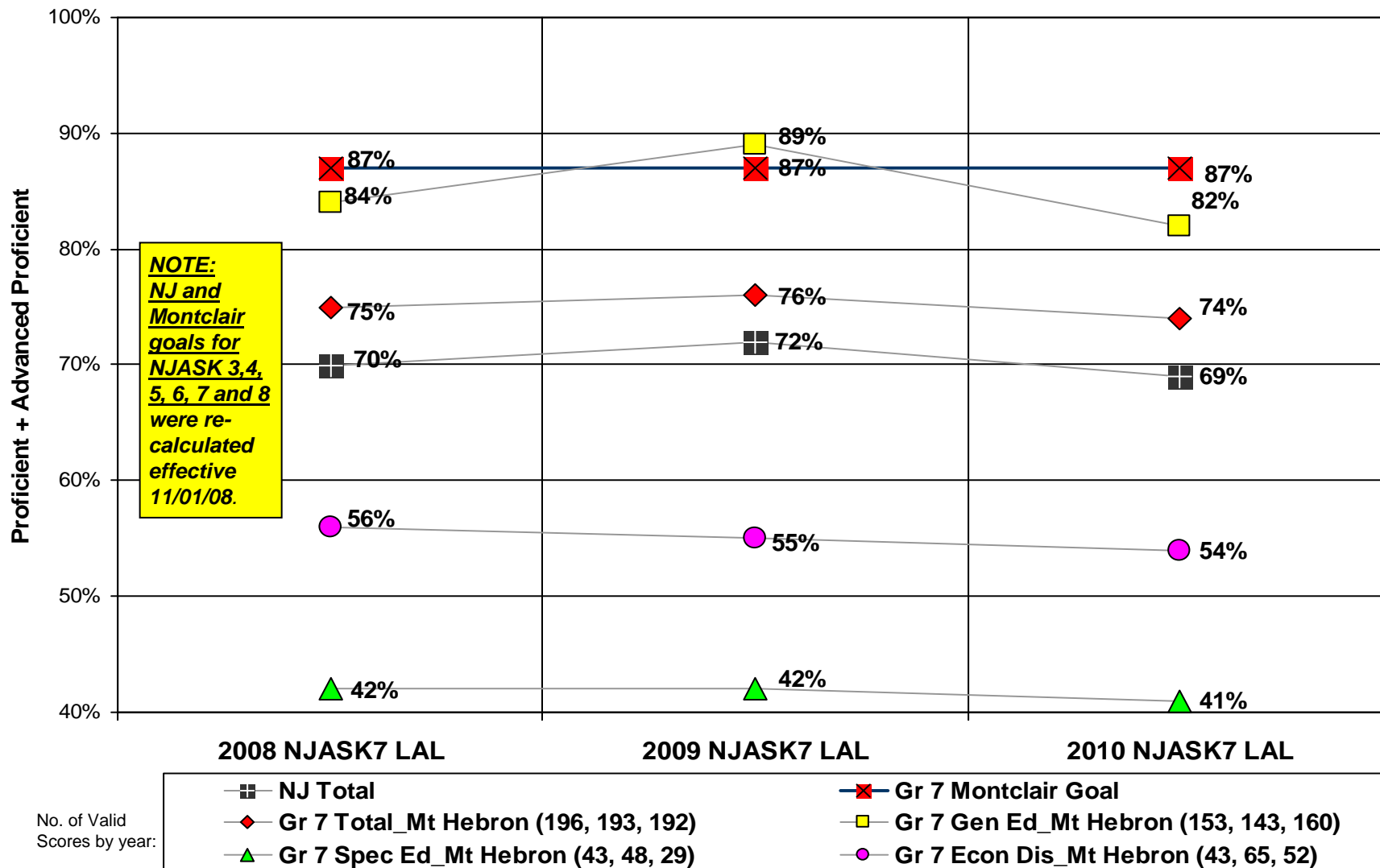


Grade 07 LAL (NJASK7) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf MT HEBRON By GROUP: 2008 - 2010

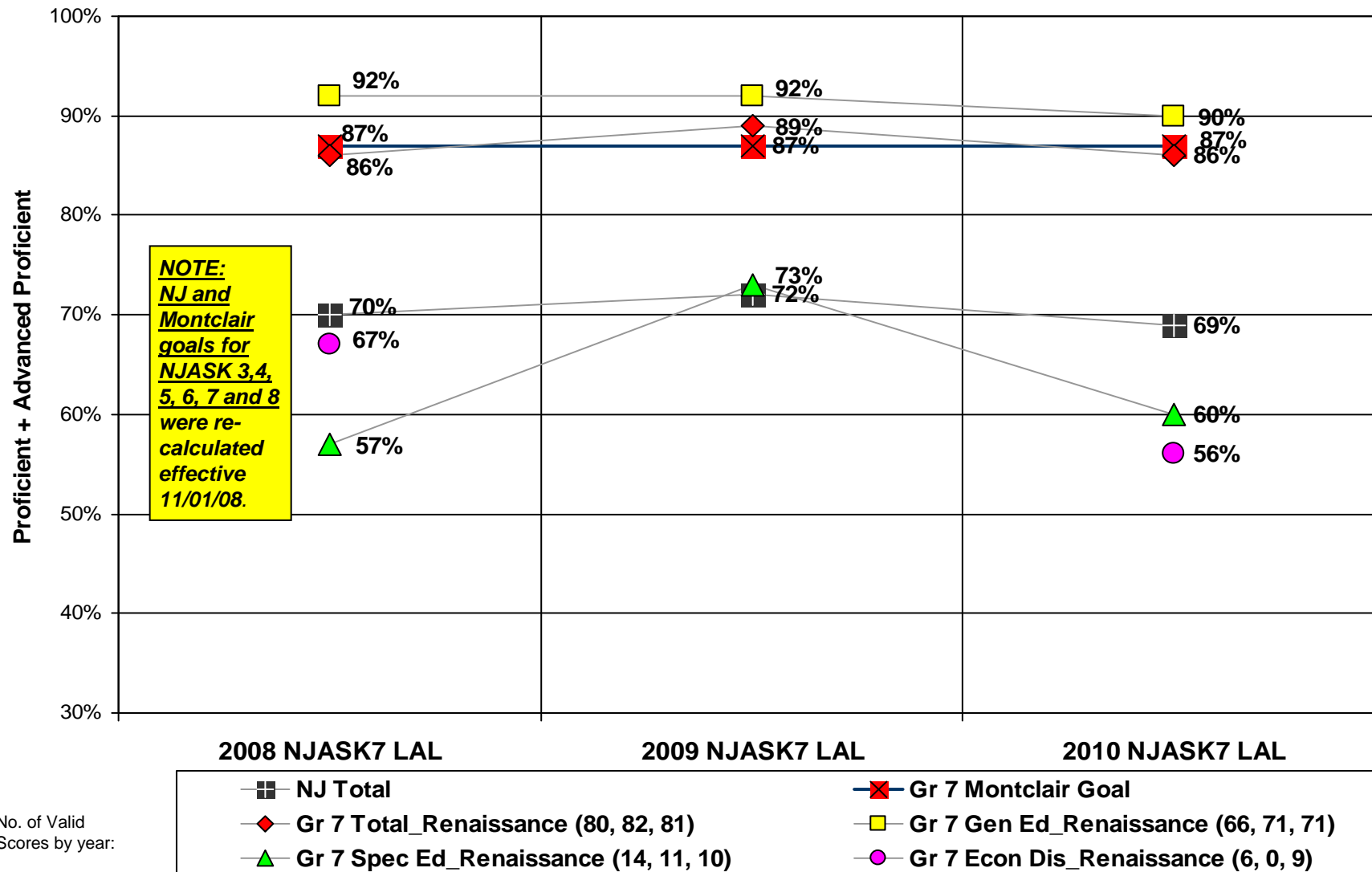


Grade 07 LAL (NJASK7) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf RENAISSANCE By GROUP: 2008 - 2010

