After School Programs

- 1) Bullock – Literacy Education Assistance Program (LEAP) - Literacy Based Program in collaboration with the Service Learning Program at Montclair State University. MSU students served as student interns/tutors for 10 weeks on Wednesdays
- 2) Nishuane After School Program – Literacy Based Program – certified teachers in addition to Volunteer Tutors from the community and Montclair High School.
- 3) Hillside Program STARS Academy – meets Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday for one hour after school focused on English Language Arts and Math.
- 4) Mount Hebron – After School Achievement Program – Meets twice a week Tuesday's and Wednesday's after school focused on English Language Arts and Math.
- 5) Montclair Community Intervention Alliance - Fall After-school Tutoring Program for 9th grade students.
- 6) New Jersey ASK 8 Saturday Skills Development Program – Invitation was extended to all 8th grade students for 6 consecutive Saturdays. Tutors were invited from the Montclair High School and Community Organizations. Students from Montclair High School in the National Honor Society and Key Club participated based upon teacher recommendations.
