HIB INVESTIGATION TIMELINE

DAY 1:

- Verbal notification is made to the Principal who pre-determines if the incident meets the criteria of HIB or a Code of Conduct investigation.
- The Principal completes a Form 338 into Genesis (with the pre-determination indicated), contacts parents, the Superintendent and the ABC that an incident was a Code of Conduct or referred for an HIB investigation.

DAY 2:

• The Principal informs the ABS of the HIB preliminary determination providing a copy of Form 338 and the ABS starts the investigation

DAY 3:

• The ABS completes the HIB Investigation and the Investigation Report within 10 days

DAY 13: (at the latest)

- The ABS reviews the report and determination with the Principal, who determines
- consequences, remedial measures, and/or support services for involved students

DAY 15: (at the latest)

• The ABS updates the HIB fields in Genesis and uploads all Forms, notifying the Superintendent and ABC of the investigation completion and determination

*The ABC Reviews the investigations with the Superintendent who may make further recommendations for the implementation of consequences/remediation or support

Next Board Meeting:

• The Board affirms or rejects the determination and may make further recommendations 5 DAYS after the Meeting: The ABC forwards the determination letters to the parents of alleged offender(s) and alleged victims(s)