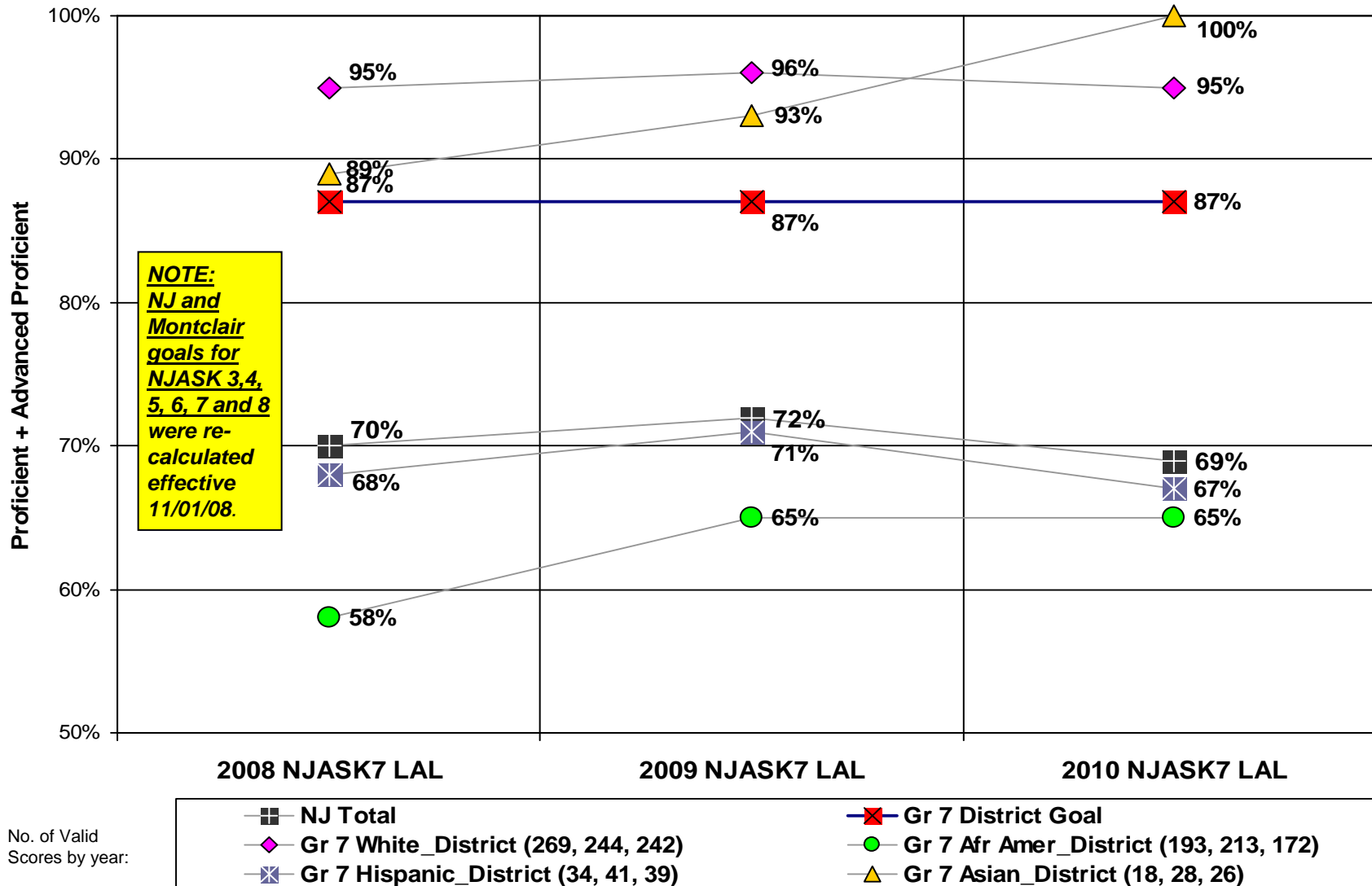


Grade 07 LAL (NJASK7) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf DISTRICT By ETHNICITY: 2008 - 2010

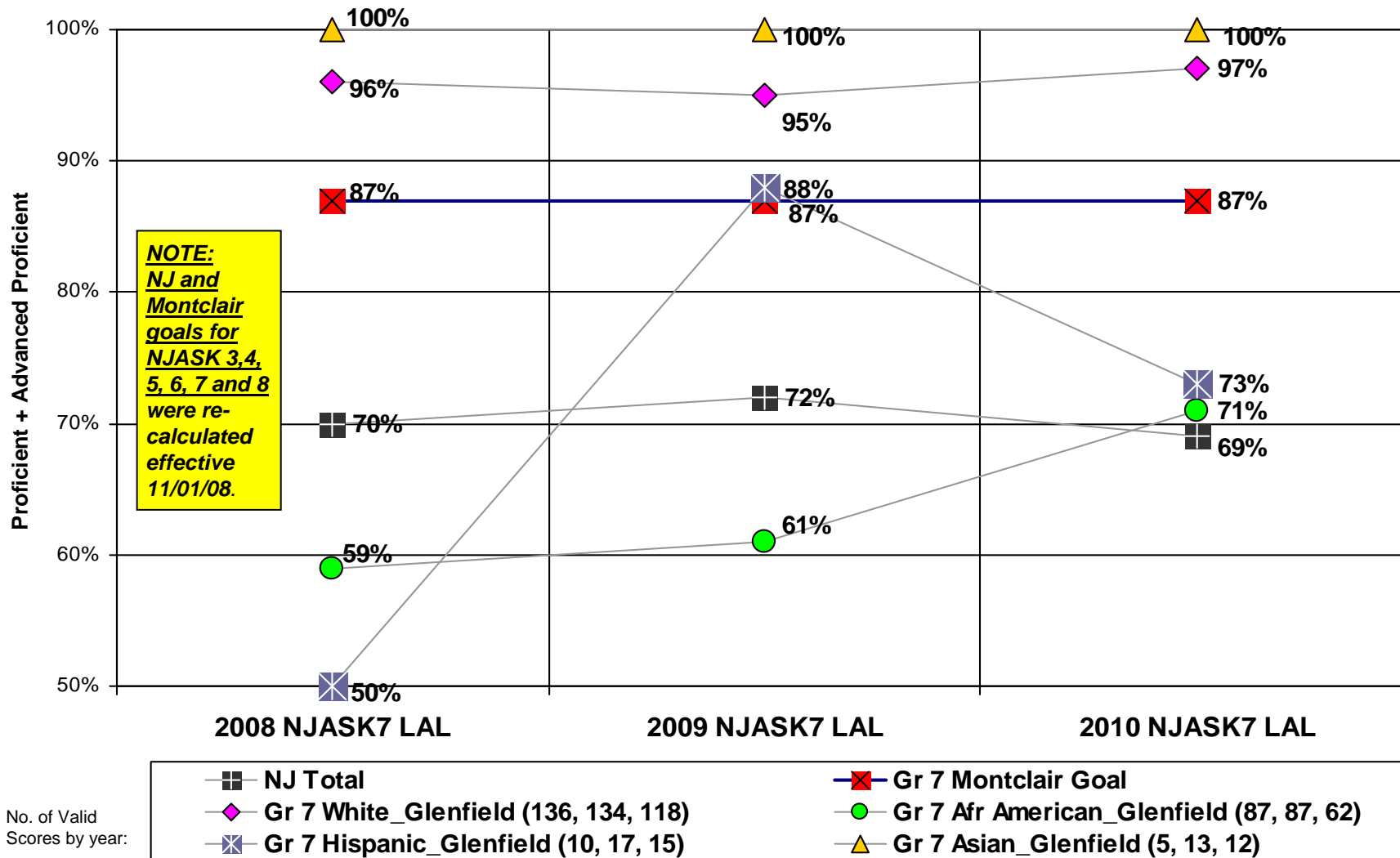


Grade 07 LAL (NJASK7) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf GLENFIELD By ETHNICITY: 2008 - 2010

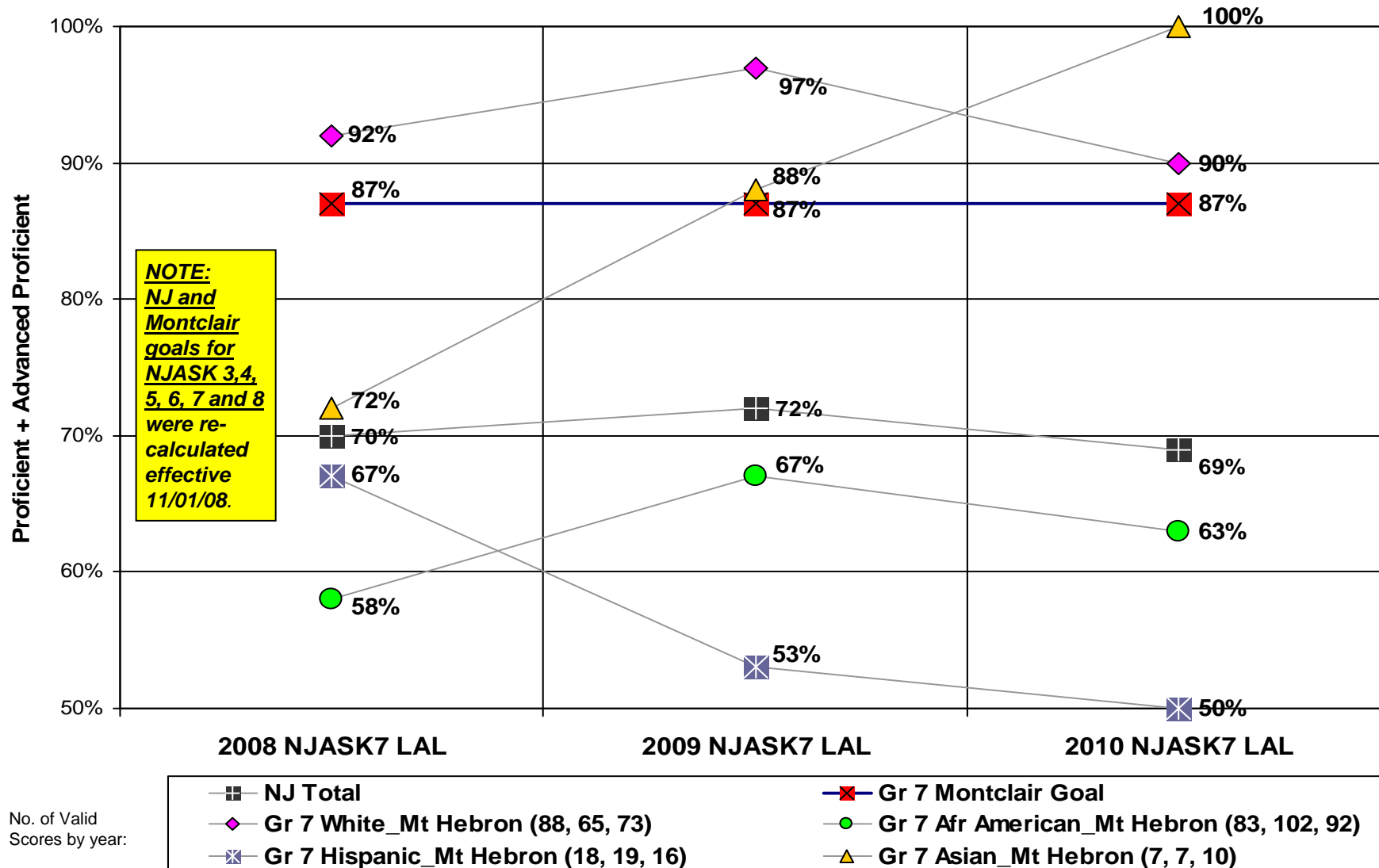


Grade 07 LAL (NJASK7) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf MT HEBRON By ETHNICITY: 2008 - 2010

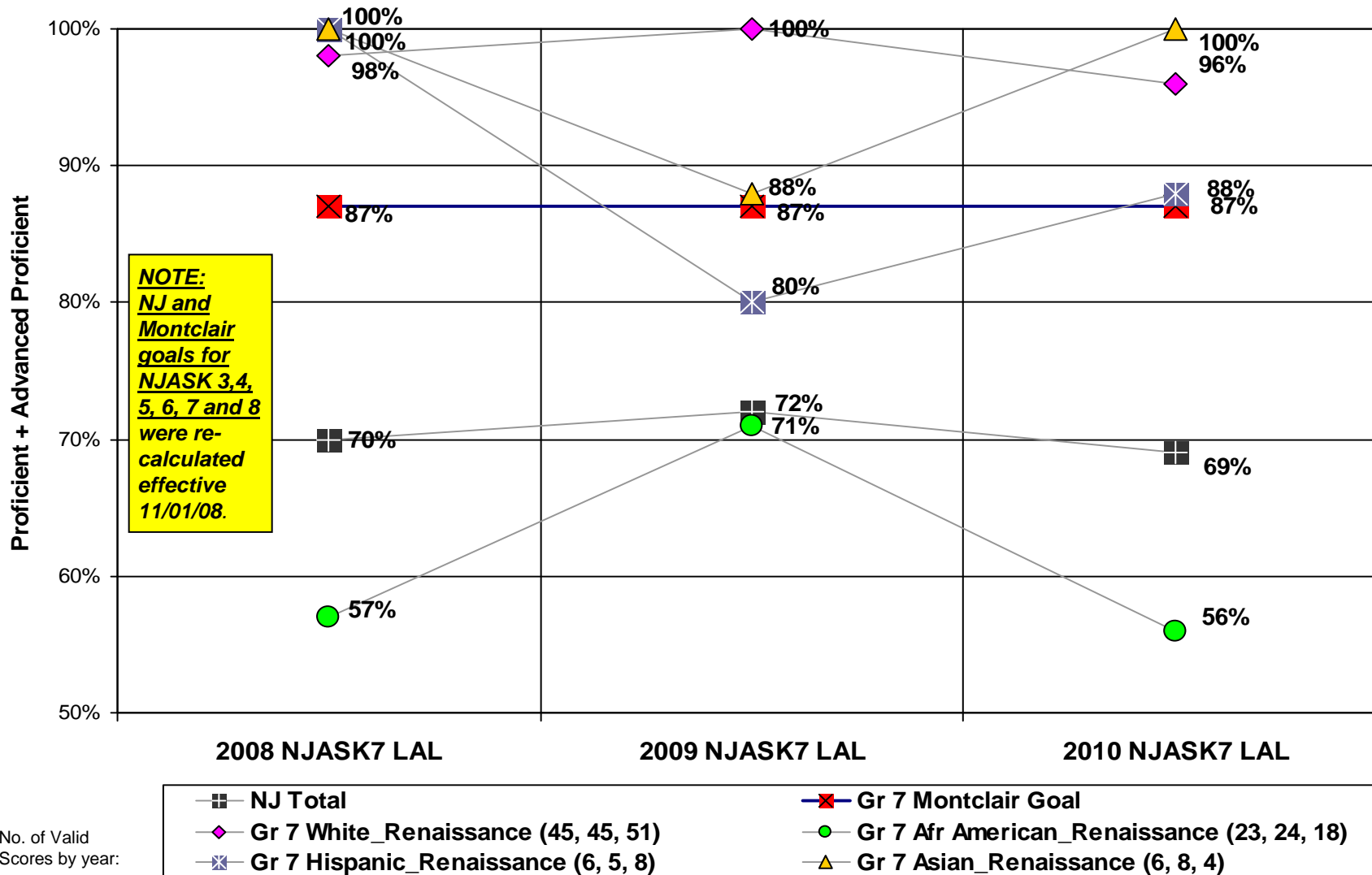

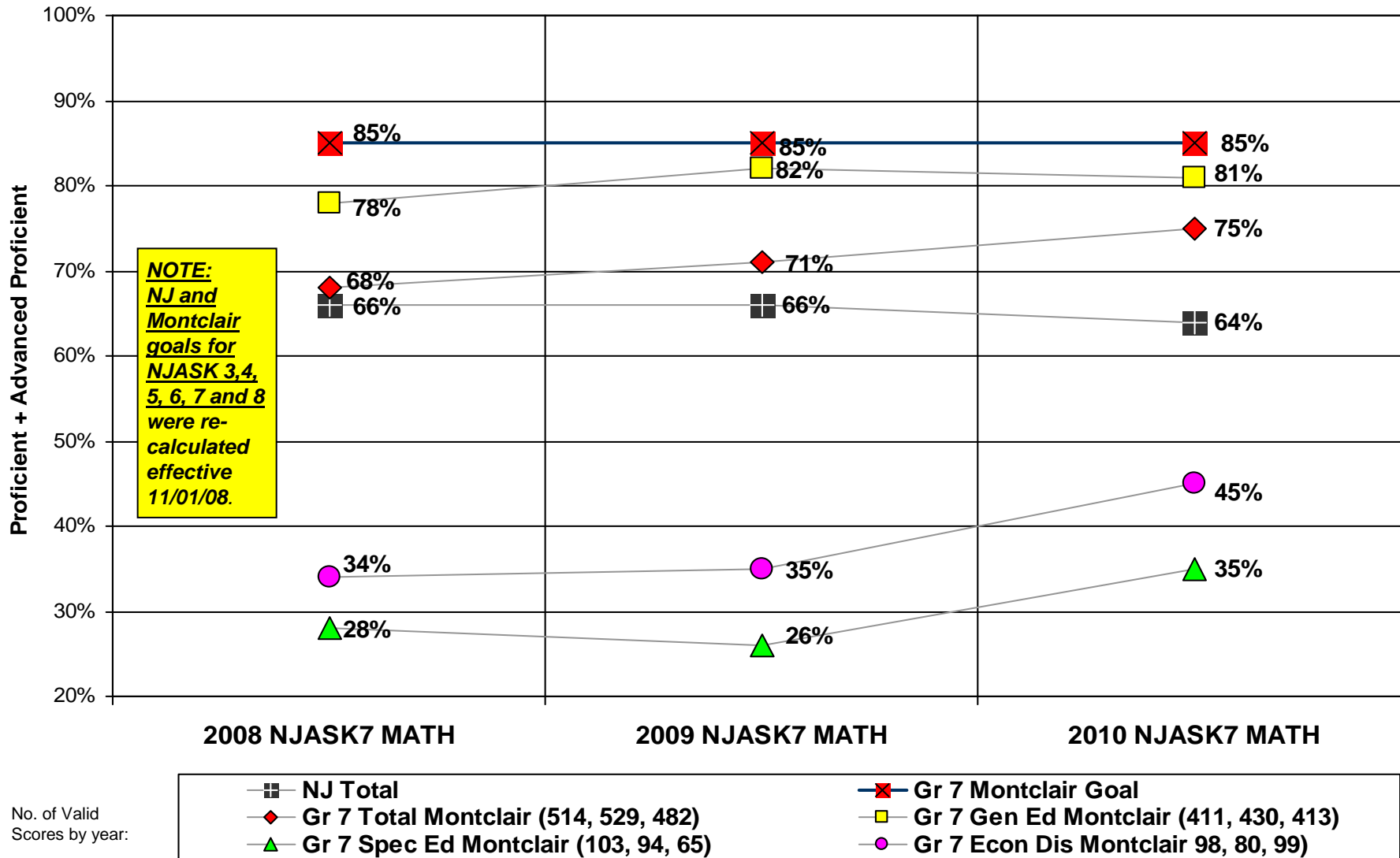


Grade 07 MATH (NJASK7) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf DISTRICT By GROUP: 2008 - 2010

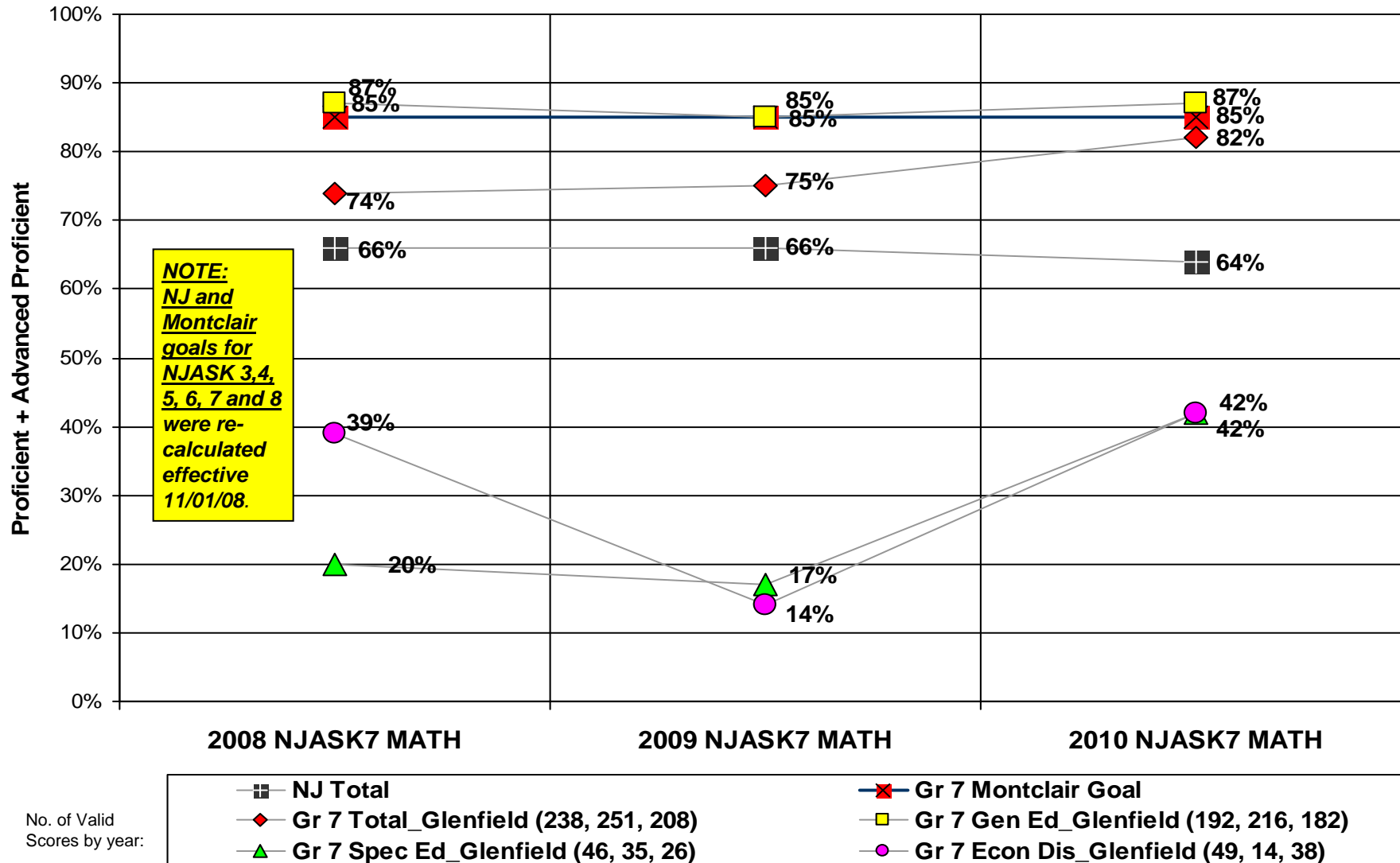

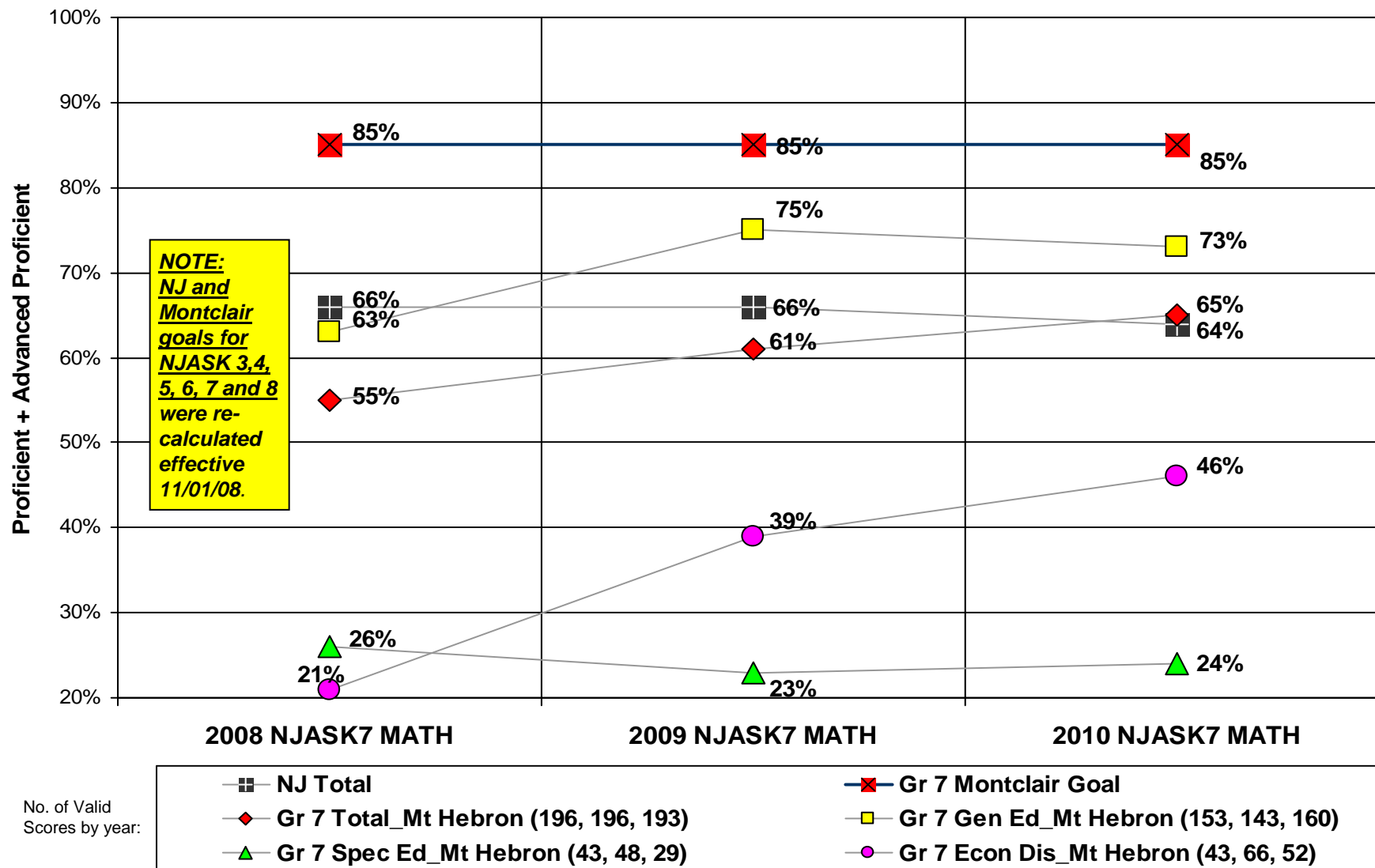


Grade 07 MATH (NJASK7) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf MT HEBRON By GROUP: 2008 - 2010

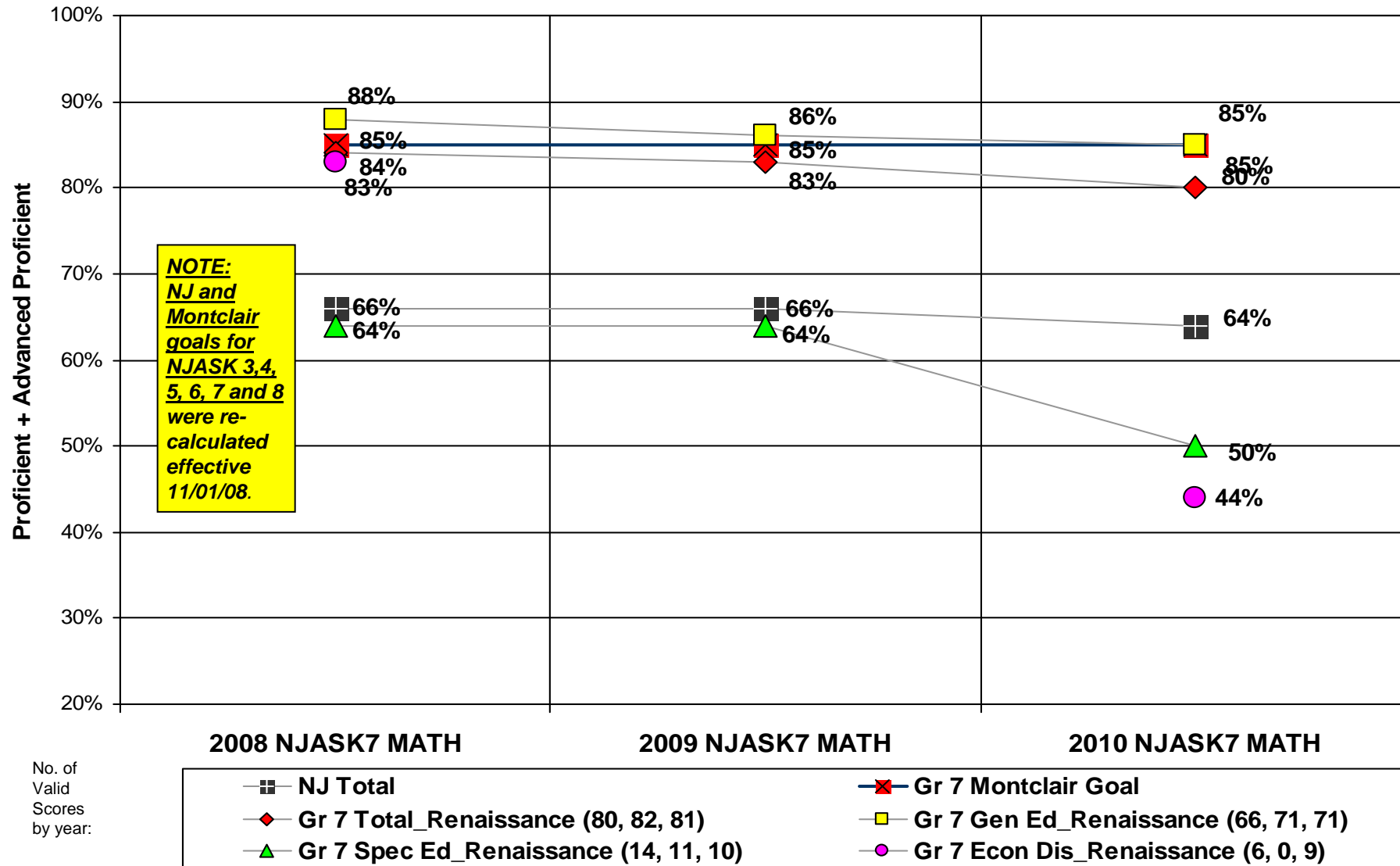

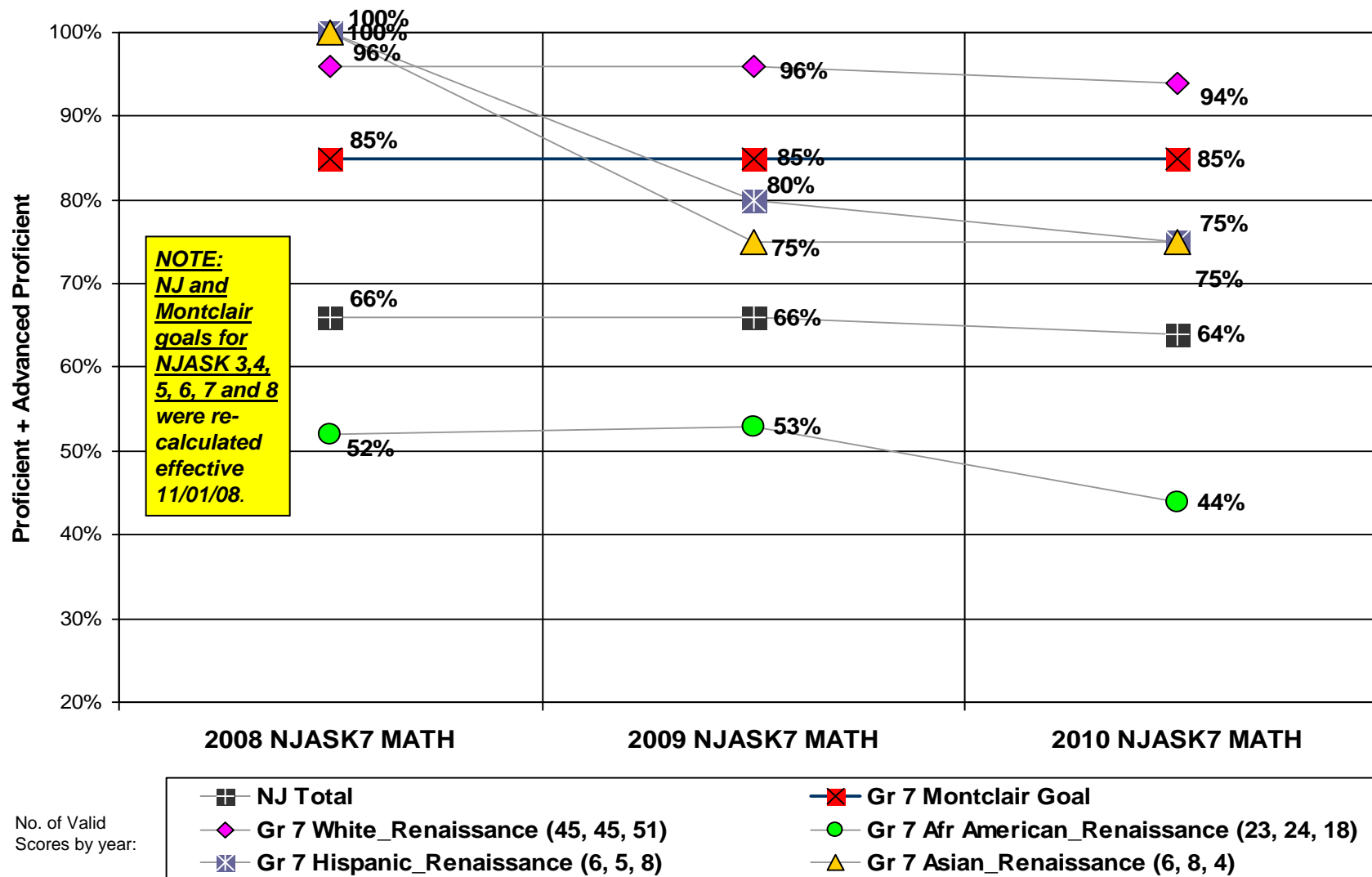

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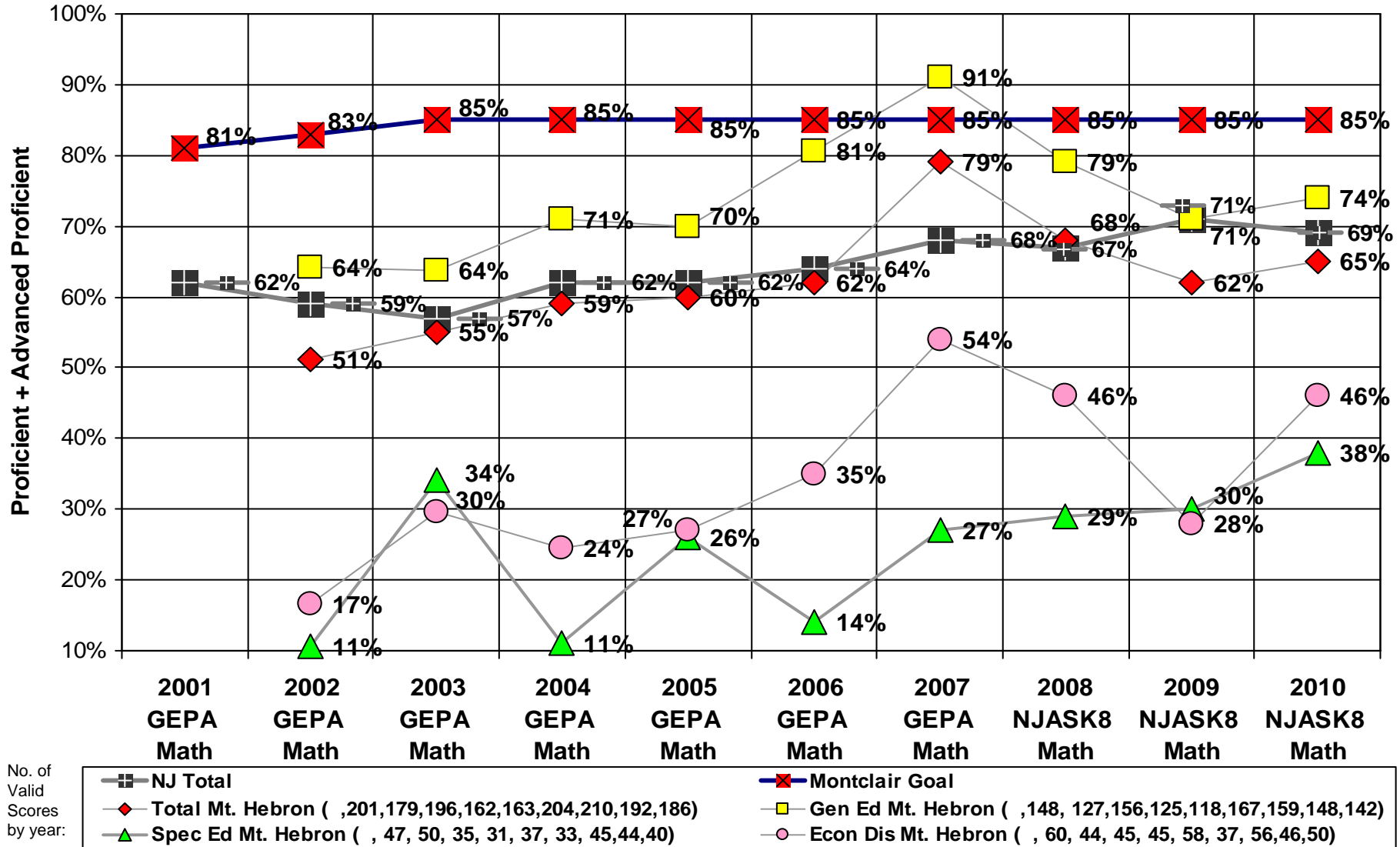


Grade 08 MATH (NJASK8) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf MT HEBRON By GROUP: 2001 – 2010

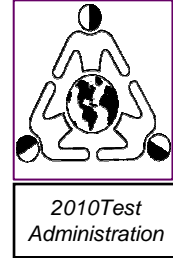

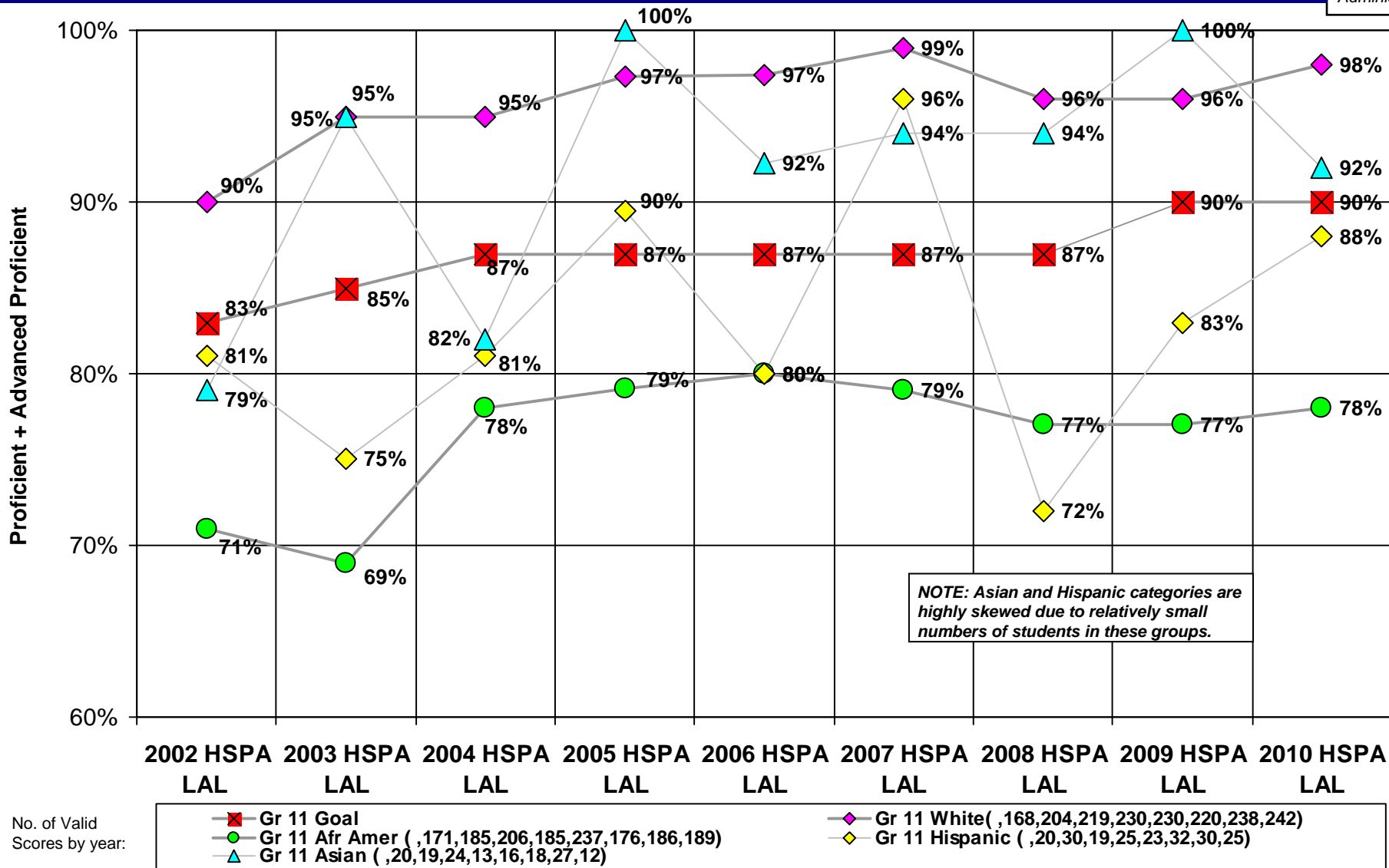

Grade 11 LAL (HSPA) CYCLE I Prof/AdvProf MHS by GROUP: 2002 – 2010



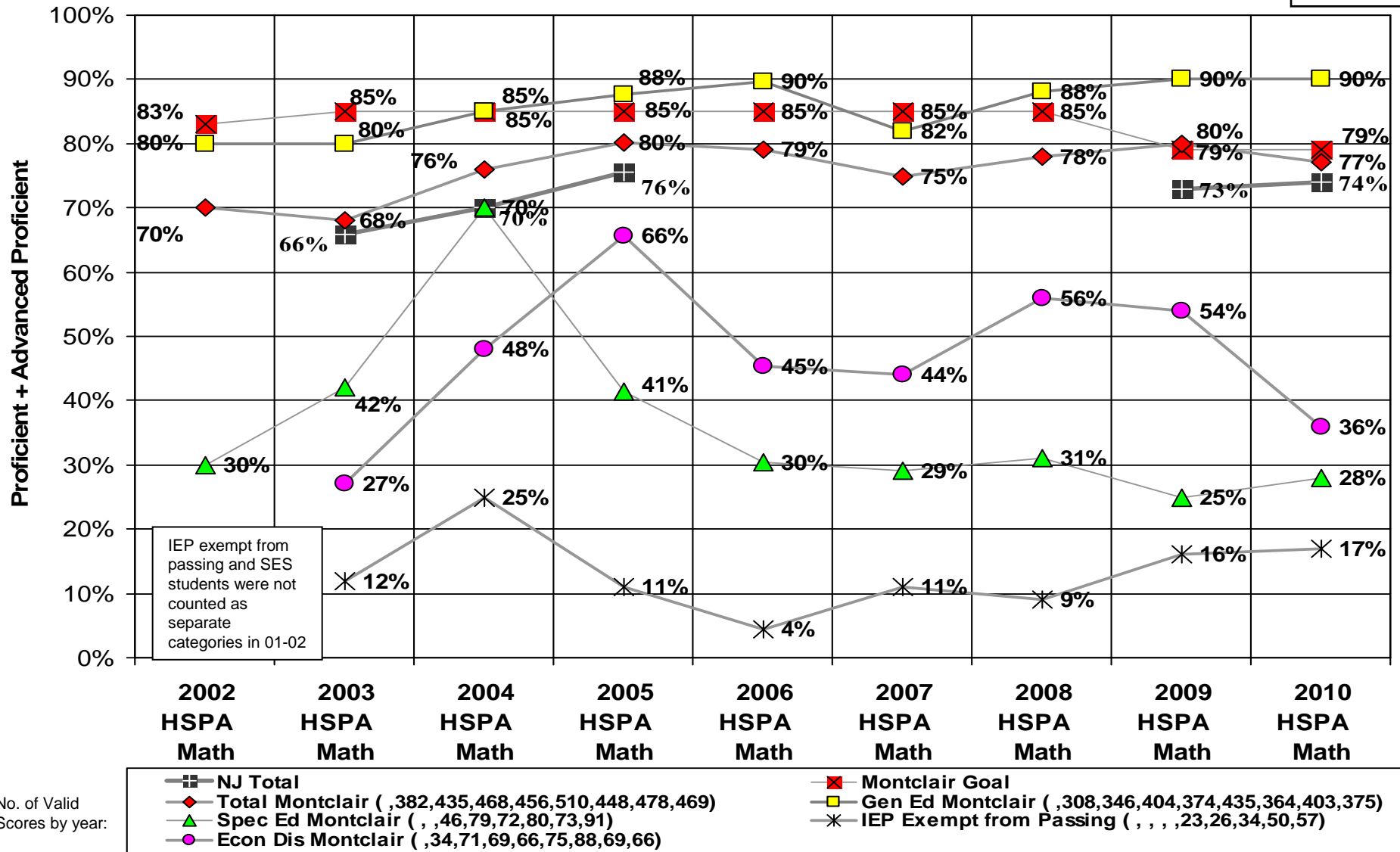
Grade 11 LAL (HSPA) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf MHS by ETHNICITY: 2002 – 2010



Grade 11 MATH (HSPA) CYCLE II Prof/AdvProf MHS by GROUP: 2002 – 2010



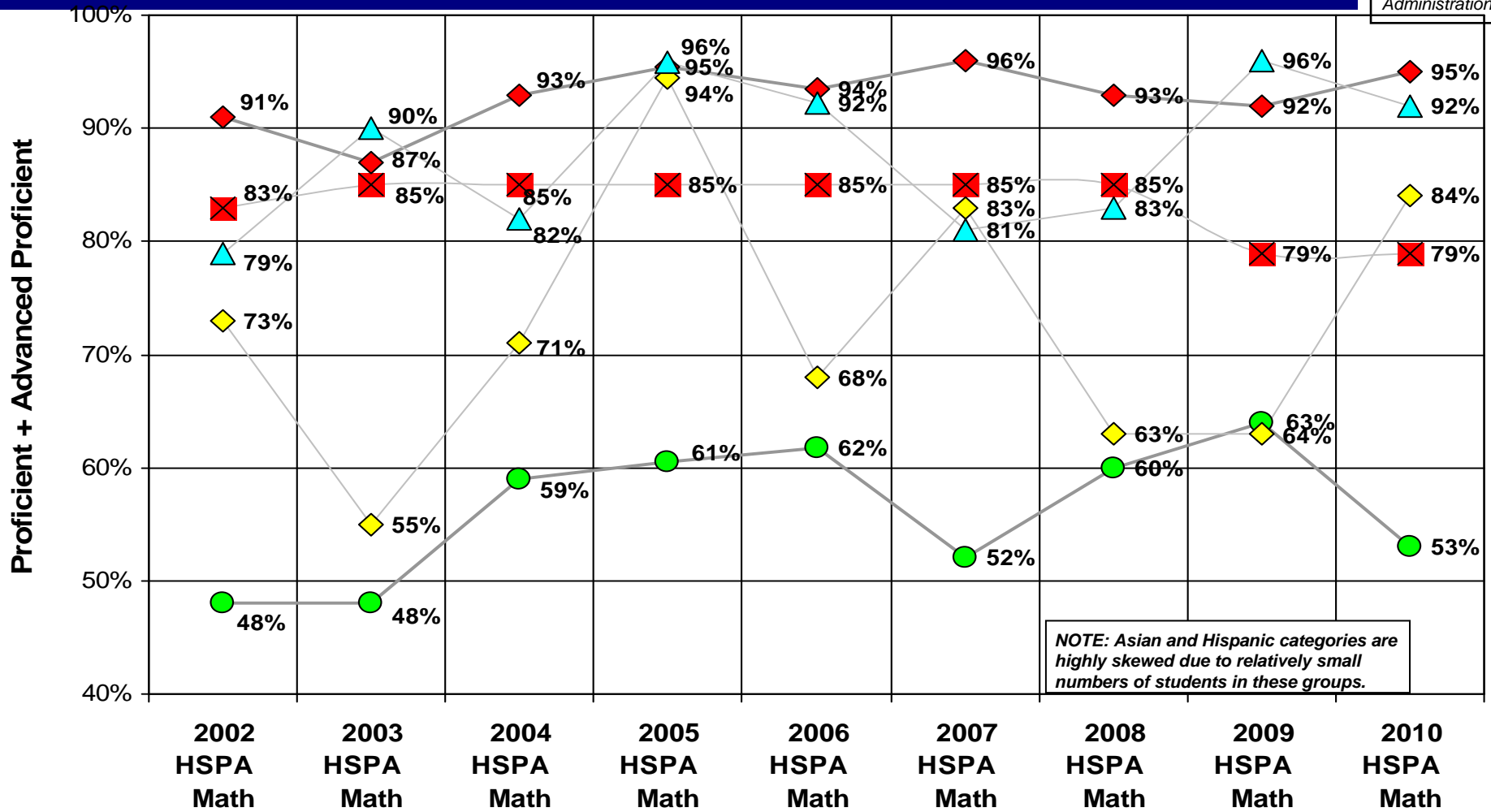

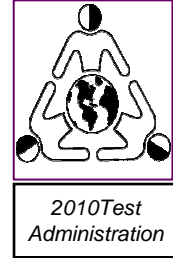
